#### deviate

- v. to depart from an established course or plan; to change direction or take a different route or approachsynonym: stray, diverge, veer
- (1) **deviate** from the norm, (2) **deviate** from the plan It's important not to **deviate** from the established safety procedures.

#### astray

adv. away from the right path or direction synonym: off course, misdirected, wayward

#### puppet

 a doll or figure that is manipulated by strings, wires, or hands to represent a person or animal; a person who is controlled or manipulated by someone else

synonym: marionette, dummy, mannequin

hijab

 a headscarf traditionally worn by Muslim women to cover their hair and neck

synonym: veil, headscarf, cover

#### underestimate

v. to think or suppose that a quantity, price, or size is smaller than it is

synonym: underrate, misjudge, miscalculate

#### avid

adj. characterized by enthusiasm and vigorous pursuit, especially of an interest or activity

synonym: enthusiastic, eager, fervent
