### helpless

adj. unable to take care of oneself or to do things without help

### corruption

 dishonest, harmful, or illegal behavior, especially of people in positions of power

synonym: depravity, bribery, degeneration

(1) **corruption** accusation, (2) federal **corruption** charges Rampant **corruption** led to a loss of trust in the government.

the act of taking anything from someone or somewhere

unlawfully; stealing

*synonym*: stealing, heist, robbery

(1) victim of identity **theft**, (2) **theft** of designs Poverty is not a reproach; however, **theft** is.

#### corrosive

theft

 adj. having the ability to corrode or erode a material or substance; causing damage or deterioration over time; harmful or destructive

synonym: destructive, erosive, caustic

(1) **corrosive** substance, (2) **corrosive** effect The **corrosive** acid ate away at the metal pipes.

### criminal

n. a person who has committed a crime synonym: offender, lawbreaker, delinquent

(1) wanted **criminal**, (2) **criminal** investigation The police are searching for the **criminal** who stole the jewels.

#### toxic

adj. of or relating to or caused by a poison; poisonous synonym: poisonous, harmful, contaminated

### predatory

adj. living by eating other animals, especially by catching prey that is still alive

#### hometown

### paradox

 a statement, situation, or person that has two opposite facts or features and therefore seems impossible, is difficult to understand, or is strange;

synonym: incongruity, dichotomy, contradiction

#### oasis

- a fertile land in a desert or semi-desert environment where there is water and therefore plants and trees and sometimes a village or town
- (1) tropical **oasis**, (2) **oasis** farming

  The **oasis** supplied water for early farms until the modern age.

#### expansive

adj. large or wide in extent or scope; friendly and open and willing to talk

*synonym*: large, extensive, vast

envy

v. to experience a feeling of jealousy or resentment towards someone because of their possessions,

#### construct

### government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

#### divide

- v. to separate or cause to separate into parts or groups synonym: separate, disconnect, split
- (1) **divide** the cake into two pieces, (2) **divide** money equally

#### parcel

 something wrapped in paper so that it can be carried or sent by post

synonym: box, packet, container

a parcel of lies,
 parcel of land
 runs a parcel delivery company.

#### crony

 a close friend or companion; a longtime associate who is often involved in one's questionable or shady dealings or activities

synonym: buddy, pal, friend

(1) a **crony** of the governor, (2) business **crony** 

The politician's close **crony** was given a high-ranking job in the administration.

belt

 to sing loudly and forcefully; to hit someone or something hard; (noun) a strip of leather or other material worn to tie or buckle something around the body

synonym: sing, hit hard, (noun) strap

The band was **belting** out old songs in response to audience requests.

#### movement

 a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

synonym: motion, progression, action

### immediately

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

hire

to give somebody a job

synonym: employ, engage, lease

(1) hire a guide, (2) hire a car by the hour

We should always be prepared to hire talented recruits.

### goon

 a person who is hired or employed to engage in acts of violence or intimidation on behalf of someone else, often for criminal or illicit purposes

synonym: thug, henchman, enforcer

The **goon** squad was hired to intimidate the protesters and disperse the crowd.

#### fortunate

adj. having good luck or lucky

synonym: fortuitous, lucky, blessed

### uprising

 a public rebellion, especially against an established government or authority

*synonym*: revolt, rebellion, insurgency

### clergy

 the official leaders of the religious activities, especially of the Christian Church

*synonym*: priesthood, church, ministry

### politician

 a person who is a member of a government or law-making organization, especially as an elected member of parliament, etc.

### greedy

adj. having or showing an intense or insatiable desire for wealth, status, power, or food

synonym: avaricious, covetous, grasping

#### intense

adj. (especially of a feeling) very strong; extremely sharp or severe

*synonym*: extreme, fierce, harsh

international criticism.

#### subdue

v. to conquer; to bring under control

*synonym*: conquer, overpower, vanquish

(1) **subdue** a confusion, (2) **subdue** his anger

The police used tear gas to **subdue** the violent crowd.

wit

 the ability to say or write things or ideas in a clever and humorous way

synonym: humor, comedy, funniness

(1) the wit of man, (2) full of wit

He has the wit to keep talking about this topic.

### advocacy

 the act of supporting or promoting a particular cause or point of view, often through public campaigning or lobbying

synonym: support, promotion, defense

(1) **advocacy** group, (2) consumer **advocacy** group The group engages in **advocacy** through lobbying and campaigning for policy changes.

### expansion

 the process of becoming larger or more extensive, or the result of this process

synonym: growth, enlargement, development

(1) industrial **expansion**, (2) **expansion** project

The company is undergoing an **expansion**, opening new locations in several states.

#### consensus

 general agreement or accord in the judgment or opinion reached by a group as a whole *synonym*: agreement, accord, harmony

(1) a public **consensus**, (2) **consensus** among scientists The two parties have reached a **consensus**.

