## categorize

synonym: classify, pigeonhole, sort

## disgust

- n. a strong feeling of dislike or disapprovalsynonym: nauseate, hate, dislike

#### sniff

v. to inhale audibly through the nose, often to detect or identify a smell; to draw in air through the nostrils with a quick, audible intake of breath

synonym: smell, inhale, scent

(1) **sniff** the air, (2) **sniff** the perfume

The dog stopped to **sniff** around the tree, looking for something interesting.

bud

a small swelling on a plant stem or twig containing an undeveloped shoot

synonym: shoot, sprout, germ

(1) pinch off a bud, (2) bud grafting

The flower was starting to show its **bud** and would soon bloom into a beautiful blossom.

#### whack

- v. to hit someone or something hard or noisily synonym: hit, strike, bash
- (1) **whack** him with a stick, (2) **whack** up the volume He **whacked** the ball out of the park with his home run.

#### attache

 a person who works at an embassy, usually having a specialized area of responsibility; a shallow and rectangular briefcase

synonym: diplomat, envoy, briefcase

(1) a commercial **attache**, (2) black **attache** case A prime minister talked with a military **attache** of the country's embassy.

#### saltiness

- n. the quality or state of being salty
- (1) the taste of **saltiness**, (2) enhance the **saltiness**. She tasted the dish and detected a slight **saltiness**.

#### umami

 a taste sensation that is often described as savory, meaty, or brothy; one of the five basic tastes, along with sweet, sour, salty, and bitter

synonym: savory, delicious, meaty

(1) umami enhancer, (2) umami flavor

Japanese food lovers appreciate the **umami** taste of miso soup.

## savory

adj. pleasing to the taste, especially by being salty, sour, or spicy rather than sweet

synonym: delicious, tasty, appetizing
