jersey

 a knitted garment typically made of wool or cotton, worn as a shirt or pullover

sneak

v. to go somewhere, or take someone or something somewhere secretly or stealthily; to steal or do something secretly or stealthily

downstairs

adv. on or to a lower or ground floor of a building

synonym: below

inn

 a small hotel or lodging establishment typically located in a rural area, often serving food and drink as well as lodging

synonym: tavern, hostel, lodge

(1) inn's lounge, (2) seaside inn

We stayed at a cozy inn during our road trip.

blackface

n. (considered offensive) a form of theatrical makeup used to portray a negative and stereotypical caricature of black people, often involving the use of darkening makeup on the face

synonym: dark makeup, minstrelsy, blacking

(1) blackface makeup, (2) blackface performance

The use of **blackface** in entertainment is widely regarded as offensive and inappropriate.

confuse

 to mistake one thing for another; to make somebody hard to understand

synonym: confound, obscure, disorient

introduction

n. a preliminary explanation or remarks given before the start of a text, performance, or event; the act of bringing something new into existence or introducing something to a wider audience or new market

synonym: initiation, preamble, prologue

introduction education, (2) self- introduction
 The introduction to the new class was informative and engaging.

minstrel

n. historically, a medieval poet, musician, or performer who traveled from place to place, often entertaining audiences with music, song, and poetry; a performer or entertainer who performs traditional or folk music, storytelling, or other forms of performance art

synonym: balladeer, troubadour, bard

(1) minstrel show, (2) traveling minstrel

The king often hired a **minstrel** to entertain him and his court with music and stories.

origin

n. the first existence or beginning of something

synonym: root, source, ancestor

There are various hypotheses concerning the origin of life.

incident

an event or occurrence, often unexpected or unplanned;something that happens

synonym: event, occurrence, accident

(1) traffic **incident**, (2) security **incident**

The **incident** at the airport caused a delay in my flight.

cork

n. a type of light and buoyant material that comes from the bark of the cork oak tree often used as a stopper for bottles or as a material for insulation or flooring; (verb) to close or seal something with a cork or similar stopper

synonym

: stopper, bung, plug

(1) cork a bottle, (2) cork flooring

She used a **cork** board to display her favorite photographs.

exaggerate

 to describe or represent something as better or worse than it is

synonym: overstate, overestimate, amplify

(1) **exaggerate** in degree, (2) **exaggerate** story

She **exaggerated** the extent of her injuries to get more

money from the settlement.

tight adj. fixed, fastened, or kept together firmly or closely synonym: closed, secured, cramped

(1) a **tight** game, (2) student on a **tight** budget The national election was held amid **tight** security.

coil

v. to wind something in a spiral or helical shape; to create a coil or coil-like shape; to group or organize something closely together in a circular or spiral pattern

synonym: twist, wind, loop

(1) coil wire, (2) coil an arm

She carefully **coiled** the rope so that it wouldn't tangle.

wig

 a head covering made of synthetic or real hair worn for a variety of reasons, including as a fashion accessory, to conceal hair loss or baldness, or as part of a costume

synonym: hairpiece, toupee, hair system

She decided to wear a pink wig to the costume party.

typical

adj. having the usual characteristics or traits of a specific group of things

synonym: characteristic, usual, distinctive

parody

 a humorous imitation of a serious piece of literature or music designed to ridicule or criticize the original work

synonym: spoof, satire, lampoon

intersperse

v. to scatter or distribute among or between other things; to insert or place something at intervals

synonym: scatter, distribute, insert

stump

 to cause to be perplexed or confused; (noun) the base part of a tree that remains standing after the tree has been felled

interlude

 a period of time between two events or periods of activity, often marked by a pause or break; a brief entertainment or performance between two larger acts or events

synonym: interval, break, pause

The **interlude** between acts allowed the audience to stretch their legs and chat.

skit

 a short, often humorous performative piece or act, typically performed in a comic or satirical tone or style, as part of a variety show or a theatrical or musical performance

synonym: sketch, parody, routine

The comedy group performed a hilarious **skit** about life in quarantine.

roster

a list of people's names, often who are available to do a job

synonym: listing, enrollment, registration

recurring

adj. happening or occurring again periodically or repeatedly *synonym*: periodic, constant, frequent

(1) recurring payments, (2) recurring decimalsA recurring back pain interfered with his concentration.

interlocutor

a person who participates in a conversation or dialogue;
 a person who speaks or converses with another

synonym: mediator, negotiator, go-between

(1) speak with an **interlocutor**, (2) find an **interlocutor** She was my **interlocutor**, facilitating the conversation between the two sides.

