### impermanent

### piercing

#### attune

v. to make receptive or aware; to bring into harmony or alignment

#### insane

adj. extremely stupid, crazy, or dangerous; mentally ill synonym: crazy, mad, foolish

#### stoic

adj. calm and unemotional, especially in difficult situations;(noun) a member of the ancient Greek school of philosophy founded by Zeno

synonym: unflappable, resigned, unemotional

He was known for his **stoic** demeanor, never showing emotion or weakness.

#### memento

 an object or item that serves to remind someone of a person, event, or experience; a keepsake or souvenir

synonym: souvenir, keepsake, reminder

(1) symbolic memento, (2) a small memento

The photo album was filled with **mementos** from their trip around the world.

### calm

adj. not excited, angry, or nervous; free from wind, large waves

synonym: quiet, peaceful, tranquility

### precious

adj. uncommon and extremely valuable

synonym: adored, cherished, valued

### explicit

adj. stated clearly and in detail, leaving no room for confusion or doubt

synonym: clear, unambiguous, unequivocal

(1) explicit content, (2) explicit instructions

### fragility

 the quality of being easily broken, damaged, or destroyed; the state of being delicate or vulnerable

synonym: delicacy, weakness, frailty

(1) fragility of life, (2) emotional fragility

The **fragility** of the glass required careful handling during shipping.

situ

adj. short for "situated," meaning located or placed in a particular position or circumstance

synonym: situational, contextual, circumstantial

Melanoma in **situ** is considered the earliest stage of melanoma and has a high cure rate with appropriate treatment.

#### **fundamental**

adj. forming an essential base or core from which everything else develops or is affected

synonym: basic, essential, entire

(1) **fundamental** education, (2) **fundamental** rights Human behavior has **fundamental** characteristics.

### aspect

- *n.* one part or feature of a situation, problem, subject, etc. *synonym*: characteristic, element, factor

#### wizard

a person who is skilled in magic or a particular technical field

synonym: sorcerer, magician, alchemist

(1) a wizard at chess, (2) financial wizard

He was a **wizard** at solving complex mathematical equations.

#### rainbow

 an arch of colors in the sky caused by the refraction and dispersion of sunlight through rain

synonym: spectrum, iridescence, prism

(1) marine **rainbow**, (2) **rainbow** after a storm She was mesmerized by the **rainbow's** colors.

### religion

 a deep conviction in a supernatural power that controls human destiny

synonym: faith, creed, belief

religion sociology, (2) freedom of religion
 Their religion strictly prohibits them from drinking or

gambling.

#### beloved

adj. loved very much

synonym: adored, cherished, dear

(1) **beloved** author, (2) **beloved** by many people I am here to save my **beloved**.

#### creative

 adj. relating to or involving the use of skill and original and unusual ideas to create something

synonym: imaginative, innovative, inventive

(1) **creative** writing, (2) barren of **creative** spirit

All the supervisor has to do is assign tasks that make his subordinates more **creative**.

#### vision

 n. the ability to think about or see the future with imagination and intelligence; the faculty of being able to see

*synonym*: sight, image, concept

gap

 a conspicuous disparity or difference separates something such as a figure, people, their opinions, situation, etc.

synonym: opening, lacuna, spread

violin

 a four-stringed wooden musical instrument held against the neck and played by passing a bow across the strings

synonym: fiddle

The cello is a member of the **violin** family.

#### rocket

mar

a large tube-shaped object that moves very first by a n. stream of gases let out behind it, used for space travel or as a weapon

synonym: projectile, missile

- to damage or spoil the appearance or surface of something

synonym: damage, deface, disfigure

### etymology

- the study of the origin and history of words, including changes in meaning and form over time; the history of a particular word or phrase

#### hasten

to move or act quickly; to cause or encourage something to happen sooner or more rapidly; to accelerate or speed up

synonym: accelerate, hurry, rush

### compose

to write music, poetry, or formal writing; to constitute or ν. make up a whole, or a specified part of it

synonym: compile, constitute, build

(1) **compose** an essay, (2) **compose** my thoughts The structure is **composed** of three main components.

