- synonym: represent, exemplify, personify

brand

- a type of product, service, etc., made by a particular company and sold under a specific name; identification mark on the skin of livestock, criminals, etc., made by burning
- synonym: trademark, label, symbol
- (1) create a **brand** logo, (2) the **brand** of the new car There's a new **brand** of hero in the movies now.

resilient

- adj. able to withstand or recover quickly from difficult conditions
- *synonym*: robust, sturdy, tough

innovation

 the creation of a new device or process resulting from study and experimentation *synonym*: invention, initiation, creation

planet

 any of the nine large celestial bodies that circle in the solar system; any celestial body that revolves around a star

tragic

adj. causing great sadness or suffering; very unfortunatesynonym: calamitous, disastrous, catastrophic

gadget

mojo

 personal magic or charm that gives someone a sense of power, good luck, or confidence; a quality of being attractive, confident, and effective

synonym: charm, magic, charisma

tradition

 a belief, custom, or way of doing something that has been passed down from generation to generation within a group or society

synonym: custom, practice, ritual

analytics

 the systematic computational analysis of data or statistics; information resulting from this analysis

synonym: data analysis, statistics

data-driven decisions.

hesitate

- v. to pause decision before saying or doing something synonym: waver, pause, waffle

warn

v. to meet the requirements or expectations; to achieve or realize

fortune

 a large amount of money or property; chance or luck as an unknown and arbitrary force affecting human affairs

synonym: wealth, affluence, assets

sensational

adj. extremely or remarkably good; causing great public interest or excitement

amazing

adj. extremely surprising, especially in a way that you like or admire

synonym: exceptional, extraordinary, wonderful

n. a thing that someone has accomplished, primarily through their effort and ability

synonym: accomplishment, attainment, triumph

predict

relegate

 to assign or dismiss to a lower or less important status or place; to demote

excitement

bubble

n. a thin, round, and often transparent mass of gas that is surrounded by a thin layer of liquid; a state of economic or social prosperity that is unsustainable and eventually collapses

reward

n. a thing given in acknowledgment of service, hard work, achievement, etc.

contract

 a legally binding agreement between two or more parties, setting out their rights and obligations to each other, typically in writing and enforceable by law

synonym: agreement, deal, arrangement

(1) employment **contract**, (2) **contract** law The company signed a **contract** with the supplier for the delivery of goods.

squad

- n. a small group of people organized for a particular purpose, especially a military one or a sports teamsynonym: team, unit, group
- (1) a bomb-disposal **squad**, (2) antiriot **squad**The police department assembled a special **squad** to handle the situation.

suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume

clue

background

 n. the details of a person's social heritage, such as family, vocational or educational experience; past information that is essential to understanding a situation or problem

synonym: ground, experience, backdrop

frequent

adj. happening constantly

synonym: periodic, recurring, routine

assume

synonym: guess, presume, suppose

prevail

v. to be common, widespread, or frequent; to be the strongest or most powerful

synonym: triumph, prevail over, be victorious

deserve

v. to be worthy of or entitled to something, especially something good or valuable

gamble

v. to take risky action in the hope of being successful; to play or game for money or other stakes

adrenaline

a substance secreted by the adrenal medulla in response to stress, which makes the heart beat faster and prepares the body to react to danger

sophisticated

adj. having a great deal of worldly experience and knowledge of people's behavior, culture, and fashion *synonym*: refined, cultured, worldly

mathematics

the science dealing with the logic of quantities, shapes, spaces, and arrangement

synonym: arithmetic, calculation, calculus

(1) a good grounding in mathematics, (2) mathematics competition

He has a flair for **mathematics**.

graduate

a person who has a first degree from university or college; (verb) to complete the first course of university or college and get a degree

synonym: alumna, alum, grad

- (1) graduate degree program, (2) honor graduate Many employers hire **graduate** trainees to train as managers.
- the science of matter and energy and their interactions physics
 - (1) nuclear **physics**, (2) laws of **physics** He studied the **physics** of radiation.

syndicate

a group of individuals or organizations combined to promote a common interest

synonym: cartel, consortium, alliance

(1) criminal syndicate, (2) syndicate member The financial **syndicate** was involved in illegal activities.

statistician

- n. a person who studies or is an expert in statisticssynonym: actuary
- (1) professional **statisticians**, (2) environmental **statistician**

The firm employs several **statisticians** to develop a recommendation engine.

calculate

 to judge or find out the amount or number of something by using mathematics

synonym: compute, figure, estimate

(1) **calculate** the distance, (2) **calculate** his credit score He couldn't **calculate** the actual value of the artwork.

probable

adj. likely to happen or likely to be true *synonym*: likely, possible, potential

(1) **probable** outcome, (2) **probable** cause of a fire It seems **probable** that he has forgotten our scheduled meeting.

outcome

n. the result or effect of an action, event, etc.

synonym: result, consequence, effect

(1) improved student **outcomes**, (2) a desirable **outcome** They awaited news of the **outcome** of the election.

jersey

a knitted garment typically made of wool or cotton, worn as a shirt or pullover

synonym: shirt, sweater, top

(1) **jersey** material, (2) fabric of the **jersey** I always wear my favorite basketball player's **jersey** to the games.

tier

 one of a series of rows or levels arranged one above the other, typically used to describe the arrangement of objects or levels of importance

synonym: level, layer, class

(1) a two-tier system, (2) tier one company

The company operates on a three- **tier** pricing structure.

promote

gut

v. to encourage or persuade people to like, buy, use, do, or support something; to raise someone to a higher position or rank

synonym: boost, raise, advertise

- n. the long tube in the body of a person or animal through which food passes when it leaves the stomach; the mental strength or bravery required to do something difficult or unpleasant

regularly

adv. at regular intervals or times

correlation

 a statistical relationship between two variables in which one variable is affected by the other; a reciprocal relation between two or more facts, numbers, etc.

synonym: relationship, connection, association

outspend

v. to spend more money than someone else or more than has been budgeted

synonym: overspend, exceed, surpass

(1) **outspend** budget, (2) **outspend** the opponent The company plans to **outspend** its competitors on advertising this year.

