#### frown

- to make an angry or severe expression by bringing your eyebrows together to indicate disapproval, displeasure, or concentration
- synonym: scowl, glare, disapprove

   Thinking always made him frown.

#### wrinkle

- *n.* a small line or fold in something, especially fabric or the skin of the face; a minor difficulty
- synonym: crinkle, fold, crumple
- (1) a fine wrinkle on a fabric, (2) a facial wrinkle

This suit is made of **wrinkle-proof** material.

sneer

v. to show contempt or ridicule for someone or something through a facial expression or tone of voice; (noun) a contemptuous or scornful smile or remark

synonym: mock, deride, ridicule

(1) **sneer** openly at him, (2) **sneer** hatefully

She **sneered** at his attempts to impress her.

sculptor

an artist who creates sculptures, three-dimensional objects, or forms

synonym: carver, modeler, artist

(1) sculptor studio, (2) renowned sculptor

The famous **sculptor** used various tools to carve the marble into the desired shape.

lifeless

adj. without life; dead

synonym: inanimate, inert, motionless

(1) fall **lifeless**, (2) a **lifeless** corpse

The plant had a **lifeless** appearance, indicating that it was not getting enough water.

pedestal

 a base or support on which something, typically a statue, column, etc., is placed

synonym: base, stand, platform

(1) pedestal sink, (2) a stone pedestal

The statue was placed on a **pedestal** in the center of the park.

colossal

adj. extremely large and impressive

synonym: gigantic, huge, enormous

(1) colossal statue, (2) a colossal success

The new building is truly **colossal**, towering over the surrounding buildings.

wreck

 a ship that has sunk or has been destroyed; a vehicle that has been badly damaged in an accident

*synonym*: collapse, destruction, devastation

(1) the house was a <b>wreck</b> ,	(2) a worthless wreck
The divers accidentally disco	overed a <b>wreck</b> on the ocean
floor.	

#### boundless

adj. having no limits; limitlesssynonym: limitless, indefinite, bottomless

(1) **boundless** imagination, (2) **boundless** energy
The **boundless** ocean stretched before them as far as the eye could see.

# enlightenment

 n. education that results in understanding and the spread of knowledge

synonym: civilization, awareness, sophistication

(1) spiritual **enlightenment**, (2) **enlightenment** activity He finally brought his **enlightenment** to perfection.

#### sonnet

- n. a 14-line poem, typically with a formal rhyme schemesynonym: poetic form, 14-line verse
- sonnet poetry, (2) Shakespeare's sonnets
   The poet wrote a sonnet to express his love for his wife.

#### Renaissance

 a new growth in activity or enthusiasm in anything, particularly art, literature, or music

synonym: rebirth, golden age

(1) artistic **renaissance**, (2) industrial **renaissance**Folk music is now experiencing a **renaissance**.

#### iambic

adj. relating to or consisting of iambs; a metrical foot consisting of two syllables, with the first syllable short and the second syllable long

synonym: metrical, poetic, rhythmic

(1) regular **iambic** norm, (2) scene of **iambic** dialogue The sonnet is written in **iambic** pentameter.

#### pentameter

n. a line of verse consisting of five metrical feetsynonym: metrical foot, verse line, poetic meter

(1) **pentameter** in poetry, (2) **pentameter** verse The poem is written in iambic **pentameter**.

### syllable

- a single unit of spoken language more significant than a phoneme containing a vowel sound and usually one or more consonants
- (1) syllable structure, (2) single syllableEmphasize the second syllable when pronouncing it.

#### unstressed

adj. not feeling worried; not having stress placed upon it synonym: relaxed, tranquil, easy-going

(1) **unstressed** vowel, (2) **unstressed** syllable She remained **unstressed** even when the deadline was approaching.

#### octave

 a musical interval encompassing eight diatonic scale degrees, such as the interval from C to the next C in a C major scale

synonym: eighth, interval, range

(1) octave key, (2) octave range

The singer's range was impressive, covering three **octaves** with ease.

#### sextet

- n. a group of six people or thingssynonym: sextette, sextuor, six-piece ensemble
- (1) sextet music, (2) sextet group

The **sextet** played a variety of jazz and classical music.

### topple

v. to cause to lose balance and fall over, especially by pushing

synonym: overturn, capsize, upset

(1) topple communist rule, (2) topple off a ledge

The statue was old and unstable, so it easily toppled over.

### arrogant

adj. having or revealing an exaggerated sense of one's importance or abilities

synonym: haughty, supercilious, disdainful

(1) an <b>arrogant</b> attitude,	(2) grow arrogant
He was so arrogant that	he thought he was always right.

#### arrogance

- n. excessive self-confidence or self-importancesynonym: hubris, haughtiness, conceit
- (1) brazen **arrogance**, (2) **arrogance** of power He acted with **arrogance** and was not well-liked by his colleagues.

#### boastful

- adj. overly proud and talking too much about oneself and one's achievements
- synonym: proud, vainglorious, self-important
- (1) a **boastful** countenance, (2) **boastful** talk

  He was **boastful** of his accomplishments and often bragged about them.

## inscription

- n. a message or design that is written or engraved on a surface of something, such as stone or metalsynonym: engraving, writing, script
- (1) **inscription** on a plaque, (2) funerary **inscriptions**The ancient coin had an **inscription** in Latin and a picture of the emperor on the other side.

#### undercut

- v. to sell goods or services at a lower price than a competitor; to cut away the underpart of somethingsynonym: undermine, weaken, sabotage
- (1) undercut a vein of ore, (2) undercut his effort The company undercut its competitors by offering lower prices.

#### bury

- v. to place a dead body in the ground, grave, or tomb synonym: entomb, sink, forget
- bury in the earth, (2) bury emotion
   There is plenty of space to bury everyone.

#### inscribe

v. to write or carve something on a surface, especially as a formal or permanent record

synonym: engrave, carve, etch

(1) **inscribe** a message, (2) **inscribe** in her mind clearly The artist **inscribed** a beautiful design on the surface of the vase.

#### surpass

- v. to be or do better than someone or something; to excel or go beyond the limits or standards of something synonym: excel, outdo, outperform
- (1) **surpass** imagination, (2) **surpass** \$20 billion in sales The athlete's record-breaking performance **surpassed** all expectations.