emcee

n. (a short for MC, a master of ceremonies) who introduces speakers, performers, or entertainers and keeps the event moving smoothly; (verb) to act as the master of ceremonies or a host of an event, typically by introducing performers, speakers, or other participants and helping to keep the event organized and flowing smoothly

synonym: host, presenter, master of ceremonies

(1) talented emcee, (2) emcee a wedding

The radio show **emcee** interviewed the celebrity guest about their latest project

clown

 a performer, typically in a circus, who wears distinctive makeup and costumes and plays practical jokes, and performs tricks or stunts to entertain audiences

synonym: jester, harlequin, comedian

She dressed up as a Halloween **clown** with a rainbow wig and oversized red nose.

slave

 a person who is, either legally or illegally, owned by someone; a person entirely dominated by some influence or a person

maternal

adj. relating to or characteristic of a mother; having feelings that are typical of a caring mother towards her child

hypersexualized

 adj. characterized by the excessive or exaggerated focus on or depiction of sexual activity, often for commercial or entertainment purposes

The fashion industry has been criticized for **hypersexualized** women's bodies in advertisements.

wench

 n. (considered offensive and is generally not used in modern English) a young woman or girl, usually of low social status

arrogant

adj. having or revealing an exaggerated sense of one's importance or abilities

synonym: haughty, supercilious, disdainful

dandy

 a man who is excessively fastidious in his dress and manner; (adjective) very good

synonym: fop, dapper, (adjective) excellent

zip

a fastener made of interlocking teeth or ridges that is used to join two edges or pieces of fabric; a sound or motion that resembles the sound made by a zipper when it is pulled; (of a computer) a popular file compression and archiving format; (short for Zone Improvement Plan) a system of postal codes used in the United States to help facilitate mail delivery more efficiently

synonym: fastener, postcode, slide

brutal

adj. harsh or cruel

superior

adj. better, higher in quality, or more advanced than others synonym: better, greater, exceptional

simplicity

 the quality or condition of being natural and plain or easy to understand or do

synonym: easiness, plainness, modesty

(1) a life of **simplicity**, (2) refined **simplicity**He liked the car because of the **simplicity** of the design.

buffoon

- a foolish or clumsy person, especially one who amuses others by making funny faces or behaving in a silly way
 synonym: clown, jester, fool
- (1) **buffoon** comedian, (2) **buffoon** character

 The court jester was a famous **buffoon** at the king's parties.

capture

v. to catch a person or an animal and confine them in an area which they cannot escape

synonym: catch, arrest, imprison

imaginary

adj. existing only in someone's mind synonym: fictional, ideal, fantastical

 a large, uncontrolled fire that spreads quickly through a natural area such as a forest, grassland, or mountain slope

synonym: blaze, bonfire, flame

entertainment

 public shows, films, television, or other performances or activities of enjoying people

synonym: amusement, recreation, enjoyment

(1) an elegant **entertainment**, (2) hour of **entertainment**The hotel is famous for its **entertainment**, including the casino.

applaud

v. to express approval of someone or something by clapping the hands

synonym: clap, celebrate, praise

humor

 the quality of being amusing or funny; the liquid parts of the body

synonym: comedy, funniness, liquid substance

synonym: amuse, delight, engage

 to make something or someone more humane or compassionate; to make something more relatable or understandable to humans

synonym: civilize, personalize

ridicule

abolitionist

 a person who advocates for the abolition (the act of doing away with something) of slavery or some other practice considered unjust

filthy

adj. dirty or unclean, often to an extreme or offensive degree; morally offensive or obscene

scum

 a layer of unwanted or unclean material that forms on the surface of a liquid or a solid, often containing dirt, oil, or other debris, also used figuratively to describe undesirable people or groups

complexion

n. the natural color, texture, and appearance of a person's skin, especially their face

deny

forge

v. to state that one refuses to admit the existence or truth of something

synonym: refute, reject, repudiate

adj. cannot be removed, erased, or forgot synonym: enduring, lasting, unforgettable

imprint

psyche

stereotype

- n. a fixed and unvarying idea or image that people have about what someone or something is like, but which is often not true in reality and may cause hurt and offense

 changing stereotypes about LGBTQ requires considerable effort.

circulate

v. to move continuously or freely around a place or closed system

synonym: flow, disperse, rotate

vaudeville

n. a type of variety show that was popular in the late 19th and early 20th century, featuring a mix of comedy, music, dance, and other forms of entertainment; often characterized by a series of short acts or sketches performed by different performers

synonym: variety show, burlesque, comedy

(1) **vaudeville** comedian, (2) classic **vaudeville**The **vaudeville** show had the audience in stitches with its comedic acts.