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outthink

v. to think more effectively, creatively, or strategically than someone else

synonym: outwit, outsmart, outmaneuver

(1) **outthink** the competition, (2) **outthink** the opposing team

competition

 a situation in which someone is attempting to beat or outperform another

synonym: contest, match, fight

(1) the first round of the **competition**, (2) intraspecific **competition**

Global **competition** is rising in virtually every industry.

immediately

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

(1) **immediately** recall a product, (2) write him an answer **immediately**

A suspension order from the court is effective immediately.

rural

adj. of or relating to the countryside

synonym: agrarian, country, rustic

rural accents, (2) people in rural areas
 Many rural areas are still impoverished.

nowhere

adv. not in, at, or to any place; not anywhere

(1) **nowhere** else to go, (2) come out of **nowhere** I've been thinking all day and getting **nowhere**.

radical

adj. relating to the essential aspects of anything; far beyond the norm, mainly used of opinions and actions

synonym: extreme, revolutionary

(1) a radical flaw in the plan, (2) a radical cure

The government established by the coup was more **radical** than before.

eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

synonym: finally, someday, ultimately

(1) **eventually** become obsolete, (2) **eventually** succeed The corporation **eventually** dominated the entire tobacco business.

chairperson

- n. the officer who presides over organization meetingssynonym: director, head, leader
- (1) vice **chairperson**, (2) the meeting elected a **chairperson**

The **chairperson** has the authority to approve or deny any request.

championship

 a contest to decide who is the best player or team in a particular sport; the act of providing approval and support

synonym: crown, title, contest

(1) a world **championship**, (2) **championship** flag His team won the **championship** for three years running.

mighty

adj. very large, powerful, or strongsynonym: potent, powerful, robust

(1) **mighty** works, (2) struck a **mighty** blow Only the **mighty** God has the power to brighten this dark land.

unfortunately

adv. by bad luck; unluckily

synonym: regrettably, unluckily, alas

(1) **unfortunately** caught in a shower, (2) even more **unfortunately**

The treatments were done but, **unfortunately**, were unsuccessful.

perceive

v. to become aware or conscious of something through the senses

synonym:

sense, discern, feel

(1) **perceive** a threat, (2) **perceive** light

Australia is widely **perceived** as having low levels of corruption.

absolute

adj. perfect or complete or to the most considerable degree possible

synonym: complete, infrangible, indisputable

(1) **absolute** loyalty, (2) an **absolute** must

Gandhi had an **absolute** zeal for nonviolence.

embarrass

- v. to cause someone to feel awkward, worried, or ashamed synonym: disconcert, unsettle, agitate
- (1) **embarrass** political enemy, (2) **embarrass** my project He looked for an opportunity to **embarrass** that actor in public.

genius

someone who has exceptional intellectual ability and originality

synonym: brilliance, brainiac, acumen

a person of genius,
 a genius for music
 mozart was a musical genius.

suddenly

adv. quickly and unexpectedly

synonym: abruptly, unexpectedly, unawares

(1) **suddenly** attacked by an enemy, (2) die **suddenly** Who answers **suddenly** knows little.

pronounce

v. to say or speak (a word or words) correctly or in a particular way

synonym: articulate, enunciate, voice

(1) **pronounce** a judgment, (2) **pronounce** a name

She struggled to **pronounce** the word in a foreign language.

competitive

adj. involving competition or competitiveness

synonym: aggressive, ambitious, militant

(1) a competitive price,	(2) competitive position
The mobile application in	dustry is a competitive one.

concept

- n. an idea or principle associated with something abstractsynonym: idea, notion, vision
- learn new concepts, (2) concept car
 One such rapidly growing concept is quantum cryptography.

random

- adj. made, done, or happening without method, conscious decision, or any regular pattern
- synonym: incidental, arbitrary, unanticipated
- a random choice, (2) bombs fell at random
 find drunk drivers, police conduct random tests.

principle

- a fundamental law or truth that explains or controls how something happens or works
- synonym: rule, creed, code

deflect

strip

v. to remove the surface from something; (noun) a sizeable narrow piece of something such as paper, metal, cloth, etc., or area of land, sea, etc.

equation

- the act of regarding as equal; (mathematics) a statement that expresses the equality of two expressions by connecting them with the equals sign

prediction

n. the act of predicting the future by reasoning; a statement made about the future

synonym: forecast, anticipation, foretelling

underlying

adj. significant as a cause or basis of something but not immediately apparent or stated clearly

synonym: fundamental, latent, basic

indicator

n. something that shows or points out what a situation is like or how a situation is changing

synonym: barometer, signal, index

adj. doubting that something is accurate or useful synonym: doubtful, distrustful, suspicious

v. to think about in-depth and evaluate to discover essential features or meaning

synonym: explore, examine, investigate

fragile

adj. delicate or easily broken or damagedsynonym: delicate, brittle, breakable
