#### cytokine

- any of various protein molecules produced by cells of the immune system that serve to regulate the immune system
- a cytokine production, (2) cytokine receptor
  Abnormal cytokine response may cause atopic dermatitis.

### hypertrophy

- *n.* the enlargement of a body part or organ because its cells increase in size
- (1) cardiac **hypertrophy**, (2) **hypertrophy** of a limb The physician looked at the images and confirmed renal **hypertrophy**.

#### atrophy

- a decrease in size of a muscle, organ, etc., caused by disease or disuse
- synonym: disintegration, degeneration, wasting away
- (1) weakness with **atrophy**, (2) **atrophy** of the muscles Daily exercise and adequate sleep are necessary to prevent the progression of **atrophy**.

#### eccentric

- adj. weird or unusual, sometimes in a funny way synonym: bizarre, abnormal, curious
