- n. the process through which plants and other organisms transform light energy into chemical energy, which is then released through cellular respiration to power the organism's activities.
- (1) oxygenic photosynthesis,(2) process of photosynthesisIn photosynthesis, plants use carbon dioxide to feed

chlorophyll

any of a group of green pigments found in photosynthetic organisms

themselves.

(1) **chlorophyll** pigment, (2) bacterial **chlorophyll Chlorophyll** utilizes sunlight to create sugars.

carotenoid

- organic pigments of yellow, orange, and red that are produced by plants, algae, and various bacteria and fungus

microscopic

adj. tiny; exceedingly precise and detail-oriented; of or used in microscopy

synonym: infinitesimal, tiny, atomic

nanostructure

- a structure that falls in between microscopic and molecular in size
