### blueprint

 a photographic print of an early plan for a building or machine

synonym: draft, prototype, sketch

(1) **blueprint** for economic reform, (2) architect's **blueprint** A business plan is a **blueprint** for your success.

#### entertainer

 a performer who provides amusement or enjoyment to an audience, often through acting, music, dancing, or comedy

*synonym*: performer, artist, showman

(1) **entertainer** of the year, (2) comedy **entertainer**The dancer is a talented **entertainer** who captivates her audience with graceful movements.

#### contend

- v. to struggle to win or surmount something synonym: compete, oppose, argue
- (1) **contend** that tobacco is nonaddictive, (2) **contend** for a championship

Tobacco companies have long **contended** that their product is not addictive.

#### entail

v. to involve or require something as necessary, particularly as a consequence of a particular situation or action; to impose a burden or restriction on something

synonym: involve, necessitate, require

(1) **entail** legal consequences, (2) **entail** risks

The job offer **entails** a lot of responsibility and hard work.

#### coddle

v. to treat somebody with too much indulgence; to cook in water just below boiling point

synonym: indulge, pamper, baby

(1) **coddle** a patient, (2) **coddle** eggs You **coddle** your daughter too much.

## terrify

- v. to frighten someone very much synonym: unnerve, scare, horrify
- (1) terrify people, (2) the threats terrify him

It would be best not to **terrify** your associates into doing complex tasks.

#### recital

 a public performance of music or dance, usually by a soloist or a group of performers; a detailed account of events or facts

synonym: performance, concert, show

(1) poetry **recital**, (2) give a **recital** at the hall Her piano **recital** was a great success, and she received a standing ovation.

# offstage

adv. in a location outside of the stage area in a theater or other performance venue; not visible to the audience or spectators

synonym: backstage, behind the scenes, off-camera

(1) crack jokes **offstage** during the break, (2) quickly move the props **offstage** 

The actors were waiting anxiously **offstage** for their cue to go on.

# grimace

v. to make a facial expression that shows pain, disgust, or discomfort; (noun) a facial expression that shows pain or disgust, marked by wrinkling of the forehead, tightness of the face, and twisting of the mouth

synonym: frown, scowl, sneer

(1) **grimace** in pain, (2) try to hide a **grimace** 

I couldn't help but **grimace** when I tasted the sour milk in my cereal.

# chipmunk

 a small, striped rodent native to North America and Asia, characterized by a short bushy tail and large cheek pouches used for storing food

synonym: ground squirrel, striped squirrel

(1) chipmunk cheeks, (2) playful chipmunk

I saw a cute **chipmunk** scurrying across the lawn.

#### carcass

 the dead body of an animal, especially one that has been killed for food

*synonym*: corpse, remains, body

#### buzzkill

 an event, person, or thing that dampens the excitement or pleasure of a situation, typically by introducing an unwelcome or unpleasant element

synonym: party pooper, killjoy, wet blanket

bud

a small swelling on a plant stem or twig containing an undeveloped shoot

#### scrub


