#### claim

v. to assert that something is true; to demand or request something as one's own; to lay legal or moral right to something; (noun) a demand or assertion of a right or something that one believes to be true

synonym: assert, declare, maintain

(1) claim responsibility, (2) false claim

He wants to **claim** ownership of the abandoned property.

#### turbulent

- adj. marked by a lot of sudden changes, confusion, or uncertainty; characterized by intense activity or agitationsynonym: chaotic, stormy, tumultuous
- (1) turbulent waves, (2) turbulent age

The stock market has been **turbulent** lately, with prices fluctuating rapidly.

#### amass

 to accumulate or gather a large quantity of something over time; to collect or assemble for future use or reference

synonym: gather, collect, accumulate

#### arable

#### noble

 adj. having or showing excellent personal qualities or high moral principles that people admire

synonym: dignified, aristocratic, benevolent

(1) a **noble** family, (2) **noble** gas

He is a **noble-minded** man

#### appoint

v. to give someone a job or role, especially as a public official or member of an organization; to arrange or decide on a time or a place

synonym: designate, assign, name

(1) **appoint** members, (2) **appoint** the day

The court **appointed** a guardian for the child.

#### government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

*synonym*: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding

The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

#### sovereign

n. a king or queen

synonym: ruler, monarch, majesty

(1) **sovereign** wealth fund, (2) a **sovereign** state King George was the **sovereign** of England.

#### kingdom

- n. the country ruled by a king or queensynonym: empire, realm, land
- (1) establish his **kingdom**, (2) a subordinate **kingdom** By remaining neutral, this **kingdom** continued to exist.

#### constitutional

adj. of or relating to a constitution (= the set of fundamental principles), especially of a country or government;
 existing as an essential characteristic

synonym: fundamental, basic, inherent

#### monarchy

- n. a form of government in which a country is ruled by a king or a queen who typically inherits the authoritysynonym: kingdom, realm, empire

#### opportune

- adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purposesynonym: suitable, timely, practical

#### emerge

export

 to send goods or services to another country for sale; to transfer electronic data out of a database or document in a format that other programs can use

synonym: ship, send, transfer

(1) export goods, (2) export the data

The country **exports** a large amount of agricultural products.

tariff

a tax imposed by a government on imported or exported goods

synonym: duty, tax, charge

(1) tariff policy, (2) tariff war

The new **tariff** on imported goods has sparked controversy among trade partners.

descendant

- n. children or offspring of a specific person, plant, or animal synonym: child, offspring, heir
- (1) **descendant** of a pioneer, (2) third-generation **descendant**

Those warriors' **descendants** are still skilled archers.

shift

- n. a slight transition in position, direction, or trendsynonym: transition, change, modification
- (1) Doppler shift, (2) major paradigm shift Could you help me shift some furniture?

plot

 a secret plan or scheme to achieve a specific goal; the plan or main story of a literary work; (verb) to plan secretly, usually something illegal

synonym: scheme, plan, design

(1) **plot** twist, (2) **plot** a revolution

The **plot** of the novel centers around a group of friends who uncover a conspiracy to control the world's water supply.

annex

v. to add territory to a country, state, or region, typically by conquest; (noun) an addition that extends a main building

synonym: add, take over, (noun) appendix

(1) annex notes, (2) hotel annex

The government **annexed** the territory from the neighboring country.

sibling

 a brother or sister; member of a family born to the same parents

synonym: brother, sister, relative

(1) have a **sibling** quarrel, (2) play with my **siblings** Children often copy their parents or elder **siblings**.

ascend

v. to go or move upward; to become king or queen; to inherit something, such as a power

synonym: rise, climb, go up

(1) **ascend** the ladder, (2) **ascend** to power The plane began to **ascend** into the sky.

throne

 a chair or seat of state for a monarch or other high-ranking person; the position of being a king or queen

synonym: seat, throne, chair

(1) abdicate the **throne**,(2) imperial **throne**The king sat on his **throne**, surveying his kingdom.

reign

 n. the period of time during which a monarch or government holds power; (verb) to be the king or queen

*synonym*: rule, governance, sovereignty

(1) reign of a dictator, (2) reign as sovereign

The dictator's **reign** was characterized by widespread human

rights abuses and suppression of political opposition.

