puppy

misbehavior

 behavior that is inappropriate or unacceptable, often in violation of rules, norms, or expectations

clarify

v. to make something, such as a statement or situation, less confusing and more understandable

synonym: explain, ascribe, purify

The police tried to **clarify** the facts concerning her death.

communicate

v. to share or exchange information with others by speaking, writing, moving your body, or using other signals

synonym: convey, share, transmit

Dolphins use sound to **communicate** with each other.

excitement

- n. a feeling of great enthusiasm and eagernesssynonym: thrill, exhilaration, incitement

boredom

 a state of weariness, restlessness, or impatience that arises from not being interested or engaged in an activity, task, or situation

glimpse

 a brief or partial view; the act of seeing something or someone for a very short time or only partly

synonym: glance, peek, sighting

instance

- n. a particular example or single occurrence of somethingsynonym: example, sample, illustration

encouraging

adj. giving hope, confidence, or support; inspiringsynonym: uplifting, inspiring, optimistic

(1) **encouraging** approval, (2) **encouraging** sign The test results were **encouraging** and showed improvement.

bark

 the hard outer layer of a tree; a sound made by dogs or some other animals

synonym: skin, husk, crust

conversation

n. an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

synonym: chat, discussion, dialogue

sniff

v. to inhale audibly through the nose, often to detect or identify a smell; to draw in air through the nostrils with a quick, audible intake of breath

impolite

hormone

- a chemical substance made by organs that encourages or influences the development, growth, sex, etc., of an animal and is carried around the body in the blood
- (1) hormone secretion, (2) female hormoneThe doctor diagnosed me with a hormone disorder.

consequence

 the outcome of a particular action or event, especially relative to an individual

synonym: result, impact, outcome

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These economic activities had disastrous environmental consequences.

sensitivity

the ability to perceive or respond to subtle differences or changes; the ability to understand and respond to the needs and feelings of others

synonym: alertness, attentiveness, sympathy

- the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

synonym: intellect, mind, encephalon

- to replace or repair the wiring of something, especially ν. an electrical system; to make significant changes in one's thoughts or behavior patterns

regulate

to control something, especially by means of rules or laws

synonym: control, restrain, handle

emotion

a strong feeling such as love, anger, etc. deriving from n. one's situation, mood, or relationships with others *synonym*: feeling, sentiment, passion

brain

rewire

judgment

the ability to form valuable opinions and make reasonable decisions

synonym: conclusion, decision, determination

(1) an emotional **judgment**, (2) deliver a **judgment** Her **judgments** are consistently rational and sensible.

alternate

adj. occurring or existing one after the other regularly *synonym*: substitute, back up, equivalent

(1) **alternate** choice, (2) every **alternate** year The cleaning lady comes on **alternate** Wednesdays.

shyness

n. the quality or state of being worried or embarrassed about meeting and speaking to other people

synonym: bashfulness, timidity, modesty

(1) lose some of my **shyness**, (2) **shyness** barrier He finally overcame his **shyness**.

cling

v. to hold onto something tightly; to be closely attached to someone or something

synonym: stick, adhere, attach

(1) **cling** onto power, (2) **cling** tightly to the skin He **clings** to the hope that he will find a job soon.

chew

v. to crush or grind something, especially food, with the teeth and then swallow it

synonym: masticate, crush, grind

(1) **chew** each word, (2) **chew** a stick of gum My dog loves to **chew** on bones.

highlight

v. to make something prominent, mainly so that people give it more attention

synonym: feature, emphasize, stress

(1) **highlight** a string in red, (2) **highlight** an important difference

The introduction **highlighted** the speaker's distinguished career as a consultant

convey

to express ideas, feelings, etc. so that it is known or understood by other people; to carry something from one place to another

synonym: communicate, transfer, deliver

(1) **convey** a complex idea, (2) **convey** goods by truck An ironic remark often **conveys** an intended meaning obliquely.

