prune

a dried plum that has a black, wrinkled appearance;
 (verb) to cut off branches from a tree, bush, or plant, especially to encourage growth

synonym: (verb) trim, (verb) cut back

prune a branch, (2) wrinkle like a prune
 You should remove the seeds from the prunes before cooking.

neuron

 a cell that is specialized to carry information within the brain and between the brain and other parts of the body

synonym: nerve cell

(1) excite the **neurons**, (2) **neuron** cell body Our body transfers information along each **neuron** using an electrical impulse.

myelin

 a white fatty substance that covers around nerves, helping them to send signals effectively

synonym: medulla

(1) **myelin** encasing the axons, (2) **myelin** protein **Myelin** sheath allows electrical impulses to travel quickly and efficiently along the nerve cells.

remodel

- *v.* to change the structure or form of something *synonym*: refurbish, remake, revamp

flourish

riddle

 a type of question that describes something in a difficult and confusing way, and that has a surprising answer, often asked as a game

synonym: mystery, puzzle, enigma

(1) riddle me a riddle, (2) solve the riddle

The **riddle** remains mysterious to us.

solver

 a thinker who finds an answer to a problem or a difficult situation; a piece of software or the algorithm that solves a mathematical problem

synonym: thinker

(1) puzzle- solver, (2) linear solver

The flow **solver** is validated against the experiment.

crossword

- a word puzzle consisting of a grid of black and white squares and blanks into which words crossing vertically and horizontally are written according to clues

hippocampus

- a major component of the brain of humans and other vertebrates that is part of the limbic system and is vital for memory
