- n. the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data

thatch

 a material, such as straw or reeds, used to cover the roofs of houses or other buildings

synonym: straw, grass, reed

premier

adj. first in importance, order, or position; leading synonym: first, leading, top
