to settle a problem or disagreement by mutual concession

 a time of great disagreement, confusion, or danger when problems must be resolved or critical decisions must be taken *synonym*: concern, problem, emergency

disappoint

frame

tip

the top or extreme point of something slender or tapering, usually a mountain or hill; a piece of advice about something practical; a small amount of money given for services

synonym: edge, advice, gratuity

handicap

 a physical or mental condition that limits a person's movements, senses, or activities

synonym: disability, impairment, limitation

 something that exists and can be perceptible, especially one that is not fully understood

synonym: marvel, wonder, splendor
