# incomprehensible

The mathematical formula was **incomprehensible** to most of the students.

#### mandarin

n. an influential and high-ranking official, notably in the civil service; the branch of Chinese, which is the official language of China

synonym: Chinese, Beijing dialect

(1) ancient mandarin house, (2) Mandarin Chinese Mandarin dialects typically have relatively few vowels.

#### Cantonese

 a dialect of Chinese spoken in and around the city of Guangzhou (Canton) in southern China, as well as by many overseas Chinese communities;

synonym: Chinese dialect, Guangdong dialect, Yue dialect

(1) **Cantonese-style** roast duck, (2) **Cantonese** dialect She took **Cantonese** classes to communicate better with her Chinese colleagues.

#### dissimilar

adj. not alike or having little in common synonym: unalike, different, distinct

dub

v. to give someone or something an unofficial name or nickname; to provide movies with a voice of a foreign language

synonym: name, designate, nickname

(1) dub the film in English, (2) dub dataWe dubbed him Ironman because of his toughness.

#### subtitle

n. a secondary title or alternate title that is displayed below the primary title often used to provide additional information or translation for a movie or video; a text that appears at the bottom of a movie, TV show, or video to provide a written translation or transcription of the spoken dialogue in another language

*synonym*: caption, heading, inscription

(1) chart **subtitle**, (2) foreign-language **subtitle**Make sure to turn on **subtitles** so you can understand the

## intelligibility

- n. the quality or state of being intelligible or easily understood; clarity of expression or communicationsynonym: clarity, comprehensibility, understandability
- (1) intelligibility test, (2) visual intelligibility

The teacher emphasized the importance of clear enunciation to increase her students' speech **intelligibility**.

#### determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

synonym: cause, factor, element

(1) environmental **determinant**, (2) a **determinant** of crop yields

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

# pronounce

 to say or speak (a word or words) correctly or in a particular way

synonym: articulate, enunciate, voice

(1) **pronounce** a judgment, (2) **pronounce** a name

She struggled to **pronounce** the word in a foreign language.

#### coincident

adj. happening or operating in the same place or at the same time

synonym: concurrent, accompanying, coextensive

(1) **coincident** indicators, (2) a series of **coincident** events **Coincident** with the negotiation, the bank was permitted to open a Beijing branch.

#### deem

- v. to consider or decide something in a particular waysynonym: believe, consider, suppose
- (1) **deem** socially responsible, (2) **deem** wrong or inappropriate

#### colonize

v. to establish a colony in or on a specific place; to settle or occupy in large numbers

synonym: settle, occupy, inhabit

### unify

v. to bring or join something together so that they form a single unit

synonym: bring together, consolidate, merge

(1) unify the system, (2) unify the party

The people believe that they can **unify** the country.

#### fascist

 adj. relating to or supporting fascism, which is a political ideology that emphasizes authoritarian government, nationalism, and suppression of political opposition and individual liberties

synonym: authoritarian, dictatorial, totalitarian

The regime was accused of being **fascist** for their oppressive tactics.

#### dictator

 a political leader who has complete power over a country, especially one who has obtained control by force

*synonym*: autocrat, tyrant, despot

# unsophisticated

adj. lacking refinement, education, or worldly experience;
 simple or straightforward in nature or style; not complex or sophisticated

*synonym*: naive, simple, inexperienced

### gatekeeper

 a person, organization, or system that controls or monitors access to something, often a website, database, or institution; a person or group that controls or regulates access to information, especially for a particular perspective or interest

synonym: guardian, watchman, custodian

(1) gatekeeper role, (2) information gatekeeper

The company's **gatekeeper screened** all incoming phone calls and emails to ensure only important ones reached the boss.

#### vernacular

 a language or dialect spoken by the ordinary people in a particular country or region

synonym: dialect, idiom, lingo

(1) **vernacular** language, (2) native **vernacular** 

The poet wrote in the **vernacular** of ordinary people.

#### posit

 $\nu$ . to suggest or accept something as fact or as a basis for argument or consideration

synonym: assert, declare, assume

(1) **posit** the existence of life after death, (2) **posit** the premise

We should **posit** several hypotheses to discuss the matter.

# linguist

a person who speaks several foreign languages; a person who studies or teaches languages or linguistics

synonym: grammatist, philologue, polyglot

(1) foreign **linguist**, (2) cognitive **linguist** 

Though I love literature, I'm a bad **linguist**.

# murky

adj. dark and gloomy or difficult to see through synonym: dim, fuzzy, foggy

(1) murky waters, (2) a murky dungeon

Prospects for the suspect's conviction are **murky** due to a lack of helpful evidence.

#### pollinate

v. to transfer pollen from the male part of a flower to the female part, thereby fertilizing the plant and allowing it to produce fruit or seeds; to spread or disseminate an idea or influence to others

*synonym*: fertilize, propagate

(1) pollinate plants, (2) pollinate fruit trees

Without bees to **pollinate** the flowers, many crops would not exist.

#### confound

 to confuse or perplex; to mix up or throw into disorder; to prove to be false or illogical

synonym: confuse, mix up, perplex

(1) **confound** right and wrong, (2) **confound** the problem The unexpected events **confounded** the scientists, who had to rethink their hypothesis.

# dazzling

adj. shining brightly; highly attractive or exciting synonym: astonishing, breathtaking, flashy

(1) dazzling debut, (2) dazzling views

Last night, the team delivered a **dazzling** performance.
