# sibling

# landscape

an expanse of scenery that can be seen in a single view;
 a large area of land, especially in the country and relating to its appearance

*synonym*: geography, terrain, topography

# burden

 a duty, responsibility, etc. that is oppressive or worrisome; a load, typically a heavy one that is difficult to carry

synonym: obligation, duty, load

(1) carry a **burden**, (2) **burden** of disease That car has a low environmental **burden**.

# ranching

n. the practice of raising livestock, typically cattle or sheep, on large areas of land, often referred to as ranches, for

meat, wool, or other products

synonym: farming, agriculture, grazing

The government introduced regulations to ensure sustainable ranching practices.

ranch

 a large farm typically devoted to raising cattle or other livestock; a rural property of considerable size and often featuring a large house

synonym: farm, estate, homestead

The cowboys rode their horses through the dusty trails of the ranch.

anchor

n. a device, typically made of metal, that is used to moor a ship or boat in a particular place, typically by being dropped to the seabed; a central cohesive source of support and stability

adrift

 adj. without purpose or direction; floating with no clear destination or goal; lacking a stable or secure position or status

absence

 the fact or condition of being away from a place where they are typically anticipated to be

# presence

 the fact or state that someone or something exists, occurs, or is present

*synonym*: existence, actuality, fact

#### manufacture

v. to make goods in large numbers, usually in a factory using machines

*synonym*: create, fabricate, assemble

- v. to provide a person or a place with the things that are needed for a particular purpose or activity

synonym: prepare, furnish, provide

tin

equip

 a silvery-white metal that is typically soft and malleable, often used to make containers or packaging materials; a thin sheet of metal or metal alloy used for a variety of purposes

The roof of the old shed was made of rusty **tin**.

# railroad

n. metal tracks laid with rails on which trains run; a system of tracks with the trains operated by an organizationsynonym: railway, track, railway system

The town was founded in the 19th century as a stop on the **railroad**, and it grew rapidly as a result.

# decide

v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options

# employ

v. to give somebody a job and pay them for it; to make use of

tagline

n. a memorable slogan or catchphrase used in advertising or entertainment to promote a product, cause, or idea; a brief statement or phrase that sums up the essence of something

synonym: slogan, catchphrase, motto

# companion

 a person or an animal with whom you spend a lot of time, or you travel

synonym: affiliate, fellow, mate

# entrepreneur

 an individual who creates or invests in one or more businesses, especially when this involves taking financial risks

synonym: founder, executive

# cofounder

- one of several people who establishes an organization or starts a business

#### **feminist**

# planet

# retiring

adj. withdrawing from a position or activity, or becoming more secluded or reserved

synonym: shy, leaving, quitting

#### conservation

 n. the protection of something important, such as the natural environment or artificial structures, especially from the damaging effects of human activity

synonym: preservation, protection, saving

# refugee

 a displaced person who has crossed national borders and who cannot or is unwilling to return home due to political, religious, or economic reasons or because of a war

# corporate

adj. of or relating to a large companysynonym: business, commercial, organizational

# cabin

n. a small, simple dwelling or shelter, typically made of wood and located in a remote or rural area; an enclosed compartment or area within a larger structure, such as an aircraft or ship, where passengers or crew members can sit or sleep

synonym: hut, cottage, shack

The quaint **cabin** in the woods was the perfect retreat for a weekend getaway.

#### surround

- v. to be all around something or somebody synonym: encircle, encompass, envelop

# primeval

adj. relating to or existing at the earliest ages; ancient, primitive, or prehistoric

synonym: ancient, primal, archaic

primeval forests, (2) archaic primeval cultures
 The cave paintings offer a glimpse into primeval human art.

# rainforest

- a forest rich in biodiversity that is generally found in tropical settings with heavy annual rainfall
- (1) **rainforest** destruction, (2) tropical **rainforest**The destruction of the **rainforest** is a ticking time bomb for the Earth.

