 a counting sequence leading up to an event, often marked by a series of signals or cues, also used as a term to describe the final stages leading up to a major event or deadline

synonym: timer

The **countdown** to launch began as the astronauts prepared for their mission.

electrify

v. to make a machine or system work by using electricity; to make someone extremely enthusiastic about or interested in something

synonym: wire, amaze, astonish

(1) **electrify** the audience, (2) **electrify** a manufacturing process

The product developed through years of research continues to **electrify** the market.

decarbonize

v. to stop or reduce emitting carbon gases, especially carbon dioxide, by replacing energy made from fossil fuels with renewable energy

synonym: decoke, decarburise, decarburize

(1) **decarbonize** their manufacturing process,



(2) **decarbonize** its energy system

We have to seek methods to **decarbonize** its fossil fuel economy.

incandescent

adj. emitting light as a result of being heated; shining brightly; passionate or enthusiastic

synonym: glowing, radiant, brilliant

(1) **incandescent** emotion, (2) **incandescent** personality The **incandescent** lights in the room created a warm and inviting atmosphere.

ratchet

 a mechanical device with a toothed wheel that can rotate in only one direction used to transmit or control motion or to prevent backward movement

synonym: gear, wrench, spanner

(1) ratchet wrench, (2) ratchet effect

He turned the bolt with the **ratchet**, making sure it was secure.

upfront

adj. frank and honest; (adverb) (of payment) in advance synonym: honest, authentic, fair

(1) an upfront tone, (2) pay upfront

He was very **upfront** with him about his intentions.

empower

- v. to give someone the power or authority to do something synonym: authorize, endow, entitle
- (1) **empower** my life, (2) **empower** the secretary to do the same

The company **empowered** employees to buy low-price items without approval to achieve efficient purchasing.

piecemeal

adv. gradually or in small increments, usually referring to a process or action that is done in stages or bit by bit;
 (adjective) consisting of many small parts or pieces;
 done gradually or bit by bit

synonym: gradually, incrementally, (adjective) bit by bit

(1) **piecemeal** approach, (2) **piecemeal** changes

The building was constructed **piecemeal** over several years.

mortar

 a mixture of cement, sand, and water used for binding building materials together; a heavy, deep bowl used to pound or grind substances

synonym: howitzer, cement mixer, masonry tool

(1) mortar joints, (2) apply mortar

The bricklayer started on the second course of bricks, laying them in fresh **mortar**.

agile

adj. able to move quickly and easily, often in a way that is graceful and controlled

synonym: nimble, quick, flexible

(1) an **agile** mind, (2) **agile** in his movements

The **agile** development process allowed the team to make changes quickly.

opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.
