### prophet

### bury

- v. to place a dead body in the ground, grave, or tomb synonym: entomb, sink, forget

### hilltop

### baptize

v. to make someone officially a member of the Christian Church by baptism (= a form of Christian ritual purification)

#### vibrant

### aquifer

#### stork

- a very tall, long-legged bird with white and black plunge and a long beak that walks around in the water to find its food

### pelican

- a large long-winged seabird having a bag of skin under its long beak for storing food
- the bag of a pelican, (2) a pelican colony
   The great white pelican is the national bird of Romania.

#### spot

- n. a particular location or place; a small round or roundish area, differing in color or feels from the surface around itsynonym: dot, mark, place

#### kestrel

- a small bird of prey (= a bird that kills and eats other creatures) of the falcon family

### migration

#### lush

adj. produced or growing in extreme abundance, often in an attractive way; having strong sexual appeal

### expanse

 a substance, such as water or oil, that flows freely and is neither a solid nor a gas

#### tamarisk

- any shrub or small tree of the genus Tamarix with tiny scale-like leaves borne on slender branches, native to drier areas of Eurasia and Africa

### papyrus

#### oleander

#### environmentalist

 a person who is concerned with and advocates for the protection of the natural environment

synonym: conservationist

The **environmentalist** lobby changed the mindset of many conservative politicians.

### encourage

v. to give someone support, confidence, or hope; to persuade someone to do or continue to do something by making it easier for them and making them believe it is a good thing to do

facilitate, persuade, stimulate

#### unrestricted

adj. not limited or confined in any way

### agriculture

 the practice or science of cultivating the land or raising stock

synonym: farming, husbandry, agribusiness

organic agriculture, (2) intensive agriculture
 Agriculture is the foundation of our economy.

#### transform

- to change in outward structure or looks;
- synonym: alter, convert, change
- (1) **transform** an education system, (2) **transform** heat into power

My father's death **transformed** my life completely.

#### fertile

adj. capable of producing abundant vegetation or crops; intellectually productive

synonym: fruitful, productive, rich

(1) fertile ground, (2) fertile market

Herbs require **fertile** soil in a sunny, sheltered location.

### vineyard

- n. a farm where grapes are grown to produce wine
- a productive vineyard,
   vineyard worker
   vineyards stretch as far as the eye can see.

#### labor

 n. productive work, especially physical work done for wages; the people who do manual or physical work in a country or company for wage; (verb) to work hard or to strive and make an effort to reach a goal

synonym: toil, moil, donkeywork

(1) seasonal labor, (2) manual labor

In several countries, child **labor** is a serious social problem.

#### bestow

v. to give something to somebody, especially as an honor or present

### chairperson

gap

### consumption

 the amount used or eaten; the act of using up a resource such as energy, food, or materials

synonym: usage, uptake, utilization

(1) average fuel **consumption**, (2) the **consumption** of food

In our country, water **consumption** usually decreases during the winter.

#### loom

v. to appear or take shape as a large, especially in a frightening way

*synonym*: appear, come on, overshadow

(1) **loom** over the global economy, (2) **loom** on the horizon The issue of divorce **loomed** large in his mind.

### deplete

v. to reduce something, especially supplies of energy, money, etc., by a large amount; to use up resources or materials

*synonym*: exhaust, consume, use up

If we continue to **deplete** the Earth's natural resources, we will cause severe damage to the environment.

#### deficit

### kingdom

### irrigation

- the agricultural practice of supplying land with water through pipes or channels so that crops grow well

### valley

 a long depression on the surface of the land, which typically contains a river

synonym: canyon, gorge, dale

#### environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

#### eliminate

- v. to remove or get rid of someone or something synonym: wipe out, destroy, eradicate

#### consult

lobby

 a large area inside the entrance of a public building where people can meet and wait; a group of people who try to persuade a politician, the government, or an official group to influence legislation

#### insufficient

adj. not enough for a particular purposesynonym: deficient, inadequate, scarce

#### lever

 a handle used to operate a vehicle or a machine; a rigid bar resting on a pivot so that one end of it can be pushed or pulled easily

This initiative will be a **lever** for increasing company sales.

#### commissioner

 an official member of a government department or another organization who is responsible for controlling something or performing specific duties

synonym: administrator, agent, official

He became an audit **commissioner** because of his years of experience as an accountant.

### publicly

adv. in a manner accessible to or observable by the public; by the government

synonym: candidly, openly, honestly

### alternate

adj. occurring or existing one after the other regularly synonym: substitute, back up, equivalent

(1) **alternate** choice, (2) every **alternate** year The cleaning lady comes on **alternate** Wednesdays.

### coalition

 a temporary alliance formed by two or more political parties for combined action; the state of being combined into one body

synonym: union, confederation, alliance

(1) a three-party coalition, (2) coalition forces

The two largest opposition parties announced they would form a **coalition** in the next elections.

### proposal

- n. a formal suggestion or offer, sometimes a written onesynonym: offer, suggestion, proposition
- an innovative proposal,
   details of his proposal
   with much opposition.

#### conserve

- v. to protect something, especially the natural environment or culture, from change, damage, or destruction
- synonym: preserve, save, maintain
- (1) means to **conserve** energy, (2) **conserve** coal resources

### regulate

v. to control something, especially by means of rules or laws

addition

synonym: accumulation, expansion, addendum

promote

 to encourage or persuade people to like, buy, use, do, or support something; to raise someone to a higher position or rank

synonym: boost, raise, advertise

#### wastewater

 water that contains waste substances from homes, farms, factories, etc.

synonym: drainage, sewerage

(1) wastewater disposal equipment, (2) biological wastewater

As that country developed its industry, it began to invest more in **wastewater** treatment technology.

#### treatment

 the way in which someone deals with or behaves towards someone or something; medical care provided to a patient for an injury or illness.

synonym: remedy, antidote, medicine

#### desalination

- *n.* the process of removing salt, especially from seawater

### facility


