#### crack

### phenomenon

### platform

### technological

adj. based on scientific and industrial progress

#### visible

### rarely

### countryside

### digital

### brand

#### influencer

#### livestream

#### biometric

#### entertainment

#### innovation

 the creation of a new device or process resulting from study and experimentation

#### silicon

 a chemical element with the symbol Si that is a hard, brittle crystalline solid with a blue-grey metallic luster and used for the transistors and integrated circuit chips in computers (1) silicon wafer, (2) crystalline silicon

**Silicon** is the second most abundant element on earth after oxygen.

### valley

 a long depression on the surface of the land, which typically contains a river

synonym: canyon, gorge, dale

### agriculture

 the practice or science of cultivating the land or raising stock

synonym: farming, husbandry, agribusiness

 an office or agency that specializes in a particular type of work, often related to collecting or compiling data or information

### implement

- v. to put a decision, plan, or system into effect synonym: execute, enforce, put through
- (1) **implement** a corporate strategy, (2) **implement** security measures

The government promised to **implement** a new system to control the financial crisis.

#### fertilizer

 a natural or chemical substance added to soil to make plants grow more successfully

synonym: manure

(1) a chemical **fertilizer**, (2) nonsynthetic **fertilizer**Nitrogen fixation by the Haber-Bosch method leads to the

### mass production of **fertilizers**.

### machinery

a group of large machines or the components of a machine that make it work; social institution functions or structure for doing something

synonym: apparatus, appliance, equipment

(1) heavy machinery, (2) inactive machinery The **machinery** of audit formally issued a business improvement order.

#### decline

to become gradually smaller, fewer, worse, etc.; to refuse to accept

synonym: descend, drop, deny

#### soil

- the top layer of Earth in which plants grow synonym: earth, ground, mud
- (1) soils retentive of moisture, (2) parched soil **Soil** moisture is another significant component controlling soil respiration.

### modern

adj. of or belonging to the present time or recent times synonym: contemporary, stylish, current

(1) modern poetry, (2) pre-modern agricultural society Their headquarters are in a **modern** skyscraper.

### protocol

a set of rules or procedures for transmitting data or conducting a process or activity, especially in computer networks or scientific experiments; the initial or original version of an agreement

synonym: procedure, system, method

(1) draft a **protocol**, (2) **protocol** breach The company has a strict **protocol** for handling sensitive information to ensure security.

### villager

 a person who lives in a village or small rural community;
 a person who is part of a close-knit and traditional community

synonym: resident, inhabitant, countryperson

#### terrace

 commonly paved outdoor space next to a house; a row of homes that were all constructed in the same design and shared dividing walls

### irrigation

- the agricultural practice of supplying land with water through pipes or channels so that crops grow well

### govern

#### structure

### paddy

n. a flooded field where rice is grown, also known as a rice paddy; rice that is still in its husk, harvested from marshy fields called paddies, usually in Asia

The sight of the **paddy** fields swaying in the wind was breathtaking.

### lottery

 a game of chance in which a large number of people buy tickets or chances to win a prize, with the winner(s) determined by a random drawing

### contiguous

### spray

#### dam

 a wall constructed over a river to block the flow of water, mainly used to generate energy

### organic

adj. of or derived from biological substance; producing plants and animals for food and other items without the use of

synthetic chemicals

synonym: biological

#### blacksmith

- a smith who forges and shapes iron with a hammer and anvil

#### helm

### decision-maker
