buffalo

 a large wild ox with shaggy hair found in Asia and North America

synonym: bison, ox, beefalo

#### hunt

v. to go after and try to catch wild animals to kill them for food, sport, or profit

synonym: chase, pursuit, quest

(1) hunt a job, (2) hunt after knowledge

Hounds **hunt** their prey by using their keen scent.

## plain

adj. without being decorated in any way; (Noun) a vast expanse of flat land with few trees

synonym: basic, straight, bare

(1) plain answer, (2) delta plain

The lowest lowland region is mostly flat plain.

#### locate

v. to specify or determine the exact position of someone or something

synonym: discover, find, place

(1) **locate** a missing pet, (2) **locate** a tumor

The robot can accurately **locate** construction material.

#### dominant

adj. more important, influential, or easy to notice than anything else of the same type

synonym: chief, predominant, prevailing

(1) achieve a **dominant** share, (2) **dominant** force Her company soon won a **dominant** market share.

vie

 to compete or contend for something, usually a prize, position, or advantage; to strive for superiority or mastery in one's field or area of expertise

synonym: compete, contend, strive

(1) vie for a trophy, (2) vie for attention

They both **vied** for the top spot in the company.

#### woodland

- n. land covered with trees and underbrush; a forest synonym: forest, grove, copse
- (1) woodland creatures, (2) broad-leafed woodland

We walked through the **woodland** and saw many different types of plants and animals.

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) nation-state, (2) a seafaring nation

The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

#### council

 a group of people who have been elected or appointed to make decisions or give advice on a particular subject or in a particular place

synonym: board, committee, assembly

(1) other **council** members, (2) city **council** election The city **council** voted to approve the new development project.

alliance

 a partnership or association formed for mutual benefit, particularly between nations or organizations.

synonym: pact, accord, coalition

(1) form alliance, (2) major airline alliances

To sell the product, the companies have formed an **alliance**.

#### wetland

adj. land that is saturated with water, either permanently or seasonally, such as swamps, marshes, and bogs

*synonym*: bog, marsh, swamp

(1) wetland conservation, (2) wetland ecosystem

The **wetland** area was home to many different species of birds.

## valley

 a long depression on the surface of the land, which typically contains a river

synonym: canyon, gorge, dale

(1) valley bottom, (2) basin-shaped valley

The **valley** had received a mild snowfall the previous week.

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#### colonize

v. to establish a colony in or on a specific place; to settle or occupy in large numbers

synonym: settle, occupy, inhabit

(1) colonize planets, (2) colonize for cultivation

European powers **colonized** much of the Americas in the 16th and 17th centuries.

#### destabilize

- v. to cause something to become less stable or secure synonym: unsettle, disrupt, upset
- (1) **destabilize** the market, (2) **destabilize** a good relationship

The political crisis **destabilized** the country and caused widespread turmoil.

#### tribe

 a social group made up of members who live together, sharing the same language, culture, religion, etc., especially those who do not live in towns or cities

synonym: family, clan, kinsfolk

## profit

*n.* money that is earned in business or by selling things after deducting the costs involved

synonym: earnings, gain, proceeds

fur

 the hairy coat of a mammal, especially when fine, soft, and thick

synonym: hair, coat, pelt

(1) an artificial fur, (2) fur coat

## opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

*synonym*: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark

The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

#### fertile

adj. capable of producing abundant vegetation or crops; intellectually productive

synonym: fruitful, productive, rich

(1) fertile ground, (2) fertile market

Herbs require **fertile** soil in a sunny, sheltered location.

#### abundant

adj. present in great quantity

synonym: ample, plentiful, generative

(1) live an **abundant** life, (2) an **abundant** supply of water The country has **abundant** oil and natural gas resources.

## homeland

a place regarded as one's native country or where one belongs

synonym: motherland, native country, fatherland

(1) beloved **homeland**, (2) **homeland** pride

I miss my **homeland** and the familiar sights, sounds, and smells.

## immediately

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

(1) **immediately** recall a product, (2) write him an answer **immediately** 

A suspension order from the court is effective **immediately**.

#### claim

v. to assert that something is true; to demand or request something as one's own; to lay legal or moral right to something; (noun) a demand or assertion of a right or something that one believes to be true

synonym: assert, declare, maintain

(1) claim responsibility, (2) false claim

He wants to **claim** ownership of the abandoned property.

