cant

 statements, especially about moral, religious, or political nature that are not sincerely believed by the person making them

synonym: buzzword, jargon, pious platitude

He took her cant to heart and made the wrong decision.

liver

 a large organ in the body, involved in many metabolic processes, such as detoxification of the organism, and the synthesis of proteins

(1) liver disease, (2) fatty liver

The patient will undergo **liver** transplant surgery tomorrow.

transplant

to move or transfer something from one place or person to another; to take living tissue or an organ from one person, animal, part of the body, etc. and put it into or onto another

synonym: relocate, emigrate, graft

(1) **transplant** a heart, (2) **transplant** my family to America He tried to **transplant** the seedling into a larger pot.

ephemeral

adj. lasting or used for only a short time synonym: temporary, momentary, brief

(1) **ephemeral** joys, (2) **ephemeral** materials His success as a famous actor was **ephemeral**.

apparently

adv. based on what you have heard or readsynonym: evidently, obviously, supposedly

(1) **apparently** simple, (2) **apparently** unrelated The police **apparently** believed this explanation was plausible.

crisis

 a time of great disagreement, confusion, or danger when problems must be resolved or critical decisions must be taken

synonym: concern, problem, emergency

(1) financial **crisis**, (2) **crisis** management The Chinese word for **crisis** comprises two characters, one for danger and the other for opportunity.

pandemic

 an outbreak of a disease that affects many people over a very wide area

synonym: outbreak

flu pandemic, (2) global pandemic
 They fear a pandemic of a new type of virus.

lockdown

- an emergency policy for people, communities, or a country to stay where they are, usually due to specific risks, such as COVID-19
- (1) go on **lockdown**, (2) **lockdown** area

The country's prime minister has decided to implement a nationwide **lockdown** measure.

disinformation

 false or misleading information that is spread deliberately, usually with the intent to deceive or manipulate public opinion

synonym: misinformation, propaganda, falsehood

(1) **disinformation** campaign, (2) **disinformation** warfare The government is being criticized for spreading **disinformation** about the pandemic.

inequality

 the unfairness of a society in which some people have more opportunity, money, etc. than others; (mathematics) relation between two values when they are different

synonym: imbalance, prejudice, unfairness

- (1) **inequality** in salary, (2) algebraic **inequality**There are several causes of economic **inequality** within societies.
- supremacy
- the state, condition, or position of being superior to all others in authority, power, or status

synonym: dominance, superiority, preeminence

(1) a race for **supremacy**, (2) **supremacy** of a country The empire's military power ensured its **supremacy** over the neighboring states.

climate

 the weather in a particular location averaged over some long period

synonym: atmosphere, weather, environment

(1) a cold **climate**, (2) effects of **climate** change **Climate** and weather have an impact on every part of our lifestyles.

peach

 juicy, sweet fruit with fuzzy, pinkish-yellow skin; a person or thing that is particularly pleasing or attractive

synonym: fruit, nectarine, apricot

(1) peach cobbler, (2) juicy peaches

The **peach** tree in my backyard produced a bountiful harvest this year.

hopeless

adj. having no hope; despairing; having no chance of success

synonym: despairing, helpless, futile

(1) hopeless situation, (2) hopeless at everything

After months of job searching, he felt **hopeless** and unsure of his future.

valid

 adj. having a reasonable basis in logic or fact; still legally or officially acceptable

synonym: proper, reasonable, useful

(1) a **valid** contract, (2) a ticket **valid** for two days Your credit card is no longer **valid**.

survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay
- (1) **survive** a blizzard, (2) **survive** a plane crash These birds can only **survive** in temperate climates.

camel

- a cud-chewing mammal used as a draft or saddle animal in desert regions
- (1) camel hair, (2) ride a camel

A **camel** has a hump on its back.

faith

 complete trust in something or someone's ability or knowledge; a strong belief in religion, divine power, etc.

synonym: belief, trust, confidence

(1) religious **faith**, (2) **faith** in government He kept his robust **faith** in his company.

utterly

adv. completely or absolutely

synonym: absolutely, completely, perfectly

(1) utterly changed, (2) utterly ignorant

We are **utterly** opposed to any form of terrorism.

suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible
- synonym: guess, assume, presume
- (1) **suppose** you're right, (2) **suppose** beforehand

What do you **suppose** the culprit's motive was?

marble

n. a hard crystalline metamorphic rock that has a pattern of lines going through it and takes a high polish used for sculpture and as building material; a small ball made of stone, especially one used in children's games

synonym: stone, rock, sphere

(1) marble statues, (2) artificial marble

The floor was made of white and black **marble** arranged in a checkerboard pattern.