byzantine

adj. characterized by a complex and often convoluted administrative system or set of rules; intricate and hard to understand

synonym: complex, convoluted, labyrinthine

(1) Byzantine rites, (2) Byzantine art

The **Byzantine** Empire was known for its complex political system and culture.

interaction

the act of connecting with someone, mainly when working, playing, or spending time with them

synonym: dealings, exchange, relations

- (1) the **interaction** between man and his environment,
- (2) **interaction** among human beings

The **interaction** of the two groups is good for brainstorming.

appropriate

adj. suitable or proper in the circumstances; fitting *synonym*: fitting, suitable, proper

(1) appropriate behavior, (2) an appropriate time It would be appropriate to dress nicely for the wedding.

clue

an object, a piece of evidence, or some information that helps someone to find the answer to a problem, question, or mystery

synonym: hint, indication, inkling

- (1) a **clue** about the crime, (2) a **clue** to the diagnosis The police couldn't find a **clue** to her whereabouts.
- a word that takes the place of a noun in a sentence, pronoun such as "he," "she," "they," or "it"

(1) **pronoun** usage, (2) possessive **pronoun** In English, personal **pronouns** such as "he," "she," and "they" can replace a person's name to avoid repetition.

identity

n. the fact of being who or what somebody or something is; the features, emotions, or ideas that distinguish persons from one another

synonym: character, personality, individuality

- (1) mistaken **identity**, (2) **identity** as an individual The terrorist's **identity** remains unknown.
- *n.* a thing, typically a small model or replica of something that is played with, especially by children

synonym: plaything, game, trinket

(1) **toy** store, (2) **toy** box

He gave his daughter a new toy for her birthday.

guilty

adj. feeling responsible for or having done something wrong or criminal

synonym: culpable, blameworthy, at fault

(1) feel a bit **guilty**, (2) **guilty** verdict

After much contemplation, the suspect decided to plead **guilty** to the theft charge.

guilt

 the fact of having committed something illegal; the negative feelings caused by believing or knowing that you have done something wrong

synonym: regret, remorse, blame

(1) criminal guilt, (2) feeling of guilt

Shame and **guilt** have significant social influences.

submissive

 adj. inclined or willing to submit or yield to authority, domination, or direction; obedient or compliant; meek or passive

synonym: compliant, obedient, docile

(1) **submissive** behavior, (2) a **submissive** personality The **submissive** dog cowered and trembled in fear when

environment

n. the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

(1) environment affairs, (2) chaotic environment

Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's **environment**.

enrich

v. to make better or improve in quality by adding something else

synonym: enhance, improve, augment

(1) **enrich** a gas with a balloon, (2) **enrich** public services Reading not only increases knowledge but also **enriches** life.

interact

- v. to communicate or react with somebody
- synonym: cooperate, combine, collaborate
- (1) **interact** directly with customers, (2) **interact** with one another

He should interact more with his colleagues.

translate

- v. to convert or change words into another language synonym: convert, transcribe, render
- (1) **translate** a document into English, (2) **translate** the emotion to a movement

Translate the text from Italian into English.

opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

umwelt

n. the environmental or perceptual world that an organism or individual experiences, particularly concerning the human experience of reality as shaped by cultural, psychological, and physiological factors synonym: environment, surroundings, habitat

A fish's **umwelt** differs from a bird's because they are adapted to different environments.

worldview

 a particular philosophy or cognitive orientation of life or conception of the world

synonym: perspective, position, viewpoint

(1) mainstream **worldview**, (2) the **worldview** of the ancient civilization

The war between the two countries was also a battle between competing **worldviews**.

perspective

a confident attitude toward something; a particular style of thinking about something

synonym: viewpoint, standpoint, outlook

(1) a **perspective** view, (2) the **perspective** of the battle His father's death changed his whole **perspective** on life.