#### emerging

adj. starting to exist, mature, or become well-known synonym: arising, occurring, state-of-the-art

- (1) **emerging** country, (2) **emerging** technologies **Emerging** technologies have dramatically improved productivity in various industries.
- a strong indication or likelihood of harm, danger, or adverse consequences; an expression of intent to inflict harm or injury on someone or something, often made as a means of coercion or intimidation

synonym: menace, danger, hazard

- (1) economic **threat**, (2) environmental **threat**The **threat** of severe weather prompted the city to issue an evacuation warning.
- n. a solid material with many even sides that is formed naturally when the substance becomes solid and has a highly regular atomic structure; clear and colorless glass made of almost pure silica

synonym: quartz

(1) liquid crystal, (2) crystal analyses

A vast **crystal** chandelier glittered brightly above us.

militia

 a military force comprised of trained soldiers who are usually a citizen or have other jobs

synonym: reserves

surround

- v. to be all around something or somebody synonym: encircle, encompass, envelop
- (1) **surround** a town, (2) a stone wall **surrounds** the palace On three sides, mountains **surround** the settlement.

#### legislation

 a law or a set of laws suggested and then passed by a parliament, or the act of making or enacting laws

synonym: act, regulation, decree

(1) anti-terrorist **legislation**, (2) introduce **legislation** Similar **legislation** had already been rejected by the parliament four times.

#### constitution

n. the set of fundamental principles or established precedents that a state, a country, or an organization is governed by; the act of forming or establishing something

synonym: fundamental law, establishment, formation

- (1) the national **constitution**, (2) the national **constitution** When the **constitution** is amended, it often creates a great deal of controversy throughout the country
- v. to remove the surface from something; (noun) a sizeable narrow piece of something such as paper, metal, cloth, etc., or area of land, sea, etc.

*synonym*: deprive, undress, (noun) ribbon

The doctor advised him to **strip** down for a check.

#### native

adj. connecting with or describing someone's birth country or place of birth, or someone born in a specific country or place

synonym: endemic, domestic, aboriginal

(1) **native** to Africa, (2) **native** language

The vegetation here is almost wholly **native**.

#### diminish

v. to reduce or be reduced in size, extent, or importance; to make something smaller, weaker, etc.

synonym: decline, dwindle, lessen

(1) **diminish** a reputation, (2) **diminish** swelling As people get old, their energies may **diminish**.

strip

#### cede

- to give up, surrender, or transfer possession or control of something, especially territory, power, or authority synonym: surrender, relinquish, yield
- (1) **cede** power, (2) **cede** custody of the kids The landowner agreed to **cede** part of his property to the government for the public good.

#### heartbreak

- a feeling of great sadness or disappointment synonym: grief, sorrow, bitterness
- (1) ease her heartbreak, (2) go through heartbreak They had experienced the **heartbreak** of losing two children due to premature births.

### ingratitude

the state of being ungrateful; a lack of appreciation or n. acknowledgment of kindness or benevolence shown towards oneself

synonym: ungratefulness, thanklessness, lack of appreciation

(1) ingratitude towards family, (2) show ingratitude The ingratitude of her children after all that she had done for them left her feeling heartbroken.

#### fortune

- a large amount of money or property; chance or luck as an unknown and arbitrary force affecting human affairs synonym: wealth, affluence, assets
- (1) ill **fortune**, (2) bit of good **fortune** Capitalism guarantees the right of ownership of personal fortune.

to think or accept something to be true without having proof of it; to take or begin to have power; to begin to exhibit a specific quality or appearance

synonym: guess, presume, suppose

(1) **assume** a lousy attitude to his boss, (2) **assume** an important role

The following example **assumes** that the capacity of each battery is the same.

#### rumor

 a piece of unverified information of uncertain origin that is spread by word of mouth

synonym: gossip, whisper, talk

(1) a false rumor, (2) rumor mill

There was a baseless **rumor** that the company was going bankrupt.

#### insurgent

adj. rising against established authority or government;characterized by rebellion, dissent, or insurgency

synonym: subversive, rebellious, mutinous

(1) insurgent attack, (2) insurgent group

The government forces fought brutally against the **insurgent** rebels in the remote region.

#### determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

*synonym*: cause, factor, element

(1) environmental **determinant**, (2) a **determinant** of crop yields

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

#### estimate

v. to guess or calculate the cost, size, value, etc. of something

*synonym*: calculate, gauge, evaluate

(1) **estimate** a fair value, (2) **estimate** this chicken to weigh three pounds

We **estimated** the season's total trade deficit at \$50 billion.

#### flood

n. a large amount of water flowing beyond its normal limits; an overwhelming number or amount

synonym: deluge, downpour, overflow

(1) flood advisory, (2) a flood of questions

These heavy rains caused flash **floods** on several islands.

#### introductory

adj. intended as an introduction or preliminary; serving as a base or starting point

*synonym*: beginning, preliminary, initial

(1) **introductory** biology text, (2) product **introductory** sale The **introductory** class was designed to give students a basic understanding of the subject.

#### committee

 a group of people appointed or elected to perform a specific function or manage a particular task, often within a larger organization

synonym: panel, board, council

(1) **committee** meeting, (2) **committee** member The ad hoc **committee** met to discuss the proposal.

#### consist

v. to be composed or made up of

synonym: lie in, comprise, exist

(1) **consist** mainly of cells, (2) **consist** only in knowing facts This examination **consists** of five problems to solve.

#### hatch

v. to cause an egg to break to allow a young animal to come out; to produce and expand something that is in an early stage

*synonym*: incubate, breed, produce

(1) **hatch** a plan, (2) **hatch** a baby chick
The eggs began to **hatch**, and the small chicks emerged.

#### pretense

an act or instance of pretending or feigning; a false or insincere show or claim

*synonym*: act, facade, show

(1) **pretense** of innocence, (2) maintain a **pretense**He put on a **pretense** of enjoying the party even though he was feeling miserable.

#### endangered

adj. at risk of extinction because it is facing significant threats

synonym: at risk, threatened, vulnerable

(1) endangered species, (2) endangered ecosystem

#### property

- a thing or things that belong to someonesynonym: belongings, possessions, equity
- (1) a man of property,(2) chemical propertyHe stood to inherit a million-dollar property.

#### coup

 a sudden, violent, and illegal seizure of power from a government; an impressive or successful action or achievement

*synonym*: revolution, overthrow, takeover

(1) **coup** plotters, (2) military **coup** 

The prime minister was arrested and charged with treason after he was found to be involved in the **coup**.

#### marine

adj. relating to the sea and the creatures and plants that live there

synonym: sea-dwelling, maritime, aquatic

(1) marine insurance, (2) variety of marine life

Seals and whales are **marine** animals beloved by the people.

#### march

v. to walk militarily with stiff, regular steps

*synonym*: parade

(1) march against the war, (2) march east

The troops marched shoulder-to-shoulder.

#### palace

 the residence of a high-ranking official such as a king, queen, etc.

synonym: mansion, manor, castle

(1) a palace garden, (2) ancestral palace

The imperial **palace** is currently undergoing reforms.

#### protest

a strong expression of disagreement, disapproval, or opposition

synonym: objection, disapproval, challenge

(1) hold a **protest**, (2) a silent **protest** 

He left the party in **protest** at its radical political stance.

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) nation-state, (2) a seafaring nation

The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

#### allege

v. to claim or assert that something is true without providing proof or evidence

synonym: claim, assert, state

(1) allege abuse, (2) allege wrongdoing

The prosecution **alleged** that the defendant was guilty of the crime.

#### provisional

adj. temporary; serving as a means of satisfying a need or requirement until a more permanent solution can be found

*synonym*: temporary, interim, tentative

(1) a **provisional** treaty, (2) **provisional** measure

The **provisional** agreement was reached pending further negotiation.

#### declare

v. to say, state, or announce something clearly, officially, or publicly

synonym: announce, state, affirm

(1) **declare** independence, (2) **declare** my love Foreign goods from abroad must be **declared** to customs when entering a country.

### republic

 a state or country in which the people and their elected representatives hold supreme power and which has an elected or nominated president rather than a monarch

synonym: democracy, federation, commonwealth

(1) **republic** democracy, (2) the **republic** of art The United States is a federal presidential constitutional **republic**.

#### proclaim

- v. to announce or state something publicly and forcefully synonym: announce, declare, trumpet
- (1) proclaim victory, (2) proclaim law

The leader **proclaimed** a state of emergency in the country.

