## greenhouse

## emission

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

#### default

v. to fail to fulfill an obligation or pay a debt when it is due; to fail to meet expectations or perform as required; to choose or accept a predetermined option or condition without making a deliberate selection or choice; (noun) a failure to fulfill an obligation or to meet a requirement; the pre-set or automatic settings that a system or program uses when the user has selected no other options

synonym: fail, neglect, omit

## colleague

one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

## miserable

adj. very unhappy, uncomfortable, or unpleasant; causing great distress or suffering

synonym: unhappy, wretched, cheerless

#### strike

- to wallop somebody or something with the hand, fist, or weapon; to have an emotional or cognitive impact upon synonym: hit, impact, influence

## instigate

to initiate, start or incite something, often to cause trouble, conflict, or violence; to urge or stir someone to take a particular action or behavior

## trigger

#### institutional

#### whirlwind

 a very strong wind that moves rapidly in circles and causes a lot of damage

synonym: tornado, waterspout, dust devil

economic whirlwind, (2) whirlwind of events
 we went on a whirlwind visit to the sightseeing spot.

pet

- an animal that you have at home as a companion and treated kindly
- (1) a **pet** bird, (2) a teacher's **pet** I have a parrot as a **pet**.

## adopt

v. to choose to follow something; to legally take a child from another family and care for them as if they were one's own

synonym: accept, assume, take on

(1) adopt a child, (2) adopt a bill

The national assembly has adopted the budget.

## vegan

- a person who does not eat or use any animal products, typically for ethical or environmental reasons
- (1) raw food vegan, (2) vegan lifestyle

The vegan diet is based on plant-based foods.

## agriculture

 the practice or science of cultivating the land or raising stock

synonym: farming, husbandry, agribusiness

(1) organic **agriculture**, (2) intensive **agriculture Agriculture** is the foundation of our economy.

#### diet

n. the food and drink that a person, animal, or community eats and drinks regularly; a legislative assembly in certain countries, for example, Japan

*synonym*: food, dietary

#### medical

 adj. relating to the treatment of illness or injuries; relating to the practice of medicine

## experiment

 the scientific test conducted to observe what happens and gain new knowledge

#### vitamin

## phytochemical

#### brain

## deprivation

*n.* a state of not having something, such as food or money, that you need for a pleasant life

#### aim

- v. to try or plan to get or achieve something
- synonym: aspire, direct, target

#### balance

 a condition in which everything has the same weight or force; something left after other parts have been taken away

synonym: equilibrium, counterpoise, remainder

#### maxim

- a well-known phrase that expresses a general or fundamental truth, principle, or rule for behavior
- synonym: adage, proverb, aphorism

#### gram

- a metric unit of weight equal to one-thousandth of a kilogram

synonym: give off, radiate, expel

## roughly

## poultry

## fridge

#### environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

#### recommend

v. to suggest that someone or something would be a suitable fit for a particular purpose or role

synonym: advise, suggest, instruct

(1) **recommend** a hospitalization, (2) **recommend** reading We **recommend** taking media training every six months.

#### condiment

 a substance or mixture of substances, such as spices, sauce, salt, or other seasonings, used to enhance the flavor of food

*synonym*: seasoning, flavoring, spice

(1) **condiment** dispenser, (2) spicy **condiments**Ketchup, mustard, and mayo are common **condiments** for burgers and sandwiches.

#### disagree

## sight

## carpool

#### dreadful

*adj.* very bad, unpleasant, or causing fear *synonym*: terrible, horrible, awful

### ditch

a long, narrow, and shallow depression or channel that is dug into the ground; (verb) to throw away

synonym: trench, channel, furrow

## virtually

adv. almost completely

synonym: almost, basically, nearly

#### cannabinoid

n. a class of chemical compounds found in cannabis plants that interact with the human body's endocannabinoid system, producing a range of biological effects, including pain relief, anti-inflammatory action, and mood alteration

synonym: cannabis compound, CBD, THC

#### contribute

## euphoria

*n.* an abundance of wealth, resources, or property; prosperity

synonym: wealth, prosperity, richness

enhance

v. to increase or improve the quality, amount, or strength of someone or something

*synonym*: improve, enrich, refine

autonomy

*n.* the right of an organization, country, or region to govern itself independently

synonym: independence, sovereignty, self-sufficiency

## strategy

 a detailed plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall goal.

synonym: approach, procedure, scenario

## policy

n. a set of rules, guidelines, principles, or procedures that govern decision-making or action, often used in the context of business or government; a course of action or plan of action adopted or followed by an organization or individual to achieve a goal or objective

synonym: strategy, plan, guideline

The company's new **policy** on remote work has made it a more inclusive workplace.

## government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

enact
