### poke

- to push or prod with a sharp object or the finger synonym: prod, jab, push

## prod

to poke or jab with a pointed object, often to urge or encourage movement or action; to provoke or stimulate someone to take action or respond in a particular way

synonym: poke, jab, nudge

(1) **prod** him into action, (2) **prod** him with a stick She used a stick to **prod** the fire and make it burn brighter.

uterus

a hollow muscular organ in the body of a woman or other female mammal in which a baby or young animal develops before birth

*synonym*: womb

(1) uterus cancer, (2) bleeding from uterus The physician prescribed medication to relieve the contraction of the uterus.

#### **obstetrics**

the branch of medicine that deals with the care of n. women during pregnancy, childbirth, and the postpartum period, including the management of complications and the health of the mother and baby

synonym: midwifery, childbirth, tocology

(1) **obstetrics** ward, (2) **obstetrics** clinic The hospital's **obstetrics** department is responsible for

caring for pregnant women and delivering babies.

## gynecology

the medical study and treatment of the physiology and diseases of the female reproductive system

synonym: obstetrics, women's health, women's medicine

(1) gynecology clinic, (2) gynecology exam The **gynecology** department at the hospital offers state-of-the-art treatments for women's health issues.

## endocrinology

n. the study of hormones, their regulation, and their effects on the body; includes the study of endocrine glands such as the pituitary gland, thyroid gland, and adrenal gland

synonym: hormone science, hormonal disorder treatment

## motility

 the ability or capacity of organisms or particles to move spontaneously or in response to external stimuli; the degree or speed of movement

*synonym*: movement, mobility, motion

(1) motility rate, (2) sperm motility

The doctor was concerned about the **motility** of the patient's digestive system.

#### semen

 the fluid that contains sperm and is ejaculated during sexual activity, which may fertilize an egg and lead to pregnancy

synonym: sperm, reproductive fluid, seed

(1) **semen** donation, (2) **semen** volume

After undergoing a **semen** analysis, the doctor told him that he had a low sperm count.

#### hound

v. to persistently pursue, harass, or pressure someone or something, often in a negative or unwelcome way; (noun) a type of dog, often bred for hunting that has a keen sense of smell and is known for its persistence and tenacity

synonym: chase, badger, annoy