### alerce

- a type of evergreen tree that is native to the Andes mountains of South America

# pan-American

- adj. relating to or involving all of North, Central, and South America

# highway

a main road, especially one connecting major towns or cities

*synonym*: road, expressway, freeway

(1) highway system, (2) an interstate highway

I'm going to take the **highway** to get to my destination faster.

cape

 a type of long, loose outer garment that covers the back, shoulders, and arms; a headland or promontory extending into the sea or other large body of water

synonym: shawl, cloak, mantle

(1) cape cod, (2) red cape

The superhero wore a flowing **cape** as part of their costume.

horn

a hard, pointed, often curved part that grows on the top of the heads of some animals, such as sheep and cows; a noisemaker or musical instrument that makes a loud noise when you blow through it

synonym: cornet, funnel, alarm

(1) a handle of horn, (2) horn of a vehicle

He enjoyed hearing the tootles of their horns with beer.

radical

 adj. relating to the essential aspects of anything; far beyond the norm, mainly used of opinions and actions

*synonym*: extreme, revolutionary

spur

 a thing that encourages someone to do something; any sharply pointed projection; (verb) to incite or stimulate someone or something

synonym: encouragement, motivation, stimulus

The threat of losing his job was the **spur** he needed to work harder.

# recognize

v. to acknowledge or realize something or someone; to identify, remember, or become aware of something that was previously known or encountered

synonym: acknowledge, identify, admit

(1) **recognize** talent, (2) **recognize** achievement It's important to **recognize** your strengths and weaknesses.

# diversity

n. the quality or fact of many different types of things or people being included in something; a range of different things or people

synonym: variety, multiplicity, variousness

(1) the **diversity** policy of the university, (2) lingual **diversity** He was impressed by the range and **diversity** of the collection.

# destroy

 to ruin or damage severely or completely; to eradicate or eliminate completely

synonym: demolish, ruin, obliterate

(1) destroy the ecosystem, (2) destroyed evidenceThe building was destroyed in the fire and had to be rebuilt.

#### relentless

adj. persistent and determined; continuing despite difficulties or setbacks

synonym: unyielding, tireless, unremitting

(1) **relentless** attack, (2) face **relentless** pressure The athlete's **relentless** training paid off in the end.

# develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) develop a strategy, (2) develop a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

### industrial

adj. of or relating to or resulting from industry synonym: manufacturing, mechanical

(1) beginning of the **industrial** revolution, (2) **industrial** alcohol

**Industrial** design has become more focused on human nature aspect than ever before.

# aquaculture

 n. the cultivation of aquatic organisms such as fish, seaweed, and shellfish for human consumption, as well as for environmental conservation and research purposes

synonym: fish farming, mariculture, hydroponics

(1) **aquaculture** industry, (2) sustainable **aquaculture** Fish farming is a form of **aquaculture** that has recently gained popularity.

# malignant

adj. having an evil or harmful nature or effect; cancerous, tending to invade or spread rapidly

# threat

dam

# pristine

adj. new and completely free from dirt or contamination synonym: chaste, pure, immaculate

#### conflict

 a strong disagreement, argument, or a violent clash between two opposing groups or individuals

synonym: clash, discord, competition

He and I often had **conflicts**, not only in personality but also in ideology.

# vibration

- n. a continuous quick and slight shaking movement synonym: oscillation, fluctuation, reverberation

# economy

n. the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

### latitude

#### cone

 a geometric shape that tapers to a point at one end and has a circular base at the other end (1) traffic **cone**, (2) ice cream **cone**

# progression

 the act or process of changing to the next stage or phase or moving forward

synonym: advancement, development, evolution

(1) **progression** of civilization, (2) **progression** of disease The company has made great strides in its **progression** toward sustainability.

#### evolution

- n. a gradual process of transformation of living thingssynonym: elaboration, expansion, transition
- (1) human **evolution**, (2) **evolution** theory They study the **evolution** of the universe.