### symphony

 a long musical composition in Western classical music for orchestra, usually with three or four main parts called movements

synonym: orchestra, harmony, concert

### spiritual

adj. relating to or affecting the human spirit or soul as opposed to material or physical things

synonym: otherworldly, ethereal, transcendental

The meditation class was focused on finding inner peace and cultivating a more **spiritual** connection with the universe.

### manifestation

 a visible or tangible form of something, especially a particular sign of a disease or condition

synonym: expression, embodiment, presentation

The **manifestation** of his anxiety was evident in his shaking hands.

### define

v. to state or explain precisely the nature, scope, or meaning of something

*synonym*: characterize, depict, express

(1) **define** a word, (2) **define** my position

To advance this discussion, we must **define** "success" rigorously.

tap

 to hit someone or something quickly, gently, and often repeatedly; to use existing resources, such as energy, knowledge, etc.

synonym: knock, exploit, use

(1) **tap** a new market, (2) **tap** keyboard with an index finger To expand the company, we must **tap** new human resources.

### quotation

 a group of words taken from a text or speech and repeated by someone other than the original author or speaker

synonym: excerpt, passage, quote

(1) double **quotation** marks, (2) take a **quotation** He included a **quotation** from the book in his essay.

#### poet

n. a person who writes poetrysynonym: versifier, rhymer, writer

(1) a court **poet**, (2) a **poet** of sorts
She is a talented **poet** who has been recognized for her work.

### quote

 to repeat or reproduce the words or statement of someone else, often acknowledging the source; to give an estimated cost or price for goods or services

synonym: cite, reference, mention

(1) quote a source, (2) quote a price

In his speech, he **quoted** a famous philosopher to emphasize his point.

#### context

 the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

(1) historical context, (2) legal context

It's important to understand the **context** of a situation before making a decision.

#### poem

 a piece of writing that emphasizes the expression of feelings and ideas by paying particular attention to diction (sometimes rhyme), rhythm, and imagery

synonym: ballad, lyric, verse

(1) a narrative **poem**, (2) **poem** to the dead

A great **poem** is a fountain forever overflowing with the waters of wisdom and delight.

### pray

- v. to make a request or petition to a higher power, especially in the form of a respectful or humble request synonym: implore, supplicate, entreat
- (1) pray devoutly, (2) pray for rain

She closed her eyes and **prayed** for strength to overcome difficult times.

### cynical

- adj. believing that people are motivated by self-interest;distrustful of human sincerity or integrity
- synonym: skeptical, mistrustful, doubtful
- (1) **cynical** remarks, (2) **cynical** worldview

  He was very **cynical** and didn't believe anything anyone said unless he saw evidence for himself.

#### observation

- the act or activity of carefully examining or monitoring something or someone
- synonym: watching, notice, reflection

### grief

- n. a very great sadness, especially when somebody diessynonym: anguish, desperation, dismay
- (1) have **grief** and sorrow, (2) a lot of **grief** Each person has a unique **grief** experience.

#### union

- n. a group of employees who have banded together to advocate for their rights and better their working conditions; the act or the state of joining together or being joined together
- synonym: alliance, coalition, confederation
- bank and credit unions, (2) a craft union
   trade union remained adamant about its demands.

### purity

 the state of being undiluted or unmixed with anything else; the state of being free from immorality, especially of a sexual nature

synonym: sinlessness, innocence, cleanliness

### atheist

a person who denies or disbelieves the existence of a deity or deities

synonym: nonbeliever, unbeliever, secularist

(1) atheist community, (2) atheist belief

She was an atheist without any belief in a higher power.

#### disbeliever

 a person who does not believe in something, such as a religion or idea

synonym: non-believer, skeptic, doubter

(1) persuade a **disbeliever**, (2) stubborn **disbeliever** Despite the evidence, she remained a **disbeliever** in the theory of evolution.

