podium

- a raised platform or stand that is used for delivering speeches, conducting meetings, or presenting awards
 synonym: lectern, stand, dais

 The speaker stood confidently on the **podium** while delivering their speech.

synonym: revolution, RPM, speed

inaccessible

Heavy snow made it **inaccessible** to go to the mountain village.

suffice

synonym: satisfy, meet, be enough

aspiration

 a strong desire to achieve something; the action or process of drawing breath

synonym: ambition, inhalation, intake

spectator

n. someone present at an event, such as a sports game,play, or concert, to watch or observe it

synonym: onlooker, observer, viewer