### employ

v. to give somebody a job and pay them for it; to make use of

synonym: hire, engage, use

- (1) **employ** job seekers, (2) **employ** a new method When making arrests, police officers frequently **employ** excessive force.
- n. a solemn promise or affirmation, often made in a formal public setting, to do something or adhere to certain principles or beliefs; a formal declaration of one's commitment to a particular course of action, organization, or duty

synonym: pledge, vow, promise

(1) oath of allegiance, (2) promise an oathHe took an oath to uphold the law as a police officer.

### allegiance

 n. loyalty or faithfulness to a person, country, cause, or belief; a pledge or oath of loyalty

synonym: loyalty, devotion, faithfulness

loyal allegiance, (2) show allegiance
 The soldiers pledged their allegiance to their country.

#### refuse

- v. to show that one is not willing to do or accept something synonym: turn down, deny, decline
- (1) refuse a request, (2) refuse the companyMy initial reaction was to refuse.

#### attempt

 an act or effort of trying to do something, especially something difficult

synonym: endeavor, effort, try

(1) the **attempt** to rescue the hostages, (2) a reckless **attempt** 

The third **attempt** was far more successful.

#### revolution

 a large-scale attempt to overthrow the government of a country, often using violence or war;

synonym: coup, innovation, rebellion

(1) beginning of the industrial **revolution**, (2) a political **revolution** 

The **revolution** by the citizen resulted in a redistribution of wealth.

#### brutal

adj. harsh or cruel

synonym: harsh, cruel, barbarous

(1) brutal bully, (2) brutal honesty

The **brutal** attack left the victim with serious injuries.

jail

 a facility where criminals are kept to be punished for their crimes; a prison

synonym: prison, slammer, penitentiary

(1) county jail, (2) be in jail

The police escorted the prisoner to the **jail**.

### exchange

v. to give something and receive something else in return, often with the implication that the items being traded are of equal or comparable value; (noun) the act of giving or taking something in return for something else; a place or system where goods or services can be bought, sold, or traded

synonym: trade, swap, interchange

(1) **exchange** rate, (2) **exchange** a few friendly words My sister and I frequently **exchange** books, as we love reading.

#### release

- v. to set free or allow to escape from confinement synonym: free, let go, discharge
- (1) **release** a prisoner, (2) **release** CO2 into the air The animal rights group worked to **release** the dolphins back into the wild.

### relinquish

- v. to give up power, control, or possession synonym: surrender, give up, abandon
- (1) **relinquish** control, (2) **relinquish** all hope She decided to **relinquish** her role as the leader of the group.

#### constant

- *adj.* happening repeatedly or all the time *synonym*: ceaseless, stable, unchanging
- (1) a **constant** wind, (2) a **constant** temperature **Constant** dropping wears away the stone.

#### compose

- v. to write music, poetry, or formal writing; to constitute or make up a whole, or a specified part of itsynonym: compile, constitute, build
- compose an essay, (2) compose my thoughts
   The structure is composed of three main components.

## patchwork

- a fabric made by stitching together small pieces of different colored and patterned fabrics; a mixture or grouping of diverse elements or components
- synonym: assortment, jumble, mishmash
- (1) the **patchwork** of legislation, (2) **patchwork** design The **patchwork** approach to funding led to an uneven distribution of resources.

#### quilt

- a warm bed covering made of padding enclosed between layers of fabric and kept in place by lines of stitching, typically forming a decorative pattern
- synonym: puff, coverlet, blanket
- (1) quilt blanket, (2) handmade quilt

My grandmother made me a beautiful **quilt** as a gift for my wedding.

#### bouquet

a bunch of flowers, especially one presented as a gift or carried at a ceremony

synonym: bunch, arrangement, nosegay

(1) hand over a **bouquet**, (2) bridal **bouquet** 

He gave her a **bouquet** of roses as a gift.

#### dedicate

to give all of your energy, time, etc., entirely to a specific person, activity, or cause; to set apart for a particular purpose or use

synonym: consecrate, devote, commit

(1) **dedicate** a few hours, (2) **dedicate** a chapter to the subject

He **dedicated** his life to helping others.