relentless

adj. persistent and determined; continuing despite difficulties or setbacks

brutal

adj. harsh or cruel

 a feeling of deep regret and sorry, usually for something you have done

synonym: guilt, anguish, regret

vacation

 a period in which someone does not have to attend work or school and is free to do whatever they choose, such as travel or leisure

synonym: leave, recess, break

(1) a short vacation, (2) summer vacation

Do you have a plan for a long vacation?

bucket

 an open container with a handle made of metal or plastic, often used for carrying liquids

synonym: pail, tub, can

(1) bucket list, (2) bucket of golf balls

She filled a **bucket** with water and carried it back to the house.

queue

 a line of people or vehicles, especially one that forms outside a place of entertainment or a public building, waiting for something to become available

synonym: range, sequence, waiting line

(1) form a queue, (2) queue system

coronavirus

- a group of viruses that cause respiratory,
 gastrointestinal, and neurological diseases in humans
 and other animals
- (1) **coronavirus** antibody test kit, (2) **coronavirus** bankruptcy

Considering the situation of **coronavirus**, organized stopped this year's beer festival.

awesome

adj. inspiring fear, admiration, or respect; very good, nice, fun, etc.

synonym: miraculous, marvelous, astounding

(1) **awesome** mental faculty, (2) have an **awesome** birthday. There is a lot of **awesome** nature and food in Hawaii.

defeat

v. to win against somebody in a fight, war, or attempt synonym: conquer, beat, overpower

(1) **defeat** a global power, (2) **defeat** body odor

Despite his best efforts, he was unable to **defeat** the enemy.

slightly

adv. in a small degree or extent; a little synonym: barely, narrowly, scarcely

(1) increase **slightly**, (2) **slightly** alkaline soils

He moved his body **slightly** to the left.

overweight

 adj. weighing more than is considered normal, desirable, or healthy for a particular height and build

synonym: heavy, obese, fat

(1) dangerously **overweight**, (2) an **overweight** patient

The doctor advised him to lose weight and maintain a healthy diet to avoid becoming **overweight**.

helpless

adj. unable to take care of oneself or to do things without help

synonym: defenseless, powerless, susceptible

(1) **helpless** baby, (2) **helpless** victims

I feel so **helpless** without you.

adrift

 adj. without purpose or direction; floating with no clear destination or goal; lacking a stable or secure position or status

synonym: afloat, aimless, unanchored

(1) adrift boat, (2) adrift at sea

After their boat engine failed, they were left **adrift** in the middle of the ocean.

mask

v. to conceal something; (noun) a covering that you wear over your face to hide it

synonym: disguise, camouflage, conceal

vaccinate

 to treat with a vaccine, usually by injection, to produce immunity against a disease synonym: immunize, inject, inoculate

The nurse vaccinated the children in the school.

chore

 a routine or tedious task, often related to household or manual labor

synonym: task, duty, job

(1) chore list, (2) household chores

tasty

adj. having a strong and pleasant flavor when it is eaten synonym: flavorful, delectable, delicious

(1) tasty treats, (2) prepare tasty food

This meal wasn't as **tasty** as we had imagined.

vend

 to sell or offer for sale, especially as a street vendor or in a small shop

synonym: sell, peddle, market

(1) **vend** souvenirs, (2) **vend** delicious meals

The local **vendor** was able to vend all of his fresh produce by the end of the day.

invest

v. to put money, effort, time, etc. into something to make a profit or achieve a result

synonym: fund, sponsor, support

(1) **invest** in stocks, (2) **invest** capital

The government should view children as national assets and actively **invest** in them.

intention

- n. something you want to do and are going to dosynonym: purpose, connotation, will
- intention behind his decision, (2) clear intention
 Our CEO's intentions are always transparent and straightforward.

workout

- n. a session of physical exercise or trainingsynonym: exercise, training, physical activity
- (1) **workout** at the health club, (2) boxing **workout** He does a different **workout** every day to keep things interesting.

commit

- v. to do something illegal or wrong synonym: engage, carry out, execute
- (1) **commit** suicide, (2) **commit** mistakes

 The military has **committed** an abuse of human rights.

discipline

n. the practice of training people to obey rules or a code of behavior, using and punishments if these are broken; a region of activity, knowledge, or influence

synonym: training, restraint, field

(1) break **discipline**, (2) rigid **discipline**He quickly learned the military **discipline**.

flex

 ν . to show off one's strength, power, or possessions; to bend or be capable of bending easily

synonym: bend, stretch, extend

(1) **flex** a finger, (2) **flex** diplomatic muscle

The gymnast was able to **flex** his muscles to perform the difficult routine.

