# lynch

v. to put to death or punish (usually by hanging) without legal authorization or due process, often as an act of mob justice or vigilante action; (noun) a violent punishment, often extrajudicial, in which a mob or group of people seize and kill someone, usually by hanging, as a form of punishment or vengeance

synonym: hang, execute, mob

#### definition

synonym: description, connotation, meaning

#### execution

 the act or process of carrying out a plan, order, or course of action; the act or process of carrying out the death penalty

synonym: carrying out, implementation, completion

(1) compulsory **execution**, (2) **execution** by injection The **execution** of the plan was flawless, resulting in a record-breaking profit for the company.

technique

a particular way or art of doing something that needs skill

synonym: approach, procedure, strategy

(1) a **technique** in martial arts, (2) the **technique** applied to construction

Jockey's superior **technique** brought him victory.

#### sanction

n. official permission or approval for an action, especially an economic or political action by a government or international organization; a penalty or punishment imposed for breaking the law, rule, or agreement; (verb) to impose a penalty or punishment for breaking the law, rule, or agreement

synonym: approve, authorize, endorse

#### communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals; for common use

# deny

v. to state that one refuses to admit the existence or truth of something

synonym: refute, reject, repudiate

#### refuse

- v. to show that one is not willing to do or accept something synonym: turn down, deny, decline
- (1) **refuse** a request, (2) **refuse** the company My initial reaction was to **refuse**.

#### violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

*synonym*: aggressive, intense, turbulent

(1) victim of a **violent** crime, (2) **violent** incident The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

lore

n. traditional knowledge, stories, or beliefs, often passed down through oral tradition; a body of knowledge or tradition that is often considered to be mythological or legendary in nature

synonym: mythology, legend, tradition

(1) military **lore**, (2) mythological **lore** 

The village's **lore** passed down stories of their ancestors and their traditions.

#### alternative

n. one of two or more available possibilities or choice synonym: choice, option

arch

arrow

legend

an old story that may or may not be accurate regarding some persons and events; a well-known person who is admired by others for a long time, particularly in a particular field

- a notable or impressive achievement, especially one that requires great skill or bravery

feat

synonym: achievement, accomplishment, exploit

#### murder

- n. the crime of killing somebody intentionally synonym: slaying, killing

# interdisciplinary

adj. involving or combining several academic disciplines or fields of study

# spectral

adj. relating to or having the properties of a spectrum (= an ordered array of colors into which a light beam can be split); relating to a ghost or apparition

The **spectral** analysis revealed unexpected details about the composition of the planet's atmosphere.

# proof

 a fact or piece of information that shows something is true or exists

synonym: testimony, evidence, assurance

#### academic

adj. associated with schools, colleges, and universities, especially studying and thinking, not with practical skillssynonym: educational, scholarly, theoretical

(1) **academic** probation, (2) an **academic** discussion

#### transform

v. to change in outward structure or looks;

synonym: alter, convert, change

# portray

#### emotional

adj. relating to people's feelingssynonym: affecting, impactful, impressive

(1) **emotional** health, (2) **emotional** distress Human **emotional** responses vary widely depending on the society to which they belong.

#### relation

 the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another *synonym*: association, linkage, connection

(1) **relation** between cause and effect, (2) **relation** of inclusion

#### addition

 the act or process of adding something to something else; the process of adding numbers

synonym: accumulation, expansion, addendum

chemical addition, (2) addition of vectors
 addition, private corporations provide healthcare services.

### historic

adj. famous or significant in history, or potentially so synonym: memorable, momentous, historical

(1) **historic** accomplishment, (2) achieve the **historic** feat The Chinese people have accomplished several **historic** feats.

#### honor

 n. high regard or great respect for someone; the quality of having and doing based on a keen sense of morality; (verb) to show respect towards someone

synonym: integrity, virtue, acclaim

(1) womanly honor,(2) honor our ancestorsI claim on my honor that it is true.

#### encounter

v. to face something, particularly something unpleasant or difficult, while attempting to do something else; to meet, especially unexpectedly

synonym: meet, run into, come across

encounter a crisis, (2) encounter a storm
 l'm prepared to encounter challenges throughout this adventure.

#### ordinary

adj. not different, exceptional, or unexpected in any way, especially in quality, ability, size, or degree

synonym: mundane, prosaic, average

(1) an **ordinary** school, (2) **ordinary** annual revenue The **ordinary** session of the Diet opened.

urban

adj. relating to or located in a town or city synonym: metropolitan, civic

(1) **urban** planning, (2) **urban** property owners Only a small number of **urban** utilities offer sanitation services.

lease

n. a legal document that grants a person or organization the right to use a property, land, or asset for a specified period of time, usually in exchange for rent or a fee; (verb) to rent or let out a property, vehicle, or other assets to someone for a specified period of time in exchange for payment

synonym: rental, tenancy, agreement

# storytelling

# complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

(1) cognitive **complexity**, (2) **complexity** theory

The project's **complexity** made it difficult for the team to complete it on time.

