#### empower

- v. to give someone the power or authority to do something synonym: authorize, endow, entitle

The company **empowered** employees to buy low-price items without approval to achieve efficient purchasing.

#### industrious

adj. hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effort synonym: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

(1) **industrious** worker, (2) **industrious** student He was known to be very **industrious** and would often work late into the night.

#### nimble

adj. quick and light in movement or action synonym: agile, quick, flexible

(1) **nimble** handling, (2) **nimble-minded** person His **nimble** movements allowed him to navigate the crowded streets with ease.

### misconception

- a belief or an idea that is wrong because it has been based on faulty thinking, understanding, or hypothesis
   synonym: fallacy, incomprehension, misunderstanding
- (1) dispel the **misconception**, (2) commonly held **misconception**

### opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purposesynonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

#### outdo

- v. to do better than someone; to surpass synonym: excel, surpass, outshine
- (1) **outdo** him in trickery, (2) **outdo** the competition He tried to **outdo** his rival by breaking the world record.

#### immersion

 the act of putting someone or something into a liquid completely; the state of being completely involved in a subject or activity

synonym: submergence, involvement, engagement

(1) baptism by **immersion**, (2) **immersion** in acid I felt like I was in a different world because of the **immersion** experience of virtual reality.

teamwork

 the combined action of a group of people working together towards a common goal

synonym: collaboration, cooperation, coordination

(1) poor **teamwork**, (2) **teamwork** in business Harmonious **teamwork** is essential to the success of this project.
