 a state of complete confusion or disorder, often characterized by a lack of predictability or control

#### incidence

n. the frequency or rate at which a particular event or condition occurs within a specific population, group, or area; the occurrence or manifestation of something, especially something harmful or unpleasant synonym: occurrence, frequency, prevalence

cattle

rogue

 a deceitful and unreliable person; a person who behaves badly

flood

a large amount of water flowing beyond its normal limits;
 an overwhelming number or amount

mercy

 n. compassion or forgiveness shown towards someone whom it is within one's power to punish or harm

synonym: clemency, leniency, compassion

#### rewrite

v. to write something such as a book or speech again in a different way, usually to improve it or add new information

synonym: revise, edit, rework

planet

 any of the nine large celestial bodies that circle in the solar system; any celestial body that revolves around a star

synonym: earth, world, globe

dedicate

v. to give all of your energy, time, etc., entirely to a specific person, activity, or cause; to set apart for a particular purpose or use

*synonym*: consecrate, devote, commit

He **dedicated** his life to helping others.

### roughly

*adv.* approximately but not precisely; with a violent manner *synonym*: approximately, more or less, around

### equivalent

- n. having the same value, quality, meaning, purpose, etc.synonym: equal, counterpart, match
- (1) **equivalent** amounts, (2) **equivalent** in meaning The European Central Bank is Europe's **equivalent** of the Federal Reserve.

#### combine

- v. to join or merge to form a single thing or group synonym: coalesce, cohere, blend

#### livestock

farm animals and birds such as cows, sheep, and chickens

synonym: cattle, oxen, herd

### ranching

### protein

- a molecule made up of a long chain of amino acids, which is essential for the structure and function of the body's tissues

### suddenly

adv. quickly and unexpectedly

synonym: abruptly, unexpectedly, unawares

- a forest rich in biodiversity that is generally found in tropical settings with heavy annual rainfall

#### colon