profound

- adj. extremely great; sensed or experienced very strongly;displaying a high level of knowledge or comprehensionsynonym: deep, unsounded, far-reaching
- (1) a **profound** book, (2) the **profound** depths of the sea My mother's illness had a **profound** impact on us all.

overthrow

v. to defeat or remove a leader or a government from a position of power by force

synonym: defeat, destroy, conquer

(1) **overthrow** the government, (2) **overthrow** the theory The group aims to **overthrow** the military regime.

evolutionary

adj. relating to or denoting how living things develop or change from earlier forms

synonym: developmental, mutative, transformative

(1) ecology and **evolutionary** biology, (2) the **evolutionary** process

Evolutionary algorithms can find ways to optimize that humans do not anticipate.

descent

n. the act or process of moving downward; a person's family origins

synonym: fall, drop, family

(1) **descent** from nobility, (2) **descent** of family

The **descent** from the mountain was steep and rocky.

ancient

adj. relating to the long ago, particularly the historical period preceding the fall of the Western Roman Empire; very old

synonym: archaic, age-old, obsolete

(1) pre-Christian ancient, (2) ancient stories

They have been living near water since **ancient** times.

vestige

 a trace, mark, or evidence of something that once existed but has now disappeared or diminished

synonym: trace, remnant, relic

(1) a **vestige** of a castle wall, (2) a **vestige** of the virus The abandoned building was a **vestige** of the city's past, with nothing left but memories.

urge

v. to spur on or encourage someone, especially by cheers and shouts; (noun) a strong desire or impulse, especially one that is difficult to control or resist

synonym: push for, advise, (noun) impulse

(1) urge a total ban, (2) a sexual urge

The lobbyist urged Congress not to approve the measure.

moving

adj. causing strong emotions or feelings, especially sadness or sympathy

synonym: emotional, poignant, touching

(1) **moving** experience, (2) **moving** ceremony His **moving** speech about his struggles with addiction brought tears to the audience's eyes.

prey

the object of a hunt; an animal hunted or trapped for eating

synonym: target, quarry, chase

(1) **prey** of beast, (2) become **prey** to terrorists The majority of snakes swallow their **prey** whole.

similarly

adv. in almost the same way synonym: also, likewise, ditto

- (1) **similarly** situated, (2) have **similarly** great abilities We argue that wages for temporary workers should **similarly** rise.
- to pass the tongue over something to moisten, taste, or eat

synonym: taste, moisten, sweep

(1) **lick** a teaspoon, (2) **lick** its wounds She **licked** the envelope to seal it before mailing it.

to say hello to someone; to express welcome on meeting someone

synonym: welcome, salute, acknowledge

(1) greet a customer, (2) greet an idea He **greeted** his friends with a warm smile and a hug.

- to find or discover someone or something that was lost synonym: seek, follow, depict
- (1) **trace** a telephone call, (2) **trace** back to medieval times Let's **trace** the origins of some familiar foreign words.

ancestry

- the family or the ethnic descent that you come from *synonym*: ancestor, family, descent
- (1) a distinguished **ancestry**, (2) prehuman **ancestry** He looked down on the royal **ancestry** of the neighboring country.

lick

greet

trace

hunt

v. to go after and try to catch wild animals to kill them for food, sport, or profit

synonym: chase, pursuit, quest

(1) hunt a job, (2) hunt after knowledge

Hounds **hunt** their prey by using their keen scent.

mob

 a large and disorderly crowd of people; a large horde of animals

synonym: crowd, throng, horde

(1) **mob** psychology, (2) **mob** violence

The excited **mob** was getting out of control at the concert.

prompt

v. to make someone decide to or try to do something, or to make something happen

synonym: actuate, inspire, incite

(1) **prompt** a feeling of hunger, (2) **prompt** a debate That incident **prompted** a nationwide chain reaction regarding the crackdown on illegal groups.

regurgitate

v. to bring back partially digested food from the stomach to the mouth; to repeat or recite something without understanding or adding anything new or original

synonym: repeat, echo, restate

regurgitate food, (2) regurgitate information
 The biology student had to regurgitate all the material she

had learned for the final exam.

