#### nuance

 a subtle or slight degree of difference in appearance, meaning, sound, someone's feeling, etc.

synonym: shading, refinement, subtlety

(1) rich in **nuance**, (2) subtle cultural **nuance**The painter has tried to express every **nuance** of the woman's expression in his work.

# doomsday

 the last day of the world when Christians believe that God will judge everyone; an unpleasant or disastrous event

synonym: Day of Judgment, Last Judgement

(1) **doomsday** scenario, (2) economic **doomsday** This task is going to take me till **doomsday**.

# counterproductive

adj. having the opposite effect to the one intended or wanted synonym: ineffective, inadequate, inefficient

(1) **counterproductive** approach, (2) highly **counterproductive** to performance

Territorial disputes between different countries are entirely **counterproductive** but common.

## obsess

v. to fill the mind of someone continually so that one can't think of anything else

synonym: torment, beset, engross

(1) **obsess** over her weight, (2) he is **obsessed** with the fear

He's utterly **obsessed** with his promotion.

## orthosomnia

- a medical term for an unhealthy obsession with getting perfect sleep
- (1) treatment for **orthosomnia**, (2) excessive **orthosomnia** Several researchers claim that tracking sleep through apps and gadgets is causing **orthosomnia**.

# preoccupation

the state or condition of thinking about something continuously or obsessively

synonym: fetish, obsession, fixation

(1) **preoccupation** with work, (2) military **preoccupation**She has an obsessive **preoccupation** with weight and shape.

# involuntary

adj. acting or done without or against one's will synonym: coerced, forced, automatic

(1) **involuntary** manslaughter, (2) **involuntary** muscles

The drug's side effects can include **involuntary** loss of urine.

#### insomnia

the condition of being unable to sleep, usually a chronic one

synonym: sleeplessness, wakefulness, restlessness

(1) medication for **insomnia**, (2) alcohol-dependent **insomnia** 

He suffered **insomnia** and loss of appetite after he began taking that medication.
