## sprawl

- v. to sit, lie, or fall with one's arms and legs spread out synonym: drape, spread out
- (1) **sprawl** out luxuriously on the sofa, (2) **sprawl** for acres The lush vegetation **sprawls** across the wonderfully landscaped gardens.

# skyscraper

- n. a very tall building, typically one in a citysynonym: high-rise, tower

#### retardant

 a substance used to slow or prevent the spread of fire; a chemical added to a material to make it less flammable; (adjective) of or relating to something that slows down or

# inhibits a process or action

*synonym*: inhibitor, suppressant, stopper

(1) age **retardant**, (2) fire- **retardant** equipment

The engineer added a corrosion **retardant** to the metal structure to extend its lifespan

#### nascent

 adj. in the process of emerging, becoming apparent, or coming into existence; recently formed or developed

synonym: emerging, developing, budding

(1) nascent industry, (2) nascent idea

The company was still **nascent** and had much growing to do.

# paradox

 a statement, situation, or person that has two opposite facts or features and therefore seems impossible, is difficult to understand, or is strange;

synonym: incongruity, dichotomy, contradiction

(1) French **paradox**, (2) the **paradox** of the heap There are many theories to explain this **paradox**.

### banal

adj. lacking originality, creativity, or freshness; uninteresting or dull due to being overused or overly familiar

synonym: trite, mundane, dull

(1) banal conversation, (2) banal plot

The restaurant's menu had a **banal** selection of generic dishes with no unique or exciting options.

### compost

 a mixture of organic matter, such as food scraps, yard waste, and manure, that is allowed to decompose and is used as fertilizer for plants and garden soil

synonym: fertilizer, humus, manure

(1) organic compost, (2) compost pile

You can add coffee grounds and crushed eggshells to your **compost** to improve the pH balance.

#### stormwater

 water that accumulates during and after rainfall or snowmelt, usually flowing into waterways, sewers, or drainage systems synonym: rainwater, runoff, drainage

(1) **stormwater** management, (2) **stormwater** runoff The **stormwater** drainage system must be improved to prevent flooding in the neighborhood.

# footprint

- n. a mark of a foot, shoe, or animal's foot left on a surfacesynonym: footmark, imprint, impression

#### outskirt

### **landmass**
