inhospitable

adj. harsh and difficult to stay in or grow; unfriendly and unwelcoming towards people who visit you

synonym: sterile, unfriendly, unwelcoming

He trekked across some of the most **inhospitable** mountains in the world.

fabricate

v. to make something, especially by assembling parts or constructing it from raw materials; to invent and present something false as true or real to deceive someone

synonym: manufacture, assemble, falsify

(1) fabricate a chemical, (2) fabricate an excuse

The detective discovered that the witness had **fabricated** her story about the crime.

trench

 a long, deep ditch made in the ground, usually parallel to a plate boundary and marking a subduction zone; a long ditch built in the ground for carrying away water

synonym: aqueduct, ditch, channel

(1) deep-sea trench, (2) trench excavator

A **trench** was being dug alongside the road by workers.

asteroid

 a small rocky body orbiting the sun, typically in the region between Mars and Jupiter

synonym: minor planet, planetoid, rocky planetesimal

(1) asteroid mining, (2) asteroid explorer

Scientists are studying the composition and origins of the **asteroid** belt to understand the early solar system better.

clamber

v. to climb or move in an awkward, laborious, or ungraceful way, often using one's hands and feet

synonym: climb, scramble, crawl

(1) **clamber** up the ladder, (2) **clamber** over a boulder I had to **clamber** over the rocks to reach the cave.

locomotion

- *n.* the action or ability to move from one place to another *synonym*: movement, travel, mobility
- (1) **locomotion** system, (2) **locomotion** control The **locomotion** of the robotic arm was smooth and precise.

situ

adj. short for "situated," meaning located or placed in a particular position or circumstance

synonym: situational, contextual, circumstantial

(1) ex- situ conservation, (2) in- situ control

Melanoma in **situ** is considered the earliest stage of melanoma and has a high cure rate with appropriate treatment.

rainforest

- a forest rich in biodiversity that is generally found in tropical settings with heavy annual rainfall
- (1) rainforest destruction, (2) tropical rainforest

The destruction of the **rainforest** is a ticking time bomb for the Earth.

vine

- a climbing plant that produces grapes; any plant with a growth habit of trailing or climbing stems
- (1) a green vine, (2) vine of ore

A **vine** remains productive throughout the year.

amplify

- v. to enhance something, particularly sound or brightness synonym: intensify, boost, argument
- (1) **amplify** a signal, (2) **amplify** the effect You might need to **amplify** this point.

improvisation

- n. the act of making something up on the spot or creating or performing something without preparation
- synonym: spontaneity, ad-lib, extemporization
- (1) **improvisation** on stage, (2) jazz **improvisation** He created a beautiful piece of music using only **improvisation**.

pollination

n. the transfer of pollen from the male reproductive organs of one flower to the female reproductive organs of another flower, resulting in fertilization and the production of seeds

synonym: flowering, fertilization, cross-fertilization

(1) **pollination** by insect, (2) the cross-**pollination** of the arts

The **pollination** process is crucial for the growth and reproduction of many plants.

mimicry

- n. the act or skill of copying the sounds or behavior of a particular person or animal, often to make people laugh synonym: imitation, apery
- vocal mimicry, (2) floral mimicry
 Some insects use mimicry to avoid detection by predators.

conceive

v. to have or develop an idea, a plan, etc. in mind; to become pregnant

synonym: imagine, envision, concoct

(1) **conceive** of an idea, (2) **conceive** a child

I can't **conceive** he'd want to harm us.

imitate

v. to copy the speech, behavior, appearance, etc. of someone or something

synonym: mimic, emulate, replicate

(1) **imitate** painting styles, (2) **imitate** animal sounds He **imitated** the modus operandi of the famous phantom thief.

inherit

v. to receive money, property, or a title from someone after they have died

synonym: obtain, gain, acquire

(1) **inherit** estate, (2) **inherit** ancestral property After his death, his sons **inherited** his business.

trait

n. a particular feature of your nature

synonym: attribute, feature, quality

(1) chemical trait, (2) personality traits

Multiple genes may influence behavioral traits concurrently.

blueprint

 a photographic print of an early plan for a building or machine

synonym: draft, prototype, sketch

(1) **blueprint** for economic reform, (2) architect's **blueprint** A business plan is a **blueprint** for your success.

mimic

 to imitate someone's speech, movement, or behavior, especially to make others laugh

synonym: mirror, imitate, ape

(1) **mimic** a human voice, (2) **mimic** numerous instruments He is very popular at school because he can **mimic** all the teachers' accents.

artifact

 a person-made object, especially one of historical or cultural interest

synonym: antique, relic, heirloom

(1) paleolithic artifacts, (2) Peruvian artifacts

The museum has a vast collection of Greek artifacts.

exoplanet

- n. a planet that orbits a star outside of the solar system
- (1) the closest **exoplanet** to Earth, (2) **exoplanet** mission The **exoplanet** Kepler-186f is located 500 light-years from Earth and is believed to be habitable.

pragmatic

adj. practical rather than idealistic

synonym: practical, realistic, down-to-earth

(1) pragmatic approach, (2) pragmatic politics

He was a **pragmatic** leader who made decisions based on what was practical rather than ideal.

rethink

v. to consider again a plan, idea, etc., especially to change it

synonym: reexplore, review, reconsider

(1) **rethink** a marketing plan, (2) **rethink** the role of the manager

We have to **rethink** our company's product lineup for further growth.

robotic

adj. of or relating to mechanical robots; (robotics) the interdisciplinary branch of computer science and engineering with the practical use of robots

synonym: automated, mechanical, laborsaving

(1) **robotic** arm, (2) **robotic** guide operation

The surgeon removed the tumor using **robotic** video assistance.

footprint

- n. a mark of a foot, shoe, or animal's foot left on a surface synonym: footmark, imprint, impression
- (1) footprints in the snow, (2) the footprints of an earlier

civilization

We choose transportation that has a smaller carbon footprint.

recycle

v. to sort and collect things to process them and produce valuable materials that can be used again

synonym: reclaim, reuse, reprocess

(1) **recycle** the cardboard boxes, (2) **recycle** milk packaging into new paper

We largely **recycle** the circuit board of cell phones because they contain a lot of valuable metals.

unfettered

adj. not constrained or restricted by limitations or rules; free, unrestricted, unbridled

synonym: unrestricted, free, unchained

(1) **unfettered** access, (2) **unfettered** capitalism The athlete felt **unfettered** by her recent injury and performed with ease.