#### worldview

 a particular philosophy or cognitive orientation of life or conception of the world

synonym: perspective, position, viewpoint

# consequence

 the outcome of a particular action or event, especially relative to an individual

synonym: result, impact, outcome

#### welfare

 the general health, happiness, and prosperous of a person or group

synonym: well-being, benefit, health

(1) child welfare, (2) a welfare state

#### climate

 the weather in a particular location averaged over some long period

*synonym*: atmosphere, weather, environment

(1) a cold **climate**, (2) effects of **climate** change **Climate** and weather have an impact on every part of our lifestyles.

# wildlife

- animals, birds, insects, etc. that grow independently of people and live in natural conditions
- (1) **wildlife** sanctuary, (2) bird and other **wildlife**The conservation area has an abundance of **wildlife**.

#### resistance

n. the act of defending oneself from an aggressor or refusing to accept something

synonym: opposition, antagonism, defiance

(1) **resistance** movement, (2) **resistance** to insulin The bill to increase the consumption tax had passed despite much **resistance** from the public.

trend

 a general direction in which something is changing or developing

# nation

a large organized community of people living in a n. particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) **nation-state**, (2) a seafaring **nation** The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

# acquire

to buy or obtain something such as an asset, object, knowledge, etc., for oneself

synonym: attain, earn, catch

(1) **acquire** knowledge, (2) **acquire** a new company Children **acquire** language at a fantastic rate.

# disbeliever

a person who does not believe in something, such as a n. religion or idea

*synonym*: non-believer, skeptic, doubter

(1) persuade a disbeliever, (2) stubborn disbeliever Despite the evidence, she remained a disbeliever in the theory of evolution.

# biology

- the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things
- (1) evolutionary **biology**, (2) cell and molecular **biology** In junior high school, we had to dissect a frog in **biology** class.

#### heal

- to make a wound or injury to become well again synonym: recover, bring around, mend
- (1) **heal** a broken bone, (2) **heal** the hurt mind It will take time for her mental scars to heal.

#### rewild

v. to restore an area of land to its natural state, especially by reintroducing locally extinct species

synonym: restore, return, rehabilitate

(1) rewild land, (2) rewild an area

The government is considering a plan to **rewild** certain areas by reintroducing native species and removing non-native ones.

# eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

synonym: finally, someday, ultimately

acre

- a unit of land area in the US Customary System and the British Imperial System, equal to 4,840 square yards (= 4,047 square meters)

#### assemble

- v. to collect in one place as a single group synonym: gather, congregate, collect
- (1) **assemble** your colleagues, (2) **assemble** a jigsaw puzzle

The president began to assemble an army.

# privately

adv. in a private manner; not publicly; secretlysynonym: secretly, in confidence, behind closed doors

(1) a **privately-owned** railway, (2) import things **privately** The couple **privately** exchanged their vows before the ceremony began.

#### infrastructure

 the basic systems, services, or features that are necessary for an organization or country, such as transport and power supplies

synonym: foundation, framework

(1) IT infrastructure, (2) infrastructure cost

Aging societies tend to require huge costs for **infrastructure** maintenance.

trail

 a path or track roughly through a countryside, mountain, or forest area, often made or used for a particular purpose; (verb) to lag or linger behind

synonym: footpath, track, course

(1) a warm trail, (2) follow the trail

The storm left a **trail** of destruction behind it.

donate

 to give money, food, clothes, etc. to help a person or organization

synonym: bestow, contribute, grant

(1) **donate** to charity, (2) **donate** blood to the Red Cross Our company **donates** to the school endowment fund every year.

capitalism

 an economic system based on the private ownership of the means of production and their operation for profit

synonym: commercialism

(1) advance **capitalism**, (2) under the umbrella of **capitalism** 

**Capitalism** also guarantees intellectual property rights and thus promotes innovation.

deploy

v. to move troops or weapons into a position or military action; to bring into something in an effective way

synonym: set up, expand, launch

(1) **deploy** troops for battle, (2) **deploy** safety measures This country **deployed** its weapons in the east region.

wealth

*n.* a large amount of money, property, or other things that someone or an organization owns

synonym: affluence, assets, fortunate

(1) majority of his wealth, (2) material wealth

The **wealth** inequality was unavoidable.

