- synonym: compassion, sympathy, tenderness
- (1) full of **empathy**, (2) **empathy** for patients **Empathy** is also necessary to understand history.

opportune

- adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose
- synonym: suitable, timely, practical
- (1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

intimidate

- v. to make someone fearful or uneasy so that they will do something that you want them to do
- synonym: frighten, threaten, terrify
- (1) **intimidate** an opponent, (2) effectively **intimidate** a thief The boss tried to **intimidate** his subordinate with threats.