spat

n. a minor quarrel or dispute, often one that is short-lived or insignificant; a sudden burst of activity or energy; a young oyster, clam, or other bivalves that has recently attached itself to a surface in its natural habitat

synonym: argument, disagreement, oyster

(1) minor **spat**, (2) clean up the **spat**

The **spat** between the two neighbors escalated into a heated argument.

fur

n. the hairy coat of a mammal, especially when fine, soft, and thick

synonym: hair, coat, pelt

(1) an artificial fur, (2) fur coat

The **fur** of the animal was thick and soft to the touch.

peek

 a quick or furtive look; (verb) to take a quick and secret look at something

synonym: glimpse, look, glance

(1) sneak **peek**, (2) **peek** at others' misfortune

She took a quick **peek** inside the box before closing it again.

perception

 a belief, opinion, or image you have based on how you regard, understand, or interpret something; the ability to see, hear, or notice something through the senses

synonym: understanding, idea, awareness

(1) keen **perception**, (2) **perception** of a stimulus He is a man admired for the depth of his **perception**.

olfactory

adj. relating to the sense of smell; connected with the perception of odors or scents

synonym: olfactive, scent-based, aromatic

(1) olfactory cortex, (2) olfactory memory

The **olfactory** senses play a key role in our taste and flavor perception.

creature

n. a living being, especially an animal

synonym: being, animal, organism

(1) creature of habit, (2) artificial creature

The deep sea **creature** was unlike anything the scientists had ever seen before.

receptor

- an organ having nerve endings that respond to stimulation such as heat or cold and makes the body react in a particular way
- (1) cellular **receptor**, (2) **receptor** for HIV in humans Hay fever occurs when a substance called histamine binds to

receptors in the nose and eyes.

alien

 a person who comes from a different country, race, or group; a form of life assumed to exist outside the Earth or its atmosphere

synonym: foreigner, unfamiliar, unknown

(1) alien fungi, (2) resident aliens

Alien species have drastically altered the ecosystem in this area.

accustomed

- adj. familiar with; used to; in the habit of; having become habituated to something, often a behavior or situationsynonym: familiar, customary, habitual
- (1) **accustomed** routine, (2) **accustomed** to complaints I am **accustomed** to waking up early for work.

misunderstand

- v. to interpret or understand something in the wrong way synonym: misinterpret, misperceive, misapprehend
- (1) **misunderstand** each other, (2) **misunderstand** entirely about her

You should not misunderstand the meaning of freedom.

perceive

v. to become aware or conscious of something through the senses

synonym: sense, discern, feel

(1) **perceive** a threat, (2) **perceive** light

Australia is widely **perceived** as having low levels of corruption.

relation

 the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another

synonym: association, linkage, connection

(1) **relation** between cause and effect, (2) **relation** of inclusion

The industrial **relations** laws were passed with little to no alteration.

pup

- n. a young dog, seal, or other animals
- synonym: puppy, whelp, cub
- (1) pup company, (2) playful pup

The little **pup** was so cute, with big, floppy ears and a wagging tail.

aim

- v. to try or plan to get or achieve something
- synonym: aspire, direct, target
- (1) **aim** at a specific target, (2) **aim** to be a nurse We **aim** for an overseas expansion.

grasp

- v. to take hold of something or someone quickly and firmly
- synonym: grab, clasp, grip
- (1) grasp his hand, (2) grasp a chance

They spent a lot of time trying to **grasp** the current situation.

sequence

- *n.* a series of related events, actions, numbers, etc., which have a particular order
- synonym: arrangement, succession, series
- (1) the **sequence** of the seasons, (2) the DNA **sequence** We do move forward with those tasks in **sequence** next week.

