stumble

- v. to miss a step and fall or nearly fall; to walk unsteadily synonym: bumble, struggle, misstep
- (1) **stumble** financially, (2) **stumble** through life She **stumbled** over the tree root.

conceive

- v. to have or develop an idea, a plan, etc. in mind; to become pregnant
- synonym: imagine, envision, concoct
- (1) **conceive** of an idea, (2) **conceive** a child I can't **conceive** he'd want to harm us.

uncover

- v. to remove the cover from something; to discover something previously unseen or hidden
- synonym: disclose, reveal, unveil
- (1) **uncover** a potential problem, (2) **uncover** the truth He continued his investigation and soon **uncovered** another crime.

confuse

- v. to mistake one thing for another; to make somebody hard to understand
- synonym: confound, obscure, disorient
- (1) confuse the listener, (2) confuse fantasy with reality

Her remarks **confused** the debate.

chimera

(in Greek mythology) a fire-breathing creature with a n. lion's head, a goat's body, and a snake's tail; a thing that is illusory or impossible to achieve

synonym: delusion, illusion, figment

(1) chimera mouse, (2) interspecies chimera Animal **chimeras** are created by combining multiple fertilized eggs.

amalgam

uterus

an alloy of mercury with another metal, used especially to fill holes in teeth; a mixture or combination of diverse things

synonym: mixture, alloy, admixture

- (1) **amalgam** alloy, (2) an **amalgam** of hope and fear His theory is an **amalgam** of earlier ideas.
- a hollow muscular organ in the body of a woman or other female mammal in which a baby or young animal develops before birth

synonym: womb

(1) uterus cancer, (2) bleeding from uterus The physician prescribed medication to relieve the

contraction of the uterus.

fetus

- an unborn or unhatched animal in the later stages of development showing the main recognizable features of the mature animal
- (1) development of the fetus, (2) an aborted fetus The female vagina is elastic enough to allow the passage of a fetus.

- a temporary organ that feeds a fetus (= unborn and developing baby) inside its mother's womb
- (1) placenta blood, (2) fetal placenta

The **placenta** produces various hormones that help maintain the pregnancy.

placenta

inherit

v. to receive money, property, or a title from someone after they have died

synonym: obtain, gain, acquire

(1) **inherit** estate, (2) **inherit** ancestral property After his death, his sons **inherited** his business.

undifferentiated

adj. having few or no clear distinctive characters; (of cells) not having specialized or mature structures or functionssynonym: uniform, identical, alike

(1) **undifferentiated** cells, (2) **undifferentiated** market The infant makes **undifferentiated** reflex responses to stimuli.

undetected

adj. not perceived or discoveredsynonym: undiscovered, hidden, concealed

undetected cancer, (2) leave the house undetected
Doctors made mistakes, and diseases remained undetected.

regenerate

- v. to improve or renew an area, institution, system, etc., especially by making it more active or successful synonym: renew, revive, improve
- (1) **regenerate** bone tissue, (2) a **regenerate** sinner The new CEO's primary mission is to **regenerate** the company on the verge of bankruptcy.

biopsy

n. the process of removing and examining tissue from the body of the sick person to determine the existence or cause of a disease

synonym: examination, autopsy

(1) **biopsy** of bone marrow, (2) liquid **biopsy**The doctor performed an excisional breast **biopsy**.

fraternal

adj. relating to or like a brother or brothers; (of twins) derived from two separate fertilized ova (= the female reproductive cell)

synonym: brotherly, congenial, biovular

(1) fraternal twins, (2) a fraternal association

He recommended that they take out **fraternal** life insurance.

ovary

- n. either of the pair of organs in the female reproductive system that produces eggs; (of a plant) the organ that bears the ovules of a flower
- (1) **ovary** atrophy, (2) salted **ovary** of walleye pollack They found **ovary** cancer in an early stage.

ancestry

- n. the family or the ethnic descent that you come from synonym: ancestor, family, descent
- (1) a distinguished **ancestry**, (2) prehuman **ancestry**He looked down on the royal **ancestry** of the neighboring country.

embryonic

adj. of or relating to an embryo (= an animal organism in the early stages of growth); in an early stage of development

synonym: embryonal

mitochondria

- n. (singular: mitochondrion) an organelle (= a specialized part of a cell) found in large numbers in most cells that produce energy for the cell by breaking down food
