trajectory

the curved path followed by an object moving through space

synonym: course, curve, orbit

The company has shown an excellent growth **trajectory** over the years.

disinvestment

 the act of reducing or withdrawing the amount of money you have provided in a particular area or sector

synonym: divestment, withdrawal, pullout

The company's decision to engage in **disinvestment** led to a reduction in its overall portfolio.

hypervacancy

 a situation in which a high proportion of homes or commercial properties in a given area stand vacant or unoccupied, often due to economic decline or urban sprawl

exodus

redeem

v. to compensate for the faults or bad aspects of something; to regain possession or assume ownership of something by paying a sum of money or fulfilling a condition; to rescue or save someone from a difficult or hopeless situation

synonym: rescue, save, recover

(1) **redeem** a coupon, (2) **redeem** a government bond He tried to **redeem** himself by volunteering at the local charity after his mistakes.

capitalize

to write a whole letter or the first letter of the alphabet as a capital; to provide a company, etc. with the money; to take the chance to gain advantage from something

synonym: bankroll, finance, endow

undervalue
