#### fascinate

v. to attract and hold the attention of someone deeply and irresistibly

synonym: captivate, intrigue, mesmerize

#### urchin

 a poor and mischievous young child, usually living on the street or in a disadvantaged community; a small, spiny marine animal with a round body and long, pointed spines

synonym: mischief, waif, guttersnipe

#### industrialize

- v. to organize the production of something into an industry synonym: motorize
- (1) **industrialize** service, (2) **industrialized** textile production

#### coffin

 a box or container used to bury a dead body; a case or structure resembling a coffin

synonym: casket, box, chest

(1) coffin lid, (2) wooden coffin

The priest prayed over the **coffin** before it was lowered into the ground.

#### octopus

 a sea creature with a soft round body and eight long tentacles (= long parts like arms)

*synonym*: devilfish

(1) giant octopus, (2) venomous octopus

He experienced nausea after eating live octopus.

## scorpion

 a small creature similar to an insect with a segmented body, a pair of pincers, and a long, thin tail that ends in a venomous sting

synonym: arachnid, stinger

(1) **scorpion** fish, (2) poisonous **scorpion** 

The **scorpion's** venom can be lethal to humans.

#### seaweed

 a plant that grows in the sea or on land very close to the sea, especially marine algae

synonym: kelp, algae

(1) floating **seaweed**, (2) **seaweed** broth

She soaked **seaweed** in water until tender.

# kaleidoscope

- a toy or optical instrument made up of mirrors and pieces of colored glass or plastic, which produce changing patterns and images when rotated; a constantly changing succession of different things or events
- (1) **kaleidoscope** of cultures, (2) **kaleidoscope** pattern
  The **kaleidoscope** of colors in the sunset was breathtaking.

## pristine

adj. new and completely free from dirt or contamination synonym: chaste, pure, immaculate

(1) **pristine** beach, (2) maintain the **pristine** condition

It is terrific to camp in **pristine** nature.

## visionary

- adj. having or showing exceptional foresight and imagination; not practical or realizable; speculativesynonym: prophetic, far-sighted, imaginative
- visionary business, (2) visionary ideas
   The visionary leader had a clear plan for the company's future.

#### tame

- v. to make wild animals domesticated or controlled, especially through specific training; (adjective) not dangerous or afraid of people, either naturally or because of specific training
- synonym: domesticate, soften, (adjective) harmless
- (1) **tame** a wild beast, (2) a **tame** animal We have to **tame** substantial financial deficits at first.

#### mammal

- any animal of which the female gives birth to live young, not eggs, and feeds her young on milk from her own body
- (1) a primitive **mammal**, (2) a sort of **mammal**Marine **mammal** populations are declining worldwide due to ocean pollution.

#### domesticate

- v. to take control of animals or plants to provide food, power, or company
- synonym: tame, naturalize, cultivate
- (1) easy to **domesticate**, (2) **domesticate** the plant We **domesticate** cows to gain milk and meat.

#### wildfire

- a large, uncontrolled fire that spreads quickly through a natural area such as a forest, grassland, or mountain slope
- synonym: blaze, bonfire, flame
- (1) **wildfire** spread, (2) arson-caused **wildfire**The **wildfire** destroyed hundreds of homes and forced thousands of people to evacuate.

## grassland

 a large area of land covered mainly by grass, with few or no trees, and typically used for grazing livestock

synonym: meadow, plain, savanna

(1) endangered **grassland**, (2) vast **grassland**Meadows and pastures are examples of smaller-scale **grasslands** in many parts of the world.

#### rewild

v. to restore an area of land to its natural state, especially by reintroducing locally extinct species

synonym: restore, return, rehabilitate

(1) rewild land, (2) rewild an area

The government is considering a plan to **rewild** certain areas by reintroducing native species and removing non-native ones.

## peatland

 an area covered with peat (= a partially decayed organic matter formed from plants)

*synonym*: bog, marsh, moor

(1) peatland ecosystem, (2) peatland bog

The preservation of **peatlands** is crucial in mitigating climate change, as they help regulate the Earth's temperature and reduce atmospheric carbon dioxide.

# mangrove

- *n.* a tropical coastal tree or shrub that grows in saline soil and has prop roots that help to stabilize it
- (1) mangrove forest, (2) mangrove swamp

The **mangrove** trees are known for their ability to survive in saltwater and sandy soil.

#### kelp

- n. a large brown seaweed that grows in cold coastal waterssynonym: seaweed, marine algae
- (1) kelp forest, (2) giant kelp

The coast was lined with beds of **kelp** swaying in the tide.

### stabilize

v. to become or cause to become steady or unlikely to give way

synonym:

brace, steady, secure

(1) **stabilize** prices, (2) **stabilize** blood sugar levels
The raising of interest rates **stabilizes** the inflation rate.

#### trade-off

 a balance achieved between two desirable but incompatible features; an exchange that occurs as a compromise

*synonym*: compromise, balance, exchange

(1) **trade-off** problem, (2) environmental **trade-off**There was a **trade-off** between speed and accuracy in the task.

#### subsidize

v. to pay part of the cost of something to support an organization, activity, etc. financially

synonym: finance, endow, sponsor

(1) **subsidize** the project, (2) **subsidize** the cost Governments **subsidize** renewable energy generation in various ways.

#### industrious

adj. hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effortsynonym: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

(1) **industrious** worker, (2) **industrious** student He was known to be very **industrious** and would often work late into the night.

# pollute

 to make an area or substance, such as land, air, water, etc., dirty or harmful to living things by adding waste matter or harmful chemicals

synonym: contaminate, corrupt, degrade

pollute the air, (2) pollute the thread
 We should do our best not to pollute the environment.