publicly

- adv. in a manner accessible to or observable by the public; by the government
- synonym: candidly, openly, honestly

cooperative

- adj. involving doing something jointly or working with others to achieve a common goal
- synonym: harmonious, collegial, helpful
- cooperative savings, (2) fishing cooperative
 we appreciate your cooperative efforts.

hike

n. a long walk or journey, especially for pleasure or exercise; an increase in cost

synonym: walk, trek, excursion

(1) go on a hike, (2) a hike in prices

The family decided to **hike** in the mountains to enjoy the beautiful scenery.

flexible

adj. able to change or be changed to suit new conditions or situations; able to bend easily

synonym: adaptable, elastic, pliable

(1) flexible schedules, (2) a flexible wire

You can be more **flexible** and creative in your approach.

instantly

adv. immediately

synonym: immediately, right away, directly

(1) **instantly** cope with, (2) be killed **instantly**

I remembered that person **instantly** and never forgot.

anticipate

v. to expect or predict that something will happen; to tell in advance

synonym: forecast, predict, expect

(1) **anticipate** your kind cooperation, (2) **anticipate** a black future

We anticipate heavy snowfall tomorrow.

genetic

adj. of or relating to genes (= parts of the DNA in cells) or the science of genes

synonym: hereditary, genetical, inborn

(1) have genetic testing, (2) a genetic disorder

Understanding protein folding is a vital step in deciphering the **genetic** code.

makeup

 colored substances used on someone's face to improve or change their appearance

synonym: maquillage, composition, cosmetic

(1) makeup artist, (2) take the makeup off her face

Her beauty resulted from a good night's sleep rather than **makeup**.

sensitive

 adj. able to notice slight changes, signals, or influences; able to feel or perceive other's feelings; susceptible to the things people say or do

synonym: exposed, susceptible, keen

(1) **sensitive** documents, (2) baby with **sensitive** skin The teacher is very **sensitive** to children's feelings.

steep

- adj. having a sharp inclination or slope synonym: sheer, precipitous, abrupt
- (1) a **steep** staircase, (2) **steep** discount The **steep** cliff made it difficult to climb.

appreciate

- v. to value and acknowledge the worth of someone or something; to be grateful for something or someonesynonym: acknowledge, admire, enjoy
- (1) **appreciate** her feedback, (2) **appreciate** the value We would **appreciate** an early reply.

parallel

 adj. being everywhere equidistant and not intersecting; of or relating to the simultaneous performance of multiple operations

synonym: aligned, side-by-side, similar

(1) a **parallel** case, (2) **parallel** processing He walked a road **parallel** to the railroad.

prelude

 an introductory or preparatory piece of music often played before a larger work or performance; a preliminary or introductory event or action

synonym: introduction, opening, prologue

(1) prelude music, (2) ominous prelude

The book's introductory chapter provided a **prelude** to the rest of the story.

settle

- to reach an agreement of disagreement synonym: inhabit, occupy, decide
- (1) **settle** a dispute, (2) **settle** down in the town I don't want to **settle** for second best.

tradition

a belief, custom, or way of doing something that has n. been passed down from generation to generation within a group or society

synonym: custom, practice, ritual

- (1) a tradition of a culture, (2) against tradition It is a tradition in many families to have a big Thanksgiving dinner with all their relatives.
- to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

relieve

to make something burdensome, unpleasant, or painful less severe

synonym: alleviate, ease, assuage

(1) relieve his thirst, (2) relieve stress

The medicine **relieved** his headache, and he felt much better.

structure

the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

(1) the **structure** of a machine, (2) **structure** and function of the brain

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

restructure

v. to organize a company, business, or system in a new and different way to make it work more effectively

synonym: reorganize, revamp, reconstruct

(1) restructure sentence, (2) restructure my debtsThe economic downturn made it necessary to restructure

the business.

eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

synonym: finally, someday, ultimately

(1) **eventually** become obsolete, (2) **eventually** succeed The corporation **eventually** dominated the entire tobacco business.

zoom

v. to move along very quickly; (noun) the act of rising upward into the air