masochist

- someone who derives pleasure from their pain or suffering; one who enjoys being humiliated or degraded
- (1) **masochist** tendencies, (2) **masochist** behavior Some people are **masochists** who enjoy experiencing pain.

martyr

 a person who suffers very much or is killed for the sake of their religious or political beliefs

synonym: sufferer, saint

X-ray martyrs, (2) a Christian martyr
 He died a martyr to science.

overwork

v. to work excessively hard or too much; the condition of working excessively or beyond one's capacity, leading to fatigue, stress, and illness

synonym: overdo, overtax, exhaust

(1) die from **overwork**, (2) **overwork** to compensate He **overworked** himself and ended up getting sick.

overstressed

 adj. experiencing a level of stress or anxiety that exceeds one's capacity to cope; feeling overwhelmed or mentally strained

synonym: overworked, stressed out, overwhelmed

(1) **overstressed** employee, (2) **overstressed** muscles I'm feeling **overstressed** and need to take a break to relax.

burnout

- the state of being exceedingly exhausted or unwell, either physically or mentally, as a result of overworking
- synonym: breakdown, exhaustion, fatigue
- (1) burnout syndrome, (2) mental burnoutHe suffered from job burnout because of hard work.

deserve

v. to be worthy of or entitled to something, especially something good or valuable

synonym: merit, earn, justify

fleeting

adj. brief or temporary, lasting only a short time synonym: temporary, brief, transitory

grab

v. to take hold of something or someone suddenly with a hand, especially in a violent way

seize

 ν . to catch or take hold of someone or something suddenly and forcibly; to capture the attention or imagination of something

synonym: grab, grasp, capture

(1) **seize** a person's property, (2) **seize** the day

He has the superpower to seize a business opportunity.

recipe

 a set of instructions for preparing a dish, including the ingredients and the method of cooking

synonym: instructions, formula, method

(1) **recipe** book, (2) **recipe** collection

The **recipe** for the cake is passed down from generation to generation in her family.

chai

 a type of spiced tea originating from India, typically made with black tea, milk, and a variety of spices such as cinnamon, ginger, and cardamom

synonym: tea, masala tea, spiced tea

(1) spiced chai, (2) chai latte

I love to start my day off with a hot cup of **chai** tea.

misery

- n. a state of ill-being due to affliction or misfortunesynonym: affliction, despair, anguish
- (1) live in misery, (2) untold misery

Our company suffered misery from incurring a heavy loss.

recommend

v. to suggest that someone or something would be a suitable fit for a particular purpose or role

synonym: advise, suggest, instruct

(1) **recommend** a hospitalization, (2) **recommend** reading We **recommend** taking media training every six months.

humble

adj. having or showing a modest or low estimate of one's quality or importance

synonym: modest, unpretentious, abject

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(1) a **humble** cottage, (2) **humble** opinion The nobler, the more **humble**.

narrative

 a story or a description of a series of events or process of telling a story

synonym: the tale, chronology, annals

(1) **narrative** poetry, (2) personal **narrative**The **narrative** handles multiple plot lines and has unpredictable ends.

alternative

- n. one of two or more available possibilities or choicesynonym: choice, option
- (1) an **alternative** plan, (2) there is no other **alternative** Doctors are gradually coming around to the idea of using **alternative** medicines.

apathy

- n. lack of emotion, concern, or enthusiasmsynonym: affectlessness, dispassion, indifference
- (1) **apathy** in the election, (2) political **apathy**The global economic crisis has led to pervasive **apathy** and powerlessness.

cynicism

 a belief or attitude of distrust or skepticism, particularly concerning the motives or integrity of other people; an inclination to believe that people are motivated purely by self-interest

synonym: distrust, skepticism, pessimism

(1) **cynicism** towards politics, (2) intellectual **cynicism**His constant **cynicism** made it difficult for him to connect with others.

possibility

- n. a chance that something may happen or be truesynonym: chance, prospect, likelihood

betray

v. to reveal or deliver to an enemy by treachery or disloyalty; to reveal something unintentionally

synonym: fail, denounce, display

He felt **betrayed** when his best friend revealed their secret to the enemy.

disappointment

 the feeling of sadness, frustration, or dissatisfaction that arises when something does not live up to one's expectations or hopes

synonym: letdown, frustration, discouragement

(1) **disappointment** in the result, (2) **disappointment** with the service

The cancellation of the concert was a huge **disappointment** for the fans.