#### wrap

to cover or enclose something entirely with paper, cloth, ν. or other material

synonym: surround, cover, bandage

(1) wrap a fish in foil, (2) wrap up a meeting

**Wrap** the bandage tightly around the injured arm.

lift

to raise something to a higher position or level; to pick up something or somebody and move them to a different position

synonym: raise, elevate, move up

(1) **lift** sagging skin, (2) **lift** a ban on alcohol

The drought **lifted** the prices of grain globally.

#### nationalist

adj. relating to or supporting a political ideology that emphasizes a strong sense of national identity and devotion to one's own country

*synonym*: chauvinist, patriotic, jingoist

(1) nationalist sentiment, (2) nationalist revolt

The **nationalist** rally attracted thousands of supporters.

#### convinced

adj. completely certain about something; having a strong belief or conviction in a particular religion

synonym: confident, positive, indoctrinated

(1) **convinced** of the idea, (2) **convinced** criminal The public is **convinced** that the prime minister has committed fraud.

#### congress

 a formal meeting of the representatives of different countries, constituent states, organizations, trade unions, political parties, or other groups

synonym: legislature, parliament, assembly

(1) an international **congress**, (2) peace **congress Congress** must consider this proposal in an unusual situation.

#### halt

 to bring or come to a stop; to force to stop moving or operating

*synonym*: stop, cease, terminate

(1) halt production, (2) halt progress

The train came to a **halt** at the station.

#### annexation

 the process of adding territory to a country, state, or other political units

synonym: absorption, incorporation, addition

(1) **annexation** of territory, (2) **annexation** by force of arms The **annexation** of the neighboring country was a controversial decision.

#### treaty

 a formal agreement or pact between two or more countries or other international entities

synonym: agreement, pact, accord

(1) **treaty** negotiation, (2) global climate **treaty** 

The two countries signed a **treaty** to establish peaceful relations.

#### strategy

 a detailed plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall goal. synonym: approach, procedure, scenario

(1) military **strategy**, (2) develop a **strategy** 

Our plan includes a comprehensive marketing **strategy**.

#### military

adj. relating to or characteristic of members of the armed forces; of or relating to war or warfare

synonym: armed, martial, warlike

(1) a **military** operation, (2) a **military** leader

The **military** academy was known for its strict discipline and training.

#### president

 the leader of a republic, for example, the US; the person in charge of the organization such as a company, university, club, etc.

synonym: leader, CEO, chairperson

president emeritus, (2) vice- president for finance
 The club president does not have absolute power.

#### territory

n. an area under the control of a ruler or state

synonym: domain, region, realm

(1) acquire **territory**, (2) **territory** in charge

They incorporated the conquered **territory** into their nation.

#### devastating

adj. causing a great deal of destruction or damage

synonym: destructive, annihilative, disastrous

(1) have **devastating** effects, (2) treat this **devastating** disease

This typhoon was the most **devastating** in years.

#### liberate

to set free; to release or rescue from captivity or oppression

synonym: emancipate, release, set free

(1) **liberate** people from oppression, (2) **liberate** potential The prisoners were **liberated** after the war ended.

#### unreal

adj. imaginary; not existing in fact synonym: false, fake, fictitious

(1) have an unreal feeling, (2) unreal situation

The idea of winning the lottery seemed so **unreal** that he didn't even bother buying a ticket.

#### obliterate

v. to wipe out, destroy, or conceal all signs of something utterly; to remove completely from recognition or memory

synonym: destroy, eliminate, erase

(1) **obliterate** all traces, (2) **obliterate** data

The accident at that nuclear power plant **obliterated** the local ecosystem.

#### resilient

adj. able to withstand or recover quickly from difficult conditions

synonym: robust, sturdy, tough

(1) a hard and **resilient** steel, (2) **resilient** population She is a **resilient** person and has always bounced back from setbacks.

#### commitment

 a promise or firm decision to do something or to behave in a certain way

synonym: burden, obligation, promise

(1) a **commitment** to an alliance, (2) meet his **commitments** 

His business **commitments** took him to the United States.

#### waver

- v. to move in a quivering manner; to become weak synonym: lurch, sway, wobble
- (1) **waver** in purpose, (2) **waver** between work and private life

She didn't **waver** in her decision to pursue her dream career, despite the challenges.
