methane

- a chemical compound with the chemical formula CH4 with no smell or color, often used as a fuel

caddy

n. a container or carrier for holding and transporting small items, such as tea or golf clubs

synonym: container, carrier, holder

depress

app

synonym: application, software

The discovery of a critical bug caused the company to delay the **app's** release.

canteen

 a small cafeteria or dining hall, especially one in a military or school setting

synonym: mess hall, cafeteria, eatery