#### devour

v. to eat or consume something eagerly or ravenously; or to destroy something rapidly

synonym: consume, swallow, destroy

(1) devour a meal, (2) devour my way

She **devoured** the mystery novel in one sitting.

# philanthropy

the practice of voluntarily helping the poor, especially by giving money

synonym: altruism, benevolence, generosity

(1) **philanthropy** organization, (2) private **philanthropy** Tech billionaires often spend the majority of their time on **philanthropy**.

# tremendous

adj. very great in degree or extent or amount or impact; extremely good

synonym: enormous, giant, immense

(1) **tremendous** amount, (2) **tremendous** popularity We had a **tremendous** time yesterday.

# suspicion

the act of doubting something, especially something wrong

synonym: doubt, misgiving, skepticism

(1) **suspicion** of fraud, (2) cast **suspicion**

# quarter

- n. one of four equal parts; a fourth part or portionsynonym: fourth, one-fourth

  percentage points higher than in the previous.

# downright

adj. (especially of something bad) complete and absolute;utter; (adverb) completely and absolutely

*synonym*: absolute, utter, complete

(1) **downright** nonsense, (2) **downright** impossible It was a **downright** lie that he would attend the event.

# hostility

n. aggressive or unfriendly feelings or behaviorsynonym: antagonism, antipathy, estrangement

(1) an act of hostility, (2) bitter hostilityHer unconcealed hostility made us unpleasant.

# largely

adv. virtually entirely; to a large degreesynonym: mainly, chiefly, broadly

(1) **largely** accepted, (2) **largely** mitigate the issue Nevada is **largely** a desert state.

# permanent

adj. lasting for a long time without essential changesynonym: lasting, ceaseless, endless

(1) literature of **permanent** value, (2) **permanent** life insurance

She is searching for a **permanent** residence.

# temperate

adj. mild or moderate in temperature or climate; exhibiting self-restraint, particularly about the consumption of food, drink, or other indulgences; showing moderation or restraint in behavior or attitude

synonym: moderate, mild, genial

(1) **temperate** grassland, (2) **temperate** behavior The **temperate** climate of the region made it an ideal vacation spot.

# grassland

 a large area of land covered mainly by grass, with few or no trees, and typically used for grazing livestock

synonym: meadow, plain, savanna

(1) endangered **grassland**, (2) vast **grassland**Meadows and pastures are examples of smaller-scale **grasslands** in many parts of the world.

#### freshwater

- adj. living in, found in, or connecting with water that does not contain salt

#### wetland

# adjoining

adj. next to or in contact with something else; sharing a common border or boundary

# territory

- n. an area under the control of a ruler or state synonym: domain, region, realm

# kayak

n. a small, narrow boat traditionally used by the Inuit people for hunting and fishing, which has a covered deck and is propelled using a double-bladed paddle

synonym: canoe, skiff, paddle boat

#### accident

an unfortunate event, especially one causing damage or injury

synonym: calamity, casualty, chance

#### lean

adj. having a noticeably small amount of body fat; (verb) to bend or move from a straight to a sloping posture

**Lean** operational improvements often lead to better environmental performance.

# accelerate

v. to make something faster or earlier; to cause to develop or progress more quickly

synonym: speed up, quicken, rev

# marine

adj. relating to the sea and the creatures and plants that live there

synonym: sea-dwelling, maritime, aquatic

(1) marine insurance, (2) variety of marine life

Seals and whales are **marine** animals beloved by the people.

# roughly

adv. approximately but not precisely; with a violent manner synonym: approximately, more or less, around

(1) roughly explain my idea, (2) roughly speaking

#### commerce

n. the activity of buying and selling things, especially on a large scale

synonym: trade, transaction, dealings