### dichotomy

a division or contrast between two things that are or are represented as being opposed or entirely different; a sharp contrast between two opposing and mutually exclusive categories or concepts

synonym: division, duality, contrast

(1) moral **dichotomy**, (2) psychological **dichotomy**The **dichotomy** between good and evil is common in literature and philosophy.

#### ultimate

*adj.* furthest or highest in degree or order *synonym*: highest, maximum, foremost

(1) the **ultimate** goal in life, (2) the **ultimate** luxury Management must take **ultimate** responsibility for the accident.

### heritage

 the culture and traditions that are passed down from previous generations

synonym: legacy, tradition, inheritance

(1) heritage site, (2) historical heritage

The **heritage** of the city is reflected in its architecture.

### generation

n. all the people born and living at about the same time, regarded collectively; the production of heat or electricitysynonym: cohort, age group, era

(1) **generation** gap, (2) the **generation** of electricity

The younger **generation** has different values and beliefs than the older one.

#### holocaust

n. the systematic killing of millions of Jews and other minority groups by the Nazis during World War II, or any similar act of mass destruction

### explore

### phenomenon

something that exists and can be perceptible, especially one that is not fully understood

synonym: marvel, wonder, splendor

(1) natural phenomenon,(2) historical phenomenonA rainbow is a natural phenomenon.

### inherit

v. to receive money, property, or a title from someone after they have died

synonym: obtain, gain, acquire

(1) **inherit** estate, (2) **inherit** ancestral property After his death, his sons **inherited** his business.

### transmit

 to send or forward an electronic signal; to pass something from one person or thing to another synonym: convey, share, dispatch

(1) **transmit** the disease, (2) **transmit** information

Parents often **transmit** their characteristics to their children.

cult

 a small religious group, especially one that is not part of a larger religion and that is regarded as outside the norm; followers of an exclusive system of beliefs and practices

synonym: sect, faith, religion

(1) cult members, (2) cult's practices

The **cult** leader promised his followers that they would achieve enlightenment if they followed his teachings.

### epigenetic

adj. relating to changes in gene expression that are not caused by alterations in the underlying DNA sequence but rather by modifications to the structure of DNA or proteins that regulate gene activity

synonym: environmental, hereditary, inherited

(1) **epigenetic** inheritance, (2) **epigenetic** markers **Epigenetic** research has opened up new possibilities for the treatment of certain diseases.

### unconscious

adj. in the state of lacking awareness and the capacity for sensory perception, especially as the result of a head injury or illness

synonym: comatose, paralyzed, senseless

### backdrop

- a painted or photographed scene or setting that is used as a background for a stage, film, or other performance

### tragic

adj. causing great sadness or suffering; very unfortunate synonym: calamitous, disastrous, catastrophic

### paradox

 a statement, situation, or person that has two opposite facts or features and therefore seems impossible, is difficult to understand, or is strange;

synonym: incongruity, dichotomy, contradiction

(1) French **paradox**, (2) the **paradox** of the heap There are many theories to explain this **paradox**.

### wisdom

- n. the quality of being wise, or the ability to use your knowledge and experience to make sensible decisionssynonym: sagacity, discernment, insight
- (1) a fountain of **wisdom**, (2) **wisdom** literature

  The community greatly respected and sought after the older adult's **wisdom**.

### tradition

 a belief, custom, or way of doing something that has been passed down from generation to generation within a group or society

synonym: custom, practice, ritual

### neuroscience

- the scientific study of the function, structure, and disorder of the brain and the nervous system
- (1) the branch of **neuroscience**, (2) a theoretical concept in **neuroscience**

Our university is famous for its professors, who are well-versed in behavioral **neuroscience**.

### psychology

- n. the scientific study of mind and behavior
- (1) **psychology** experiment, (2) **psychology** of crowd

She had a master's degree in psychology.

### fascinating

adj. extremely interesting

*synonym*: alluring, intriguing, captivating

(1) **fascinating** story, (2) completely **fascinating** to me The museum houses a **fascinating** collection of Celtic artifacts.

