# inject

*synonym*: shoot, infiltrate, insinuate

# glucagon

 a hormone produced by the pancreas that helps to regulate blood sugar levels by stimulating the liver to convert stored glycogen into glucose

synonym: hormone, stimulator, enhancer

# terrify

- v. to frighten someone very much synonym: unnerve, scare, horrify

# regimen