## compete

 to strive to achieve more success than someone or something

synonym: contend, contest, vie

(1) **compete** against a friend, (2) **compete** fiercely You must **compete** with others to obtain this position.

#### warrior

 a person who engaged in or experienced warfare, especially in the past

synonym: fighter, soldier, combatant

(1) armored warrior, (2) warrior spirit

The poem depicts the heroics of a legendary warrior.

#### horseback

- n. the back of a horse; the act of riding on a horsesynonym: equestrian, horse riding, mounted
- (1) **horseback** trek, (2) **horseback** adventure We went on a scenic trail ride on **horseback** through the mountains.

## conquer

- v. to bring under control by force or authority synonym: defeat, overpower, subdue

#### tribute

- n. a payment, gift, or other forms of recognition made in honor of or submission to another person or entitysynonym: honor, accolade, recognition

#### maize

#### squash

#### span

 the entire length of something, such as time or space from beginning to end; the amount of space that something covers

#### **lucrative**

*adj.* producing a great deal of profit; financially rewarding *synonym*: profitable, moneymaking, remunerative

Investing in real estate can be a **lucrative** business if done correctly.

toll

money that you have to pay to use a particular road, bridge, etc.; (verb) to ring slowly

synonym: fee, cost, expense

## spectacle

 something or someone seen, especially a notable or unusual sight; an optical device consisting of a frame that houses a pair of lenses for correcting defective vision

*synonym*: marvel, sensation, phenomenon

She could not help watching the sad **spectacle**.

#### chief

adj. most important or primary; (noun) a person who is in charge

synonym: essential, primary, leading

#### refuse

- v. to show that one is not willing to do or accept something synonym: turn down, deny, decline
- (1) **refuse** a request, (2) **refuse** the company My initial reaction was to **refuse**.

## hefty

- adj. large, bulky, and heavy; impressively large, substantial, or powerful; large in amount, extent, or significancesynonym: weighty, substantial, sizeable
- hefty price, (2) hefty breakfast
   The hefty box of books was too heavy to lift on my own.

## spite

n. feelings of anger and resentment; (in spite of, also despite) a phrase that is used to indicate that something happened or exists even though there is a particular obstacle or difficulty

synonym: malice, ill will, vindictiveness

(1) bear **spite** against him, (2) die in **spite** of intensive care He did it out of **spite**, to annoy me.

## rocky

adj. full of or abounding in rocks; of, relating to, or made of rock

synonym: stony, boulder-strewn, rough

(1) **rocky** terrain, (2) **rocky** relationship The **rocky** road made it difficult to drive on.

#### expedition

- n. a journey or voyage for a specific purposesynonym: journey, trip, voyage
- (1) **expedition** team, (2) a polar **expedition**The **expedition** to the Amazon jungle was both exciting and challenging.

#### statistics

*n*. the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data

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## (1) statistics for cancer, (2) official statistics

The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

#### process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

*synonym*: procedure, method, system

(1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process** The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

## government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

#### ammunition

- n. supplies, such as bullets or shells, used by armed forcessynonym: bullets, cartridges, shells
- (1) **ammunition** storage, (2) **ammunition** depot The soldiers were equipped with ample **ammunition** for the battle.

#### smallpox

 a highly contagious viral disease characterized by fever, weakness, spots on the skin, and often death

synonym: variola

(1) **smallpox** epidemic, (2) **smallpox** vaccine An outbreak of **smallpox** occurred in the 1920s.

#### vaccine

 a substance that is put into the body and protects them from disease by causing them to produce antibodies (= proteins that attack harmful bacteria, viruses, etc.)

## epidemic

#### ravage

synonym: endemic, domestic, aboriginal

## acquire

v. to buy or obtain something such as an asset, object, knowledge, etc., for oneself

synonym: attain, earn, catch

(1) **acquire** knowledge, (2) **acquire** a new company Children **acquire** language at a fantastic rate.

#### cede

- v. to give up, surrender, or transfer possession or control of something, especially territory, power, or authoritysynonym: surrender, relinquish, yield
- (1) **cede** power, (2) **cede** custody of the kids The landowner agreed to **cede** part of his property to the government for the public good.

