synonym: compulsion, fixation, enthusiasm

#### overstressed

adj. experiencing a level of stress or anxiety that exceeds one's capacity to cope; feeling overwhelmed or mentally strained

synonym: overworked, stressed out, overwhelmed

- a period of excessive or uncontrolled consumption, often of food or alcohol; a spree or bout of reckless behavior or indulgence

synonym: spree, overindulgence, splurge

(1) binge on social media, (2) alcohol binge She stayed up all night binge-watching her favorite TV show.

### figurative

adj. using figures of speech, especially metaphors, to create a special effect; not literal

synonym: metaphorical, symbolic, allegorical

- (1) in a **figurative** sense, (2) **figurative** painting When he said he was starving to death, it was a figurative way of saying he was very hungry.
- to commit or dedicate oneself or one's time, effort, or energy to a particular task or purpose

synonym: commit, dedicate, apply

(1) **devote** all of my energies, (2) **devote** my own life He **devoted** himself to studying the history of ancient civilizations.

#### overlook

to fail to notice something; to watch over someone; to provide a view from above

synonym: disregard, look down, supervise

- (1) **overlook** a street, (2) **overlook** that fact We cannot **overlook** an opportunity for great success.

#### categorize

*synonym*: classify, pigeonhole, sort

### inquisitive

adj. curious and interested in learning or finding out about things; questioning or prying into matters that are not one's concern; curious or nosy

synonym: curious, inquiring, nosy

(1) inquisitive mind, (2) inquisitive researcher

The **inquisitive** child asked endless questions about the world around her.

### smartphone

- a mobile phone that functions as a computer and connects to the Internet