resigned

 adj. having accepted something unpleasant or difficult, particularly a job or situation, without complaint or resistance; accepting one's fate or circumstances

synonym: submissive, acquiescent, passive

(1) with a **resigned** voice, (2) **resigned** to their fate
She had a **resigned** look on her face when she realized that she had lost the race.

spectator

n. someone present at an event, such as a sports game,play, or concert, to watch or observe it

synonym: onlooker, observer, viewer

(1) mass **spectator** sport, (2) **spectator** seat She enjoyed watching the game as a **spectator**.

yell

v. to shout in a sudden and loud way

synonym: shout, scream, cry

(1) **yell** for help, (2) **yell** as loud as we can

When I asked my father for more money, he became furious

and **yelled** at me.

participate

- v. to take part in something
- synonym: take part, partake, enter
- (1) **participate** fully in conversation, (2) **participate** in the program

The majority of students actively **participated** in the college's intramural sports program.

bloody

- adj. covered in or smeared with blood; involving or characterized by bloodshed or brutality
- synonym: gory, gruesome, savage
- (1) **bloody** massacre, (2) **bloody** diarrhea

The crime scene was **bloody** and gruesome.

nihilist

- a person who rejects all religious, moral, and political beliefs and values; a person who believes life is meaningless and void of purpose
- synonym: anarchist, cynic, skeptic
- (1) violent nihilist, (2) militant nihilist

The professor accused the student of being a **nihilist** for constantly challenging the course material.

comfort

- a state of physical ease and freedom from pain or constraint
- synonym: ease, solace, coziness
- (1) words of **comfort**, (2) **comfort** level

He found **comfort** in the warm embrace of his loved ones.

destructive

- adj. causing or able to cause tremendous and irreparable damage
- synonym: destroying, harmful, disastrous
- (1) lead to **destructive** behavior, (2) a habit **destructive** to health

It was the most destructive storm in decades.

avenge

v. to get revenge or seek retribution for a perceived wrong or injury, often in the form of punishment, retaliation, or vindication

synonym: retaliate, revenge, requite

(1) avenge a friend, (2) avenge an injustice

He sought to **avenge** his brother's death by seeking justice through the legal system.

scenario

a description of possible actions or events in the future;
 a written outline of a play, film, or literary work

synonym: plan, scheme, procedure

(1) the worst case **scenario**, (2) number of different **scenarios**

The president prepared several possible **scenarios** for an enemy attack.

outcome

- n. the result or effect of an action, event, etc.
- synonym: result, consequence, effect
- (1) improved student **outcomes**, (2) a desirable **outcome** They awaited news of the **outcome** of the election.

emotional

adj. relating to people's feelings

synonym: affecting, impactful, impressive

(1) emotional health, (2) emotional distress

Human **emotional** responses vary widely depending on the society to which they belong.

bury

- v. to place a dead body in the ground, grave, or tomb synonym: entomb, sink, forget
- bury in the earth, (2) bury emotion
 There is plenty of space to bury everyone.

grandparent

- n. a parent of one's father or mother
- (1) great- **grandparent**, (2) person of **grandparent** age She was close to her paternal **grandparents** and often spent summers with them.

shell

 hard outer covering or case of eggs, nuts, some seeds, and some animals

synonym: ammunition, armor, cover

(1) an egg shell, (2) a mollusk shell

The outermost electron **shell** determines the chemical properties of an atom.

pretension

 n. the act of claiming or asserting something, especially without good reason or without evidence; an unfounded or excessive claim or ambition

synonym: presumption, pretense, affectation

(1) **pretension** to authority, (2) baseless **pretension**His **pretensions** of being a gourmet were quickly exposed when he could not identify basic herbs and spices.

pregnant

adj. having a baby or young animal developing in the uterussynonym: expectant

(1) needs of **pregnant** women, (2) a silence **pregnant** with suspense

She vacated the position when she got pregnant.

regain

v. to get something back or recover something after it has been lost or taken away

synonym: recover, reclaim, retrieve

(1) **regain** our reputation, (2) **regain** my health After years of hard work, he finally **regained** his financial stability.

prefer

v. to like, choose, or want one thing or person better than another

synonym: choose, like, favor

- (1) **prefer** physics to chemistry, (2) **prefer** a window seat The birds **prefer** open water areas with reeds around them.
- a steep rock face, especially one at the edge of the sea or a river

synonym: crag, escarpment, precipice

cliff

(1) a bold cliff, (2) cliff diving

He stood at the edge of the **cliff** and looked out to sea.

decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

lawn

 a stretch of ground covered with grass, typically attached to a house, and often used for recreation or aesthetics

synonym: yard, grass, meadow

(1) lawn mower, (2) lush lawn

The family enjoyed a picnic on the **lawn** in the park.

scenery

n. the natural features of a landscape or environment, viewed particularly in terms of their aesthetic appeal; the visual elements that constitute a play's backdrop or setting

synonym: landscape, view, panorama

(1) **scenery** painting, (2) mountain **scenery**

The beautiful **scenery** along the coast took our breath away.

donor

n. a person or an organization that makes a gift of money, food, supplies, etc. to a cause or fund; in medicine, a person who gives blood or tissue or an organ to be used in another person

synonym: contributor, patron, supporter

a transfusion of **donor** blood,
 an unnamed **donor** body rejected the liver of the **donor**.

anonymous

adj. having no known name, identity, or known source synonym: nameless, unidentified, unnamed

(1) **anonymous** letter, (2) **anonymous** house She received several **anonymous** calls.

naive

adj. showing unaffected simplicity and lack of experience, wisdom, or judgment

synonym: innocent, unsophisticated, gullible

(1) naive belief, (2) naive mistake

The con artist's lies quickly took in the **naive** young man.

optimist

 a person who tends to expect the best in all things and to be hopeful and confident about the future

synonym: positive thinker, dreamer, idealist

(1) optimist by nature, (2) excessive optimist

She is a confident **optimist** who always looks on the bright side.

pragmatist

 a person who practically approaches situations and problems; someone who prioritizes usefulness and functionality over abstract principles or ideals

synonym: realist, practical person, utilitarian

(1) pragmatist perspective, (2) a true pragmatist

As a **pragmatist**, she always focuses on finding practical solutions to problems.

horror

 intense fear or disgust, especially at something shocking or terrifying

synonym: fear, terror, dread

(1) horror movie, (2) horror-struck look

The stories of war crimes filled her with horror.

assure

v. to give confidence or reassurance to someone; to convince or guarantee someone that something will happen or that something is true

synonym: ensure, guarantee, promise

ram

v. to strike or push forcefully, often to cause damage; to batter or break open a door or barrier using brute force

synonym: crash, collide, slam

survival

 the state of continuing to exist or live, frequently in the face of difficulty or danger

synonym: endurance, continuity

(1) survival ability, (2) survival food

He evaluated his chances for **survival** rather pessimistically.

victory

 success in a game, competition, election, or battle, or the knowledge that you have won

synonym: win, triumph, success

(1) **victory** in the law court, (2) **victory** over terrorism We are optimistic about our final **victory**.

grateful

adj. feeling or showing an appreciation of kindness; thankful synonym: thankful, appreciative, indebted

(1) a **grateful** breeze, (2) put a **grateful** expression She was **grateful** for the help he provided.

background

the details of a person's social heritage, such as family, vocational or educational experience; past information that is essential to understanding a situation or problem

synonym: ground, experience, backdrop

(1) a **background** color, (2) a criminal **background**The company's hiring criteria emphasize personality, not a person's **background**.

exciting

adj. causing a lot of interest or excitement *synonym*: exhilarating, stimulating, thrilling

(1) **exciting** football player, (2) **exciting** news The findings of the experiment were both **exciting** and unexpected.

virtual

adj. being actually such in almost every respect; existing in essence or effect though not in actual fact

synonym:

practical

(1) a **virtual** image, (2) trading of **virtual** currencies She is the **virtual** president of the company.

wildling

 a human or animal living in the wild or wilderness; a person lacking social graces or convention, often behaving in an unconventional or wild manner

synonym: wilderness, savage, untamed

(1) wildling child, (2) wildling tribe

The hunters set traps to catch wildlings for their pelts.

pray

- v. to make a request or petition to a higher power,especially in the form of a respectful or humble requestsynonym: implore, supplicate, entreat
- (1) **pray** devoutly, (2) **pray** for rain

She closed her eyes and **prayed** for strength to overcome difficult times.

dive

- v. to jump into the water with your head and arms going in first, or to move down to a deeper level underwatersynonym: dip, leap, plunge

embrace

v. to accept something willingly and enthusiastically; (noun) the act of clasping another person in the arms as in greeting or affection

memoir

- a historical account or biography written from the writer's knowledge of famous people, places, or events
- synonym: bio, biography

historic

adj. famous or significant in history, or potentially so synonym: memorable, momentous, historical

(1) **historic** accomplishment, (2) achieve the **historic** feat The Chinese people have accomplished several **historic** feats.

analyze

 to think about in-depth and evaluate to discover essential features or meaning

synonym: explore, examine, investigate