#### bulk

*n.* the quantity or size of something that is very large; the main part of something

synonym: majority, largeness, amount

(1) buy in **bulk**, (2) **bulk** data transfer

I received a parcel of great bulk.

## military

adj. relating to or characteristic of members of the armed forces; of or relating to war or warfare

synonym: armed, martial, warlike

(1) a military operation, (2) a military leader

The **military** academy was known for its strict discipline and training.

#### concentration

n. the ability to focus all your time and energy on one thing without thinking about anything else.

synonym: attention, engagement, assiduity

(1) **concentration** of armaments, (2) his research area of **concentration** 

This exam requires excellent concentration to pass.

## territory

- n. an area under the control of a ruler or state
- synonym: domain, region, realm
- (1) acquire territory, (2) territory in charge

They incorporated the conquered **territory** into their nation.

## expense

the money, time, or effort incurred or required for something

synonym: cost, expenditure, outlay

(1) enormous expenses, (2) expense account

For this project to be successful, we must control **expenses** strictly.

#### formidable

adj. causing fear, apprehension, or awe; difficult to deal with or overcome; capable of inspiring respect or admiration

synonym: daunting, intimidating, fearful

(1) formidable challenge, (2) formidable competitor

The mountain range was a **formidable** obstacle for the hikers.

#### afford

- v. to have enough money or time to be able to buy or do something
- (1) **afford** to buy a new car, (2) **afford** a high travel cost He cannot **afford** a holiday.

## attempt

 an act or effort of trying to do something, especially something difficult

synonym: endeavor, effort, try

(1) the **attempt** to rescue the hostages, (2) a reckless **attempt**

## appease

 to pacify or soothe someone, usually by agreeing to their demands or requests; to calm someone's anger or anxiety

synonym: pacify, calm, soothe

The manager tried to **appease** the angry customer by offering them a refund.

#### steep

adj. having a sharp inclination or slope

synonym: sheer, precipitous, abrupt(1) a steep staircase, (2) steep discount

The **steep** cliff made it difficult to climb.

## reserve

v. to keep something for future use or contingency; to obtain or arrange something, such as a meeting, seat, etc., in advance

synonym: keep, hold, preserve

You can easily **reserve** seats over the telephone.

## expand

v. to increase or to make something greater in size, number, or importance

synonym: extend, grow, boost

(1) **expand** a lineup, (2) **expand** agricultural output They hope to **expand** their business worldwide.

vast

adj. enormous in size, number, amount, or quantity synonym: expansive, extended, boundless

(1) vast majority, (2) vast desert

A vast audience viewed the broadcast.

pursue

 to do something or attempt to attain something over time; to follow or seek someone or something, especially in trying to catch them

synonym: seek, hunt, chase

(1) **pursue** a goal, (2) **pursue** freedoms

She intends to **pursue** a political career.

strategize

v. to plan or devise a detailed plan, especially for achieving success in situations

synonym: plan, devise, scheme

(1) **strategize** for success, (2) **strategize** about how to win The company **strategized** about how to increase sales.

coordinate

v. to bring the different parts of the activity and the people into an organized, ordered, or efficient relationship; (adjective) of equal importance, rank, or degree

synonym: organize, harmonize, ordinate

- (1) **coordinate** a special project, (2) a **coordinate** clause We want to **coordinate** a schedule for the investigation.
- complexity
- the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

(1) cognitive **complexity**, (2) **complexity** theory

The project's **complexity** made it difficult for the team to complete it on time.

## diplomat

 a person appointed by a government to conduct diplomacy (= the management of relationships between countries) with one or more other countries or international organizations

synonym: envoy, ambassador, representative

(1) allied diplomat, (2) expel a diplomat

The senior **diplomat** worked tirelessly to negotiate a peace treaty between the two countries.

## operate

- v. to work in a particular way; to supervise something synonym: work, use, employ
- (1) **operate** 24 hours a day, (2) manually **operate** a machine

This machine is too difficult to **operate** for me.

## lasting

adj. durable and enduring over time; continuing or permanent in effect

*synonym*: enduring, permanent, persistent

(1) lasting impression, (2) lasting impact

Their marriage was built on a foundation of love and trust, which resulted in a **lasting** relationship that spanned over fifty years.