### groundbreaking

*adj.* producing fresh findings; using novel techniques *synonym*: innovative, revolutionary

He has produced groundbreaking research on the subject.

### compassionate

adj. feeling or showing sympathy and concern for the suffering or bad luck of others

synonym: empathetic, sympathetic, merciful

(1) a **compassionate** heart, (2) **compassionate** leave My father has a serious and **compassionate** personality.

instinct

 an inborn behavioral pattern that is often responsive to specific stimuli; an innate feeling that causes you to act or believe that something is true

synonym: intuition, aptitude, feeling

(1) **instinct** for self-preservation, (2) aggressive **instinct** When faced with a dangerous situation, his initial **instinct** was to flee.

### evolutionary

adj. relating to or denoting how living things develop or change from earlier forms

synonym: developmental, mutative, transformative

(1) ecology and **evolutionary** biology, (2) the **evolutionary** process

**Evolutionary** algorithms can find ways to optimize that humans do not anticipate.

react

- v. to take action in response to something
- synonym: respond, reply, oppose
- (1) **react** at a high temperature, (2) **react** against his way of thinking

creature

- n. a living being, especially an animal
- synonym: being, animal, organism
- (1) creature of habit, (2) artificial creature

The deep sea **creature** was unlike anything the scientists had ever seen before.

survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period
- synonym: endure, persist, stay
- (1) **survive** a blizzard, (2) **survive** a plane crash

These birds can only **survive** in temperate climates.

prime

- adj. main or most important; basic
- synonym: excellent, exceptional, premium
- (1) **prime** number, (2) deputy **prime** minister

After a thorough investigation, she has been named as the **prime** suspect.

radiate

v. to spread out or emit something, such as light or heat, in all directions

synonym: give off, scatter, beam

definitely

adv. without any question and beyond doubt; clearly

synonym: absolutely, certainly, indeed

(1) **definitely** become a problem, (2) say **definitely**

#### obvious

*adj.* easy to see, discover or understand *synonym*: apparent, conspicuous, evident

(1) **obvious** reasons, (2) his conclusion was **obvious** There are **obvious** differences between the two wine-producing regions.

### propensity

 a natural inclination, preference, or tendency toward a particular activity, behavior, or opinion

synonym: tendency, inclination, disposition

(1) **propensity** for violence, (2) **propensity** to procrastinate His **propensity** for lying caused him to lose many friends.

### astonishing

adj. surprising or shocking; difficult to believesynonym: surprising, shocking, astounding

(1) **astonishing** achievement, (2) make **astonishing** gains The news of her sudden death was **astonishing** to everyone who knew her.

#### cruel

adj. feeling or showing pleasure in causing pain or suffering to others

synonym: heartless, sadistic, vicious

(1) a **cruel** and unusual punishment, (2) **cruel** joke The dictator was known for his **cruel** and oppressive regime.

#### emotion

 a strong feeling such as love, anger, etc. deriving from one's situation, mood, or relationships with others

synonym: feeling, sentiment, passion

(1) control my **emotion**, (2) afraid to show **emotion**Some **emotions** are common across cultures and backgrounds.

### specifically

adv. only associated with or meant for one thingsynonym: especially, particularly, notably

(1) designed **specifically** for men, (2) for **specifically** American customers

This ad campaign is aimed **specifically** at young women.

### hack

v. to hit and cut somebody or something roughly and violently; to find a bug in a computer program and break into their systems or networks

synonym: cut, chop, crack

(1) **hack** through the jungle, (2) **hack** into the program This blog offers a variety of tips for **hacking** everyday life.