#### ambivalent

adj. having mixed or conflicting feelings or attitudes towards something or someone; uncertainty or indecision about

what course of action to take

synonym: conflicted, indecisive, unsure

(1) **ambivalent** feelings, (2) **ambivalent** attitude

I feel **ambivalent** about attending the party since I don't know anyone there.

# acknowledged

adj. recognized or admitted as being true or valid synonym: recognized, accepted, admitted

(1) **acknowledged** beauty, (2) publicly **acknowledged** truth His **acknowledged** expertise in the field earned him the respect of his peers.

#### **furious**

adj. extremely angry; full of ragesynonym: angry, rageful, livid

The coach was **furious** with the players for their lack of effort during the game.

#### victim

 a person who has been harmed, injured, or otherwise negatively affected by a particular action, circumstance, or event

synonym: prey, target, sufferer

The **victim** of the crime deserves justice and support to recover from the trauma.

# injustice

- n. a violation of the rights of others or the laws of a societysynonym: unfairness, bias, discrimination
- (1) gross injustice, (2) injustice system

# mysterious

adj. difficult to understand, explain, or identify; having an aura of secrecy, intrigue, or puzzlement

#### jail

*n.* a facility where criminals are kept to be punished for their crimes; a prison

#### abandon

#### wheelchair

#### slam

# laughter

 a charitable institution that provides housing, food, and other basic needs to people who are poor, disabled, or elderly and do not have family or financial support

synonym: shelter, asylum

#### carceral

- adj. relating to or involving a prison or other institution for the confinement of criminals or detainees; characterized by confinement or restriction
- (1) **carceral** punishment, (2) **carceral** facility

  The **carceral** system in the US has long been criticized for its excessive use of incarceration as punishment.

#### statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) **statistics** for cancer, (2) official **statistics**The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

# **immigrant**

 a person who has come to a country where they were not born to live there permanently

synonym: settler, expatriate, emigrant

(1) **immigrant** communities, (2) an **immigrant** from the country

Police received a report of illegal **immigrants** in the area.

### bury

- v. to place a dead body in the ground, grave, or tomb synonym: entomb, sink, forget
- (1) **bury** in the earth, (2) **bury** emotion

There is plenty of space to **bury** everyone.

#### marked

adj. having a noticeable feature or distinctive quality; easily noticeable or obvious

synonym: distinct, prominent, striking

(1) a marked difference, (2) marked decline

Her **marked** improvement in her grades resulted from her increased focus and effort.

### grave

n. a place where a dead body is buried, typically marked by a headstone or other memorial; a very serious, solemn, or important matter; (verb) to carve, cut, or etch a design, inscription, or mark onto a hard surface, such as stone or metal; (adjective) serious, solemn, or weighty in nature

*synonym*: tomb, crypt, sepulcher

(1) **grave** an image, (2) **grave** mistake

Many innocent civilians were killed and buried in mass graves outside the city during the war.

#### tribune

 an official in ancient Rome who represented various social groups and had the power to veto decisions made by other officials; a platform or elevated area used for speaking or addressing a public audience

synonym: platform, podium, stand

crowd of cheering supporters.

# argue

v. to express differing opinions or points of view, often in a heated or contentious manner; to present a case or reasoning to persuade or convince others

*synonym*: debate, dispute, quarrel

(1) **argue** a case, (2) **argue** passionately

The couple began to **argue** over which restaurant to go to for dinner.

#### unwelcome

adj. not wanted, not invited, or not appreciated; causing annoyance or displeasure

synonym: uninvited, disliked, undesired

(1) **unwelcome** interruption, (2) **unwelcome** surprise
The **unwelcome** visitor quickly made their presence known.

#### resident

 a person who lives in a particular place or has their home in a place

synonym: dweller, inhabitant, inhabitant

(1) a **resident** of the city, (2) **resident** tax

Visa renewal for **resident** foreigners in this country is once every five years.

# appropriate

*adj.* suitable or proper in the circumstances; fitting *synonym*: fitting, suitable, proper

(1) **appropriate** behavior, (2) an **appropriate** time It would be **appropriate** to dress nicely for the wedding.

# gentrify

v. to renovate, revitalize, or develop a deteriorated, predominantly urban area, often leading to the displacement of low-income or minority residents and the influx of more affluent residents and businesses

synonym: revitalize, renovate, renew

(1) **gentrify** a community, (2) **gentrify** a street

The new coffee shops and high-end boutiques are starting to **gentrify** the neighborhood.

#### sacred

 adj. connected with religion or religious purposes; worthy of respect or dedication because of a connection with a god

synonym: holy, inviolable, hallowed

(1) **sacred** music, (2) the halo of a **sacred** image
This space is a private office **sacred** to the President

#### burial

- n. the act or ceremony of placing a dead body in a gravesynonym: interment, funeral, entombment
- (1) burial at sea, (2) a round burial mound

The **burial** ceremony was a somber reminder of his passing.

