### decarbonize

 to stop or reduce emitting carbon gases, especially carbon dioxide, by replacing energy made from fossil fuels with renewable energy

synonym: decoke, decarburise, decarburize

- (2) **decarbonize** its energy system

We have to seek methods to **decarbonize** its fossil fuel economy.

#### widen

v. to become or make something broader, wider, more extensive

synonym: broaden, enlarge, extend

(1) **widen** in excitement, (2) **widen** a narrowed heart valve He **widened** his investigation into a medical clinic.

#### rebalance

v. to adjust or distribute something proportionally to restore balance; to make changes to bring a situation back into equilibrium or stability

synonym: adjust, realign, readjust

rebalance the budget, (2) rebalance team roles
need to rebalance my investment portfolio to reduce risk.

# abundantly

adv. in large quantities; plentifully synonym: plentifully, copiously, lavishly

(1) **abundantly** clear, (2) **abundantly** available The policy change resulted in an **abundantly** positive outcome for the company.

#### miner

n. a person who works in a mine (= excavation in the Earth from which ores and minerals are extracted), especially one who extracts coal, minerals, or precious metals from the Earth

*synonym*: digger, excavator, miner

(1) miner strike, (2) miner industry

The coal **miner** worked tirelessly to extract valuable minerals from deep underground.

# polluted

*adj.* contaminated with harmful or poisonous substances *synonym*: contaminated, poisoned, unclean

(1) polluted air, (2) cadmium- polluted area

The river was **polluted** with chemicals, causing harm to the wildlife.

#### scour

 to clean thoroughly and vigorously by scrubbing or rubbing; to search or examine something thoroughly and systematically synonym: cleanse, scrub, clean

(1) **scour** a pot, (2) **scour** the Internet

She had to **scour** the kitchen to find a clean dish to use for dinner.

#### methane

- a chemical compound with the chemical formula CH4 with no smell or color, often used as a fuel
- (1) atmospheric **methane**, (2) reduce **methane** emissions The ignition of **methane** gas in the plant killed five employees.

# inject

v. to put a liquid such as a drug or other substance into a person's or an animal's body using a needle and syringe (= small tube)

synonym: shoot, infiltrate, insinuate

(1) **inject** under the skin, (2) **inject** a personal opinion into a debate

Let's try to **inject** a bit of enthusiasm into your performance.

# pretension

 n. the act of claiming or asserting something, especially without good reason or without evidence; an unfounded or excessive claim or ambition

*synonym*: presumption, pretense, affectation

(1) **pretension** to authority, (2) baseless **pretension**His **pretensions** of being a gourmet were quickly exposed when he could not identify basic herbs and spices.

#### cocreate

- v. to create something by working with others
- (1) **cocreate** our life, (2) **cocreate** a relationship We form partnerships to **cocreate** customer value.

## app

 n. (abbreviation for application) software designed to run on smartphones and other mobile devices or inside a web browser on a PC

synonym: application, software

(1) killer app, (2) cannot log in to the app

The discovery of a critical bug caused the company to delay the **app's** release.

### perplexity

- n. confusion, doubt; state of being puzzledsynonym: confusion, bewilderment, uncertainty
- (1) a **perplexity** issue, (2) resolve **perplexity**The **perplexity** of the situation left everyone at a loss for words.

#### imbalance

 a situation in which two or more things are not equal or equally treated

synonym: inequality, asymmetry, instability

(1) trade **imbalance**, (2) symptoms of hormonal **imbalance**An **imbalance** in certain substances causes problems with brain function.

### empathy

- n. the ability to share another person's feelings or experiences by imagining that person's situationsynonym: compassion, sympathy, tenderness
- (1) full of **empathy**, (2) **empathy** for patients **Empathy** is also necessary to understand history.