## spiritual

adj. relating to or affecting the human spirit or soul as opposed to material or physical things

*synonym*: otherworldly, ethereal, transcendental

(1) constant **spiritual** striving, (2) **spiritual** leader

The meditation class was focused on finding inner peace and cultivating a more **spiritual** connection with the universe.

## ceremony

- n. a formal event or ritual, often religious or solemnsynonym: ritual, rite, observance
- (1) ceremony hall, (2) ceremony location

The wedding **ceremony** was a beautiful and emotional event.

#### reaffirm

v. to state something again strongly to emphasize that it is still true

synonym: declare, acknowledge, advocate

(1) **reaffirm** a relationship, (2) **reaffirm** the basic points The board member of the pharmaceutical company **reaffirmed** the commitment to public health.

#### communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals;for common use

synonym: collaborative, combined, collective

(1) **communal** swimming pool, (2) **communal** combination of funds

**Communal** elections were held in several European countries.

## spirit

n. the part of a person which is the seat of their mind, feelings, and character rather than their physical body; the general atmosphere of a place or situation and the effect that it has on people

synonym: soul, attitude, enthusiasm

(1) **spirit** and the letter of the law, (2) an indomitable **spirit** Despite their tragic loss, the family is showing great **spirit**.

**balance** 

 a condition in which everything has the same weight or force; something left after other parts have been taken away

synonym: equilibrium, counterpoise, remainder

(1) the **balance** of power, (2) asset on the company's **balance** sheet

Try to keep a **balance** between work and off.

#### horde

 a large group of people or animals, especially one that is chaotic or uncontrolled

synonym: crowd, swarm, mass

horde of attackers, (2) the horde of shoppers
 The horde of zombies was approaching quickly.

settler

a person who moved with a group of others to live in a different country or area

synonym: frontiersperson, immigrant, emigrant

(1) new settlers, (2) settlers on some foreign shoreA large proportion of railway workers in settler colonies were

white.

## encroach

v. to advance beyond the usual or acceptable limit gradually and often without being noticed; to infringe upon someone's territory, rights, privacy, etc.

synonym: invade, impinge, infringe

(1) **encroach** on the realm, (2) **encroach** on the habitat of the animal

You have no right to **encroach** on my leisure time.

#### disturb

- v. to interrupt someone who is trying to work, sleep, etc.
- synonym: agitate, bother, intrude
- (1) **disturb** the peace, (2) **disturb** his sleep Tourists frequently **disturb** the island's delicate natural balance.

#### herd

 a group of animals of the same type that live or are kept together as livestock

synonym: flock, brood, horde

(1) herd of cattle, (2) the common herd

He was riding **herd** on the sheep during the day.

## interpret

v. to explain or assign the meaning of information, actions, etc.

synonym: decode, decipher, analyze

- (1) **interpret** a graph, (2) **interpret** the question
- Different people might **interpret** this news differently.

## migration

n. the movement of animals to a new location, frequently as the seasons change

synonym: exodus

the migration of birds, (2) overseas migration
 There was a migration of impoverished farmers into the

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#### towns.

#### intent

 a strong determination or attention to do or achieve something; (adjective) having a strong determination to do or achieve something

synonym: purpose, aim, goal

(1) the **intent** of a question, (2) **intent** gaze

The designer's **intent** was to create a minimalist aesthetic for the interior of the building.

#### retaliation

- n. the act of seeking vengeance or revenge in response to a perceived wrong or harm suffered, usually to cause harm to the person or group responsible for the initial act
   synonym: retribution, revenge, vengeance
- (1) **retaliation** tactics, (2) **retaliation** against discrimination The company faced heavy **retaliation** from its competitors after releasing a controversial product.

## wagon

n. a four-wheeled vehicle used for transporting goods or people, often pulled by horses, oxen, or other animals; a compartment or container used for storage or transportation, such as a shopping cart or trolley

synonym: cart, buggy, chariot

(1) wagon wheel, (2) station wagon

The circus **wagon** was brightly painted with pictures of the animals inside.

#### conflict

 a strong disagreement, argument, or a violent clash between two opposing groups or individuals

synonym: clash, discord, competition

(1) the **conflict** between good and evil, (2) the longstanding **conflict** 

He and I often had **conflicts**, not only in personality but also in ideology.

