#### sunshade

 a device or material used to protect someone or something from the sun's rays, particularly a parasol or umbrella; a structure or covering that shades a window or outdoor area

synonym: umbrella, awning, parasol

The beach umbrella provided a **sunshade** for us during the hot summer day.

### origami

the Japanese art or practice of folding paper into decorative shapes and figures

synonym: paper folding, paper art

#### conceive

*synonym*: imagine, envision, concoct

#### unfold

v. to open up or spread out something that is folded or rolled up; to reveal or disclose something that was previously hidden or unknown

synonym: open, spread out, expose

(1) unfold the story, (2) unfold the stroller

The mystery **unfolded** as the detectives gathered more clues.

#### compress

v. to press or squeeze together to make something take up less space

synonym: condense, constrict, squeeze

(1) compress the chest, (2) compress gas

She **compressed** the files into a single ZIP archive to save space on her computer.

emit

v. to give off or send out something such as light, heat, sound, gas, etc.

synonym: give off, radiate, expel

(1) **emit** a gamma ray, (2) **emit** air pollution During the unloading, the container box **emits** a clicking sound.

unroll

v. to unwind or unfurl something that has been rolled up, such as a carpet or banner; to reveal or make visible something that was previously concealed or hidden

synonym: unwind, unfurl, wind off

(1) unroll the gift wrap, (2) unroll paperI unroll the mat before starting my yoga practice.

rehearse

v. to practice or repeat something, such as a performance, speech, or action, to prepare for an event or to improve one's skills; to go through the motions of a planned activity before executing it

synonym: practice, recite, drill

(1) **rehearse** an opera, (2) **rehearse** a speech The actors needed to **rehearse** their lines before the performance.

bumblebee

 a large, furry bee with black and yellow bands on its body that is known for its loud buzzing sound and its important role in pollinating plants

synonym: bee, honeybee, pollinator

(1) **bumblebee** pollination, (2) protecting **bumblebees**The sound of the **bumblebee's** wings was soothing to listen to.

centimeter

- *n.* a unit of measurement of length in the metric system, equivalent to one-hundredth of a meter
- (1) centimeter measurement, (2) thirty centimeters tall

The room was only one **centimeter** wider than the piano, making it a tight fit.

#### hover

- v. to stay in one place in the air synonym: hang, float over, drift
- (1) **hover** between life and death, (2) **hover** around the table

Two birds were **hovering** overhead.

### glowing

adj. highly enthusiastic; greatly praisedsynonym: burning, bright, flaming

(1) glowing reviews, (2) glowing cheeks

The western sky was glowing pink.

#### Jovian

adj. relating to Jupiter or its characteristicssynonym: Jupiter, giant planet

(1) Jovian satellites, (2) Jovian planet

The **Jovian** moon Europa is believed to have an ocean beneath its icy surface.

#### titanic

adj. of or having a great size, power, or influence; of or relating to Titanium (= a light, strong grey, lustrous, corrosion-resistant metallic element)

synonym: colossal, massive, immense

The **titanic** ship sank on its maiden voyage.

## hydrocarbon

- an organic compound consisting entirely of hydrogen and carbon
- (1) **hydrocarbon** production, (2) **hydrocarbon** molecules in crude oil

Burning **hydrocarbons** releases water vapor and carbon dioxide.

#### methane

 a chemical compound with the chemical formula CH4 with no smell or color, often used as a fuel (1) atmospheric **methane**, (2) reduce **methane** emissions The ignition of **methane** gas in the plant killed five employees.

#### ethane

n. a colorless, odorless hydrocarbon gas with the molecular formula C2H6 that is a basic component of natural gas and is used as a fuel source and in the production of chemicals

synonym: natural gas, methane, propane

**Ethane** combustion is an important energy source for heating and electricity generation.

### starlight
