mayonnaise

She found a paint **flake** on the wall and realized it was time to repaint the room.

soaked

adj. completely wet; saturated or drenched with a liquid synonym: drenched, saturated, wet

The hiker's boots were **soaked** from walking through the stream.

whit

tofu

soymilk

lecithin

 a fatty substance found in animal and plant tissues often used as an emulsifier (= a substance that helps to stabilize and homogenize a mixture of two or more immiscible substances) in the food and industrial processes

synonym: phosphatide, phospholipid, lipid

(1) lecithin granules, (2) dietary lecithin

Soy **lecithin** is a popular alternative to egg yolks in baking.

phospholipid

- n. a type of lipid that is an essential component of cell membranes, consisting of a phosphate group (= a chemical compound made up of phosphorus and oxygen), glycerol (= a colorless, odorless, sweet-tasting, viscous liquid), and fatty acid chains
- phospholipid bilayers, (2) synthetic phospholipid
 Liposomes are microscopic vesicles made up of phospholipids used in drug delivery systems.

emulsify

to mix two or more liquids that normally don't dissolve in each other, such as oil and water, by adding an agent that helps to suspend the tiny droplets of one liquid within the other

synonym: blend, fuse, mix

- (1) **emulsify** fats and proteins, (2) **emulsify** egg yolks You must first **emulsify** the oil and vinegar to make the salad dressing.

hydrate
