#### immoral

adj. not conforming to accepted society's standards of honesty or morality

*synonym*: unethical, wicked, corrupt

(1) **immoral** behavior, (2) politically **immoral** It is **immoral** to cheat on a test.

#### deviant

adj. markedly different or departing from what is normal or expected

synonym: abnormal, unconventional, irregular

(1) deviant ideas, (2) deviant art

His **deviant** behavior made others uncomfortable, and they avoided him at all costs.

#### distasteful

adj. unpleasant or offensive to the sense of tastesynonym: unpleasant, unsatisfying, disagreeable

(1) distasteful to her, (2) distasteful remark

The food served at the dinner party could have been more appealing and **distasteful**.

#### enslave

v. to make someone a slave; to deprive someone of their freedom of choice or action

synonym: coerce, deprive, imprison

(1) **enslave** poor peasants, (2) **enslave** indigenous people Her beauty **enslaved** me completely.

#### harrowing

*adj.* causing distress or suffering; extremely distressing *synonym*: traumatic, torturous, distressing

(1) harrowing battle, (2) harrowing journey

Her **harrowing** experience in the war had left her with deep emotional scars.

riot

 a violent disturbance of the peace by a crowd, characterized by destruction of property, looting, arson, and attacks on individuals

synonym: disturbance, unrest, upheaval

(1) riot police, (2) riot control gas

The **riots** in the city have left many buildings damaged and several people injured.

# galvanize

 to stimulate or shock someone into taking action; to cover metal containing zinc to protect it from rust

*synonym*: energize, invigorate, motivate

(1) galvanize steel, (2) galvanize the country

The motivational speech **galvanized** the team and gave them the drive to succeed.

#### effeminate

 adj. having qualities or characteristics traditionally associated with women, especially delicacy, softness, and a lack of strength or assertiveness

synonym: unmanly, delicate, soft

(1) effeminate gestures, (2) effeminate voice

His **effeminate** mannerisms made others question his masculinity.

# bully

 a person who uses strength or power to harm or intimidate those who are weaker; (verb) to intimidate, harass, or mistreat someone weaker or less powerful

synonym: tormentor, intimidator, aggressor

(1) **bully** bystander, (2) **bully** the weak

The schoolyard **bully** terrorized the other children and made their lives miserable.

#### liberate

to set free; to release or rescue from captivity or oppression

synonym: emancipate, release, set free

(1) **liberate** people from oppression, (2) **liberate** potential The prisoners were **liberated** after the war ended.

#### stonewall

v. to refuse to answer questions or provide information; to delay discussion or decision

synonym: obstruct, block, impede

(1) **stonewall** the investigation, (2) **stonewall** their attempts The government **stonewalled** the opposition party's efforts to access information about the project.

# uprising

 a public rebellion, especially against an established government or authority

synonym: revolt, rebellion, insurgency

(1) stage an **uprising**, (2) violent **uprising**The anti-government **uprising** was successful in overthrowing the regime.

# courageous

adj. able to face and deal with danger or fear without flinching

synonym: brave, valiant, fearless

(1) make a **courageous** decision, (2) **courageous** rescue attempt

He was a **courageous** soldier who had served his country with honor.

# sibling

 a brother or sister; member of a family born to the same parents

synonym: brother, sister, relative

(1) have a **sibling** quarrel, (2) play with my **siblings** Children often copy their parents or elder **siblings**.

#### commemorate

v. to honor the memory of someone or something by ceremony or tribute

*synonym*: honor, remember, celebrate

The country **commemorated** the war heroes on Memorial Day.

### capitol

a building that houses a legislative assembly, especially the US Congress

synonym: government building, legislative center

The **capitol** building was a stunning example of classical architecture, with its marble columns and grand dome.

#### newfound

# masquerade

a party, dance, or other festive gatherings of persons n. wearing masks and other disguises, or a costume worn on such an occasion; making a false outward show

synonym: disguise, pretense, facade

(1) show up in a masquerade, (2) absurd masquerade The **masquerade** party was lavish, with guests in elaborate costumes and masks.

### transgender

adj. relating to or denoting a person whose gender identity does not correspond to that person's biological sex assigned at birth

*synonym*: non-binary

(1) **transgender** person, (2) **transgender** rights Many **transgender** individuals face discrimination and marginalization in society.

## nonbinary

adj. someone who does not identify as a man or a woman;not relating to, composed of, or including only two thingssynonym: pluralistic, polyphyletic

(1) **nonbinary** gender, (2) **nonbinary** identities

More and more people in various countries believe that the policymaker should change the marriage rules for **nonbinary** people.

### germ

 a very tiny living that causes the disease; a piece of something such as an organism, concept, etc., capable of growing into a new one or part of one

synonym: bacterium, microbe, pathogen
