sunrise

 the time in the morning when the sun first appears in the sky

sunset

the time in the evening at which the sun begins to fall below the horizon; (verb) to expire or be terminated automatically at the end of a fixed period

excavate

- v. to dig or remove earth, rocks, or other materials from the ground or a site, often to uncover or discover something synonym: dig, unearth, extract

surrounding

adj. that is near or around, or closely encircling something *synonym*: circumferent, encircling, neighboring

matrix

 a rectangular array of numbers, symbols, or expressions, arranged in rows and columns and often enclosed in brackets; an enclosure within which something originates or develops synonym: grid, cast, table

The **matrix** of numbers on the spreadsheet allowed the accountant to track the company's profits and losses easily.

isolate

 to physically or socially separate someone or something from other people or things

synonym: separate, sequester, insulate

 You should not isolate them from the community.

squid

 a sea creature with a long and soft body, large eyes, eight arms, and two tentacles (= long parts like arms), and that is sometimes used for food

synonym: calamari, calamary

(1) a **squid's** tentacle, (2) **squid** ink spaghetti The giant **squid** weighed over 50 kilograms.

ammonite

n. a type of prehistoric marine animal that lived during the Jurassic and Cretaceous periods characterized by their spiral shape and intricate chambered shells, which are often preserved as fossils

synonym: fossil, shell, cephalopod

(1) ammonite shell, (2) ancient ammonite

A group of paleontologists discovered an **ammonite** fossil on their latest dig.

shell

 hard outer covering or case of eggs, nuts, some seeds, and some animals

synonym: ammunition, armor, cover

(1) an egg shell, (2) a mollusk shell

The outermost electron **shell** determines the chemical properties of an atom.

ecosystem

 all the plants and living creatures in an area and the way they affect each other and the environment (1) marine **ecosystem**, (2) change the **ecosystem**Human conservation efforts often fail unexpectedly because they disturb the balance of the **ecosystem**.

exposed

adj. having no protection or shield from something, such as bad weather, attack, or criticism

synonym: endangered, revealed, disclosed

degrade

v. to make something worse, especially in quality; to show or treat someone in a way that makes them seem no value and do not have the respect or reasonable opinion of others

consolidant

robust

eventually

measurement

 the act or process of finding something's size, quantity, or degree

skull

 a bone framework that surrounds the brain and gives the head its shape

synonym: cranium, scalp, brain

conservation

 the protection of something important, such as the natural environment or artificial structures, especially from the damaging effects of human activity synonym: preservation, protection, saving

n. the consideration or examination of the similarities between two or more people or things
