synonym: dash, connection

#### mumble

v. to speak quietly, unclearly, or in a way that is difficult to understand; to murmur or mutter inarticulately

synonym: murmur, mutter, whisper

#### Negro

n. ("Negro" is now considered out of date and offensive) a term that was once used to refer to people of African descent, especially those living in the United States

synonym: African American

(1) **Negro** literature, (2) American **Negro** 

They developed **Negro** blues with a lively rhythm.

#### jean

 a sturdy cotton twill fabric, typically blue, used for jeans and other clothing

synonym: denim, cotton, pants

(1) a jean skirt, (2) jean denim

She wore her favorite pair of **jeans** to the party.

### smartphone

- a mobile phone that functions as a computer and connects to the Internet
- (1) **smartphone** app developer, (2) **smartphone** addict Internet traffic volumes have increased significantly with the advent of **smartphones**.

#### boardroom

a room where the board of directors of a company or organization meets

synonym: meeting room, conference room, executive room

(1) **boardroom** meeting, (2) **boardroom** decision

The corporate **boardroom** was filled with tense silence as the CEO presented the new plan.

#### elusive

*adj.* difficult to find, define, achieve, or remember *synonym*: mysterious, ambiguous, inapproachable

(1) an **elusive** criminal, (2) track down an **elusive** fact
The physicist who found the **elusive** particle won the Nobel
Prize.

#### pave

v. to cover something with a hard, flat material such as stones, bricks, or concrete, to make it suitable for travel or use

synonym: surface, coat, cover

(1) pave a new path, (2) pave a smoother road

They **paved** the courtyard with bricks, giving it a more polished appearance.

#### anthem

 a rousing or uplifting song identified with a particular group, body, or cause

synonym: hymn, song, paean

(1) a national anthem, (2) anthem singer

The **anthem** of the country was played during the ceremony.

#### contralto

 the lowest female singing voice or voice part, usually ranging from F below middle C to second F above middle C

synonym: alto

(1) contralto singer, (2) rich contralto range

The singer's deep **contralto** voice was perfect for the opera's lead role.

## scrapbook

 a book or album filled with photographs, clippings, and other memorabilia that are collected and arranged in a creative or meaningful way; a collection of memories or mementos

*synonym*: album, collection

(1) scrapbook pages, (2) digital scrapbook

My grandmother keeps all her photos in a **scrapbook**.

#### yell

v. to shout in a sudden and loud way

synonym: shout, scream, cry

(1) **yell** for help, (2) **yell** as loud as we can

When I asked my father for more money, he became furious and **yelled** at me.

#### heirloom

n. a valuable object, typically a piece of jewelry, artwork, or household item, that is passed down from generation to generation as a family heirloom; something that has special sentimental or historical value

synonym: heritage, inheritance, legacy

(1) **heirloom** jewelry, (2) family **heirloom** 

The family recipe for apple pie has become an **heirloom** tradition.

#### priceless

adj. extremely valuable or importantsynonym: invaluable, incalculable, precious

(1) **priceless** work of art, (2) **priceless** opportunity Investigators discovered **priceless** documents throughout the house.

#### henceforth

adv. starting from this time; from now onsynonym: hereafter, henceforward, subsequently

(1) abstain from wine **henceforth**, (2) promise never to lie **henceforth** 

This city will be henceforth recognized as the capital.

#### scatter

- v. to cause to separate and go in different directionssynonym: disperse, spread, bestrew
- (1) **scatter** seeds, (2) **scatter** around the internet The hunter's approach **scattered** the geese.

#### resonate

- v. to be filled with a deep echoing sound synonym: echo, reverberate, resound
- (1) deeply **resonate** with the consumers, (2) **resonate** in the same frequency

The sound **resonates** well in this theater.

#### laureate

- n. a person who has been awarded an honor or a prize for achievement in a particular field, especially in literature or academia; a poet who is honored for achieving the highest level of excellence in a competition or for producing a lifetime body of work

#### valueless

adj. without any value or worth; worthless; having no significance or importance

synonym: worthless, meaningless, value-free

#### chairperson

- n. the officer who presides over organization meetingssynonym: director, head, leader
- (1) vice **chairperson**, (2) the meeting elected a **chairperson**

The **chairperson** has the authority to approve or deny any request.

#### nonviolence

n. the use of peaceful means, such as civil disobedience or passive resistance, rather than violence to achieve a goal, especially in the context of political or social change

synonym: pacifism, nonresistance, peacekeeping

(1) **nonviolence** movement, (2) **nonviolence** protest Martin Luther King Jr. was a champion of **nonviolence** in the fight for civil rights.

colonel

a military rank above a lieutenant colonel and below a general

synonym: officer, military, ranking officer

(1) colonel rank, (2) brevet colonel

The Army **colonel** led the troops into battle.

## politely

adv. in a courteous or respectful manner, showing good manners or consideration for others

synonym: courteously, respectfully, graciously

(1) **politely** ask, (2) nodded **politely**

## desegregation

n. the action or process of eliminating segregation, typically of races or ethnic groups, in educational, social, or other

#### institutions

synonym: integration, assimilation

#### opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

v. to depict or describe someone or something in a painting, film, book, or other artistic work

synonym: depict, describe, illustrate

## gunpoint

n. the point of a gun, used as a threat or in an armed robbery

synonym: point, muzzle

#### daring

adj. brave and taking risks

*synonym*: audacious, bold, venturesome
