#### solver

 a thinker who finds an answer to a problem or a difficult situation; a piece of software or the algorithm that solves a mathematical problem

*synonym*: thinker

### storytelling

- n. the act or art of narrating or writing storiessynonym: narrating, relating, recounting

#### outsize

- adj. larger or more extensive than what is considered average or normal; of an unusually large size or amount synonym: oversize, huge, massive
- (1) outsize impact, (2) outsize equipment

The musician's **outsize** stage presence made her concerts an unforgettable experience.

#### firsthand

adv. from the source; directly; (adjective) received directly from a source

*synonym*: direct

#### onside

adj. pertaining to being in a position that is not offside; in a position that is not in violation of the rules of a sport or game

synonym: valid, legal, allowable

#### murky

#### inventive