reinforcement

n. the act of strengthening, supporting, or consolidating; something that serves to strengthen or support

synonym: strengthening, support, underpinning

supremacy

 the state, condition, or position of being superior to all others in authority, power, or status

synonym: dominance, superiority, preeminence

inferiority

 the state or condition of being lower in rank, quality, or status; a feeling or sense of being less worthy or capable than others

synonym: lower status, low self-esteem, inadequacy

sense of **inferiority** about their work.

headline

 a heading at the top of a newspaper or magazine story or page

synonym: title, caption

haunt

v. to frequent or visit repeatedly, often in a way that is disturbing or unsettling; to occupy or fill the mind, often in a way that is unpleasant or persistent

synonym: stalk, spook, obsess

The crowd's boos and jeers continued to **haunt** the performer long after the show ended.

survey

 an investigation of the opinions, behavior, etc. of a particular group of people, made by asking people questions

synonym: study, examination, poll

conduct

- v. to organize and carry out a particular activitysynonym: behave, lead, carry on
- (1) **conduct** a background check, (2) **conduct** research Police will **conduct** random breath testing for drunk driving.

appeal

 a serious, earnest, or urgent request for money, information, or help; a quality that makes somebody or something attractive or interest

synonym: request, charm, attraction

(1) draw out your **appeal**, (2) an **appeal** for help He needed to resolve the problem as soon as possible, so he made an **appeal** directly.

impersonate

v. to pretend to be someone else, often with the intent to deceive or defraud; to imitate the mannerisms or speech of another person as a form of tribute or satire

synonym: imitate, mimic, copy

(1) **impersonate** a government official, (2) **impersonate** a character

The comedian is famous for his ability to **impersonate** famous politicians.

slavery

 the practice or system of owning, buying, and selling people as property and forcing them to work

synonym: bondage, servitude, enslavement

(1) **slavery** labor, (2) institution of **slavery**

The abolition of **slavery** in the United States was a major achievement in the fight for human rights.

segregation

n. the act or process of separating or isolating people, things, or groups based on race, gender, religion, social class, or other characteristics; a political or social system that enforces such separation or isolation *synonym*: isolation, separation, discrimination

racial segregation, (2) segregation of power
 Segregation based on race or ethnicity is illegal and unjust.

continually

adv. in a way that happens without interruption or repeatedly synonym: repeatedly, frequently, constantly

(1) **continually** access information, (2) **continually** changing world

Her tongue runs on continually.

reappear

 to show up again or return after not being heard of or seen for a period of time

synonym: come again, repeat, re-emerge

(1) **reappear** on the surface, (2) **reappear** throughout this book

Cancer has **reappeared** at the same site.

echo

 a sound heard after being reflected off a surface, such as a wall or a cliff

synonym: reverberate, repeat, reflection

suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

grotesque

adj. bizarre or fantastic in shape, appearance, or character; fantastic; bizarre

persistent

 adj. continuing firmly or obstinately in the course of action despite difficulty or opposition; lasting or enduring without fading or being lost over time

racism

n. prejudice, discrimination, or antagonism directed against a person or people based on their membership in a particular ethnic group, typically one that is a minority or marginalized

synonym: prejudice, discrimination, bias

(1) systemic **racism**, (2) research on anti- **racism**The school's lack of diversity was a clear indication of the **racism** present in the community.

prejudice

 a thought or feeling that is unfair and makes no sense, mainly when it is formed without enough thought or knowledge

synonym: bias, preconception, predisposition

(1) deep-rooted **prejudice**, (2) color **prejudice**This community is free of social **prejudice**.

breed

v. to keep animals for producing offspring in a regulated manner

synonym: raise, multiply, reproduce

(1) **breed** horses, (2) **breed** suspicion

This animal **breeds** in northern latitudes.

infiltrate

v. to enter or penetrate a group, organization, or place covertly or secretly, usually with a specific purpose or goal in mind; to spread or diffuse through something gradually or subtly

synonym: penetrate, sneak in, invade

(1) **infiltrate** the bloodstream, (2) **infiltrate** a community The spy was able to **infiltrate** the enemy's headquarters

ingrained

perpetuate

- v. to make something continue or prevail for a long time synonym: eternalize, preserve, maintain

continuum

 a series of similar items in which no part or portion is distinct or distinguishable from adjacent parts
