# pivot

 a change in direction or focus, especially in a business or political strategy; a fixed point that supports something that turns or balances

synonym: center point, fulcrum, heart

(1) center- **pivot** irrigation, (2) **pivot** point

The team needed to come up with a **pivot** strategy to turn things around.

#### mundane

adj. very ordinary and therefore lacking interest or excitement

synonym: ordinary, everyday, prosaic

(1) mundane affairs, (2) mundane objects

After returning from the war, he had a pretty **mundane** life.

#### stale

adj. no longer fresh, new, or interesting; dull or uninteresting synonym: old, uninteresting, dull

#### arouse

synonym: excite, stimulate, stir

# vitality

#### sexless

## heterosexual

- adj. attracted to individuals of the opposite sexsynonym: straight, conventional

#### stressor

- n. something that causes stress or emotional tensionsynonym: pressure, strain, burden

# breastfeeding

## handcuff

#### nurture