### amazing

adj. extremely surprising, especially in a way that you like or admire

synonym: exceptional, extraordinary, wonderful

(1) **amazing** advances, (2) the most **amazing** feeling The golfer recorded an **amazing** distance.

viral

adj. relating to or caused by a virus

fight viral infections, (2) detect a viral code
 This device can more accurately detect viral pathogens.

clinic

 a building or hospital department where people can go for medical care or advice, especially of a particular condition

*synonym*: hospital, infirmary

(1) visit to the veterinary **clinic**, (2) a dental **clinic** She holds a **clinic** on Tuesday mornings.

empathy

 the ability to share another person's feelings or experiences by imagining that person's situation

*synonym*: compassion, sympathy, tenderness

full of empathy, (2) empathy for patients
 Empathy is also necessary to understand history.

### caregiving

the act of providing care and support for someone who is ill, disabled, or elderly

synonym: nurturing, caring, assisting

(1) **caregiving** process, (2) **caregiving** responsibilities She devoted her life to **caregiving**, looking after her aging parents.

#### corridor

 a hallway or passageway, especially one connecting rooms or areas within a building or structure

synonym: hallway, passageway, aisle

(1) walk along a corridor, (2) air corridor

The long **corridor** was filled with people rushing to get to their rooms before the meeting began.

### lingering

 adj. continuing for a long time; persistent; remaining in a place or situation for longer than is usual or necessary; unwilling to leave

The **lingering** smell of smoke clung to his clothes even after he left the campfire.

### passerby

 a person who is walking by or happens to be in the vicinity of a particular place or event, often without necessarily being involved in it in any way

synonym: spectator, onlooker

#### norm

- n. something that is regarded as usual, typical, or standardsynonym: criterion, mean, standard

### caption

 a title or brief explanation accompanying a photograph, illustration, or other images; a heading or inscription for a chapter, section, or document

synonym: heading, subheading, title

(1) caption text, (2) social media caption

The **caption** on the photograph helped to explain the image's content.

#### underneath

adv. under or below something else

synonym: below, under, beneath

(1) **underneath** the surface of the water, (2) **underneath** the laughter

The penny fell underneath the piano.

#### random

adj. made, done, or happening without method, conscious decision, or any regular pattern

synonym: incidental, arbitrary, unanticipated

(1) a random choice, (2) bombs fell at randomTo find drunk drivers, police conduct random tests.

#### sensation

 a feeling associated with stimulation of a sense organ or with a specific body condition; a general feeling of interest and excitement

synonym: feeling, perception, mania

(1) cause a widespread **sensation**, (2) taste **sensation** If you apply this ointment, you may feel a mild burning **sensation**.

### expand

v. to increase or to make something greater in size, number, or importance

*synonym*: extend, grow, boost

(1) **expand** a lineup, (2) **expand** agricultural output They hope to **expand** their business worldwide.

### physically

adv. in a way related to a person's body or appearance rather than their mind

(1) **physically** and mentally, (2) stay **physically** fit Having a **physically** healthy physique is essential for a great life.

### vagus

 the tenth of the twelve cranial nerves, which originates in the brainstem and innervates the throat, heart, and digestive tract; also known as the pneumogastric nerve

synonym: nerve, wandering nerve, tenth cranial nerve

(1) vagus activity, (2) vagus stimulation

The **vagus** nerve connects the brain to many different organs in the body.

#### nervous

bundle

adj. worried and anxious about something; relating to the nerves

*synonym*: neural, anxious, uneasy

- n. a group of things that are tied or wrapped together; a large amount or quantity of something; a package or parcel of things

### govern

v. to legally control and direct a country, city, group of people, etc. and be responsible for introducing new laws, organizing and maintaining public services

synonym: control, rule, preside

(1) a nation's right to **govern**, (2) **govern** a public enterprise The regulations **governing** medical malpractice claims are rigorous.

### digestion

n. the process of breaking down food in the body into smaller, more usable components, typically involving enzymes and other bodily processes; the process of assimilating, understanding, or absorbing information or ideas

*synonym*: absorption, assimilation, metabolism

(1) poor digestion, (2) impaired digestion

Overeating can lead to discomfort and slower digestion.

#### distress

- n. a feeling of great worry, sadness, pain, or discomfortsynonym: discomfort, despair, misery
- (1) a signal of distress, (2) emotional distress