## negotiate

to have formal discussions with someone to reach an agreement

synonym: discuss, mediate, bargain

(1) **negotiate** a settlement, (2) **negotiate** the price of the house

We are always happy to **negotiate** a discount.

bull

 a male bovine animal; an investor who has a positive outlook on the market or a particular investment and buys with the expectation of prices increasing

synonym: bovine, cattle, bruiser

(1) bull market, (2) bull fighter

The farmer raised a **bull** on his ranch for breeding purposes.

crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angrysynonym: insane, absurd, bizarre

(1) **crazy** about cars and racing, (2) a **crazy** scheme The rain and thunder are **crazy** today.

mobilize

v. to make something ready for action or use; to organize people or resources for a particular purpose

synonym: activate, rally, marshal

(1) **mobilize** cooperation, (2) **mobilize** a stiff joint The military **mobilized** troops to the border.

arrival

n. the act or situation of coming or being brought to a place; accomplishment of an objective

synonym: reaching, appearance, coming

(1) **arrival** and departure gate, (2) **arrival** at a conclusion Weather forecasters are predicting the **arrival** of a heatwave.

prospector

- n. a person who searches for minerals such as gold or silver by systematically digging, panning, or prospecting synonym: miner, digger, explorer
- (1) **prospector's** shovel, (2) gold **prospector**The **prospector's** camp was in a remote area of the wilderness.

#### occupy

- v. to consume all of someone's space, attention, or time synonym: inhabit, settle, populate
- (1) **occupy** his time, (2) **occupy** a position

The young prince will soon **occupy** the throne.

#### straw

 dry stalks of cereal plants used as fodder, fuel, basket, etc.

synonym: hay, stalk, reed

(1) **straw** basket, (2) rice **straw** 

The **straw** hat protected her face from the sun while she worked in the fields.

#### vision

 the ability to think about or see the future with imagination and intelligence; the faculty of being able to see

synonym: sight, image, concept

(1) a prodigious **vision**, (2) telescopic **vision** 

Driving is difficult for me because of my poor vision.

#### decisive

adj. making a clear and definite decision or choice; settling an issue

synonym: final, conclusive, unambiguous

(1) a **decisive** ballot, (2) **decisive** action

The **decisive** victory in the war ended years of conflict.

#### defeat

- v. to win against somebody in a fight, war, or attempt synonym: conquer, beat, overpower
- (1) **defeat** a global power, (2) **defeat** body odor

Despite his best efforts, he was unable to **defeat** the enemy.

#### victory

 success in a game, competition, election, or battle, or the knowledge that you have won

synonym: win, triumph, success

(1) **victory** in the law court, (2) **victory** over terrorism We are optimistic about our final **victory**.

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#### graver

 a tool used for engraving or carving hard materials such as stone or metal; a person who carves or engraves; (adjective) more serious or important than something else

synonym: burin, chisel, engraving tool

(1) graver marker, (2) graver mistake

The blacksmith used a **graver** to inscribe his name on the forged iron gate.

#### threat

 a strong indication or likelihood of harm, danger, or adverse consequences; an expression of intent to inflict harm or injury on someone or something, often made as a means of coercion or intimidation

synonym: menace, danger, hazard

(1) economic threat, (2) environmental threat

The **threat** of severe weather prompted the city to issue an evacuation warning.

## railroad

- metal tracks laid with rails on which trains run; a system of tracks with the trains operated by an organization
   synonym: railway, track, railway system
- (1) coast-to-coast **railroad**, (2) **railroad** industry

  The town was founded in the 19th century as a stop on the **railroad**, and it grew rapidly as a result.

#### construct

v. to build or create something; to assemble or combine different parts to form something whole

synonym: build, assemble, create

(1) construct a 3D image, (2) construct a dam

He **constructs** hypotheses that no mathematician has ever imagined before.

#### decimate

 to destroy a significant portion of something or reduce by ten percent; to cause extensive destruction or severe damage; to drastically reduce in size or number

synonym: devastate, destroy, annihilate

(1) decimate population, (2) decimate economy

The hurricane **decimated** the small town, leaving behind destruction and devastation.

#### starvation

 a severe lack of food that leads to malnutrition and, ultimately, death