# tropical

adj. originating in, located in, or characteristic of the tropics synonym: equatorial, tropic

(1) tropical cyclones, (2) tropical islands

**Tropical** storm Marco is making his way along the coast of Florida.

#### unconscious

adj. in the state of lacking awareness and the capacity for sensory perception, especially as the result of a head injury or illness

synonym: comatose, paralyzed, senseless

(1) **unconscious** bias, (2) a person who is **unconscious** I know his **unconscious** habit that he touches his face when he lies.

# grapple

v. to make a strenuous effort to solve a problem; to engage in a close fight or conflict without weapons

synonym: brawl, scuffle, wrestle

(1) **grapple** with problem, (2) **grapple** with each other He needed to **grapple** with structural reforms to improve the company's revenue.

# belong

v. to be the property of someone or something; to be a member or part of a group; to be in the proper or appropriate place

*synonym*: fit, be appropriate, be suitable

(1) **belong** to different species, (2) **belong** to a group All the books in this section **belong** to the library's rare collection and must be handled carefully.

#### beloved

adj. loved very much

synonym: adored, cherished, dear

(1) **beloved** author, (2) **beloved** by many people I am here to save my **beloved**.

# grandparent

- n. a parent of one's father or mother
- (1) great- **grandparent**, (2) person of **grandparent** age She was close to her paternal **grandparents** and often spent summers with them.

# hallway

- n. an interior passage or corridor onto which rooms opensynonym: foyer, corridor, entrance
- the head of a hallway,
   wax a hallway floor
   dashed down a hallway to a bathroom.

#### elevator

 n. a mechanical device used for vertical transportation, typically in multi-story buildings, consisting of a compartmentalized platform that moves between floors

*synonym*: lift, hoist

# operator

 a person who uses and controls machinery or equipment; a mathematical symbol used to perform calculations

*synonym*: controller, handler, manipulator

### locate

v. to specify or determine the exact position of someone or something

synonym: discover, find, place

(1) locate a missing pet, (2) locate a tumor

The robot can accurately **locate** construction material.

### haunted

adj. inhabited, visited, or frequented by ghosts or spirits;
 disturbed or troubled by persistent or disturbing
 memories or emotions

synonym: spooky, eerie, ghostly

(1) haunted house, (2) haunted by memories

The old mansion was known to be **haunted**, with strange noises and eerie sightings reported by visitors.

# lobby

 a large area inside the entrance of a public building where people can meet and wait; a group of people who try to persuade a politician, the government, or an official group to influence legislation

synonym: entrance, hall, anteroom

(1) **lobby** for legislation, (2) a hotel **lobby** 

That **lobby** group actively advocated environmental protection to the government.

#### interact

- v. to communicate or react with somebody synonym: cooperate, combine, collaborate
- (1) **interact** directly with customers, (2) **interact** with one another

He should interact more with his colleagues.

#### disturb

- v. to interrupt someone who is trying to work, sleep, etc. synonym: agitate, bother, intrude
- (1) **disturb** the peace, (2) **disturb** his sleep Tourists frequently **disturb** the island's delicate natural balance.

#### imaginary

adj. existing only in someone's mindsynonym: fictional, ideal, fantastical

(1) **imaginary** number, (2) **imaginary** pregnancy Little children tend to have **imaginary** friends.

# suddenly

adv. quickly and unexpectedly synonym: abruptly, unexpectedly, unawares

(1) **suddenly** attacked by an enemy, (2) die **suddenly** Who answers **suddenly** knows little.

#### convinced

adj. completely certain about something; having a strong belief or conviction in a particular religion

synonym:

confident, positive, indoctrinated

(1) **convinced** of the idea, (2) **convinced** criminal The public is **convinced** that the prime minister has committed fraud.

#### faucet

- n. a device for controlling the flow of liquid from a pipe synonym: tap, spigot, valve
- (1) a water faucet,(2) faucet handleI turned on the faucet to wash my hands.

# prank

 a playful or mischievous trick, practical joke, or act of mischief performed with the intention of amusing or surprising others

synonym: hoax, trick, stunt

(1) prank caller, (2) harmless prank

The group of teenagers played an innocent **prank** on their teacher, but it backfired, and they got in trouble.

#### intimate

adj. having a very close friendship, personal

synonym: close, tight, friendly

(1) my **intimate** affairs, (2) **intimate** relationship He has an **intimate** knowledge of American history.

# desperately

adv. in a way that shows a lack of hope and a willingness to do anything because of the problematic situation; with great urgency

synonym: urgently, perilously, seriously

(1) **desperately** anxious, (2) **desperately** ill patient The baby clung **desperately** to her mother.

horror

 intense fear or disgust, especially at something shocking or terrifying

synonym: fear, terror, dread