#### environment

n. the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

(1) **environment** affairs, (2) chaotic **environment**Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's **environment**.

### democracy

n. a form of government in which the people have the authority to deliberate and decide legislation, or to choose governing officials to do so

*synonym*: self-government, republic, commonwealth

#### inextricable

*adj.* unable to be separated or escaped from *synonym*: inescapable, inseparable, entangled

#### isolate

v. to physically or socially separate someone or something from other people or things

#### manifest

v. to show something such as feeling, attitude, quality, etc. clearly through signs or actions

synonym: exhibit, make plain, demonstrate

manifest as the word, (2) manifest displeasure
 The Prime Minister manifested his regret for his neighbors

#### servant

 a person who performs duties for others, especially a person employed in a house on domestic duties or as a personal attendant

synonym: attendant, helper, assistant

(1) servant of God, (2) fellow servant

The faithful **servant** had been working for the family for many years and was well-trusted.

#### loot

 steal goods from a place or person, typically during a war or riot; (noun) steal goods from a place or person, typically using force, especially in times of war or civil disorder

synonym: plunder, pillage, rob

(1) loot the ship, (2) war loot

The bandits **looted** the small town, leaving it in ruins.

#### coffer

n. a strongbox or chest used for storing valuable objects or money; a fund or treasury, especially one used to hold or manage money, assets, or resources; a recessed panel used to decorate ceilings or other architectural features

*synonym*: treasury, strongbox, safe

(1) coffer lid, (2) bank coffer

The government is trying to replenish the **coffer** by increasing taxes.

#### expense

the money, time, or effort incurred or required for something

synonym: cost, expenditure, outlay

### economy

n. the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

synonym: finance, trade, business

The **economy** of the country is struggling due to the recent political instability.

#### vital

adj. necessary for the success or continued existence of something

synonym: critical, crucial, invigorating

(1) play a **vital** role, (2) **vital** for a healthy society Perseverance and optimism are **vital** to success.

#### render

v. to bring someone or something into a particular state; to provide something such as service, help, etc.

synonym: deliver, give, provide

(1) **render** an assessment, (2) **render** the contract void The jury must **render** a decision on this complex case.

### worthless

adj. having no value or usefulness; not worth consideringsynonym: valueless, useless, pointless

(1) worthless stock, (2) worthless coin

The product was found to be **worthless** as it failed to meet the customer's expectations.

gang

a group of people who organize and engage in criminal activity

synonym: crew, posse, group

(1) a motorcycle gang, (2) gang member

The street **gang** was known for its violent behavior.

brutal

adj. harsh or cruel

synonym: harsh, cruel, barbarous

(1) brutal bully, (2) brutal honesty

The **brutal** attack left the victim with serious injuries.

communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals; for common use

synonym: collaborative, combined, collective

(1) **communal** swimming pool, (2) **communal** combination of funds

**Communal** elections were held in several European countries.

fee

- n. a sum of money charged for a particular service
- synonym: charge, cost, expense
- (1) fee calculation, (2) service fee

The lawyer's **fee** for the case was \$10,000.

rap

 a type of music characterized by a strong, repetitive beat and lyrics that often focus on social and political issues; a reproach for some lapse or misdeed

synonym: hip-hop, emceeing, MCing

(1) rap music, (2) get a rap

The new **rap** album is getting a lot of attention.

perpetrator

a person who carries out a harmful or illegal act,
 particularly one that involves violence or deception

synonym: culprit, wrongdoer, offender

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(1) perpetrator identity, (2) culprit perpetrator

The police have not yet caught the **perpetrator** of the crime.

#### bribe

v. to try to make someone do something to gain one's favors or influence by giving a gift of money or other inducements

synonym: graft, corrupt

(1) bribe a politician, (2) bribe him with food

He tries to **bribe** the ship's captain to export illegal products.

jail

 a facility where criminals are kept to be punished for their crimes; a prison

*synonym*: prison, slammer, penitentiary

(1) county jail, (2) be in jail

The police escorted the prisoner to the jail.

### sanitary

adj. clean and hygienic; of or relating to the promotion of health through cleanliness

synonym: hygienic, clean, germ-free

(1) due to **sanitary** reasons, (2) adopt **sanitary** measures The public restrooms were equipped with automatic flushers and hand sanitizer to maintain high **sanitary** conditions.

rank

 a position in a hierarchy of status or authority; (verb) to take or have a position relative to others

*synonym*: position, status, standing

(1) rank amateur, (2) high rank

He was promoted to the **rank** of captain in the military.

### corruptible

adj. capable of being made to do something dishonest or immoral

*synonym*: bribable, dishonest, venal

(1) **corruptible** officials, (2) **corruptible** judges

Bureaucracies are more **corruptible** than other systems or organizations.

#### frustrate

to hinder or prevent efforts, plans, or desires from doing, succeeding, or being fulfilled; to make someone feel upset or annoyed because they are unable to change or achieve something

synonym: hinder, thwart, dishearten

(1) **frustrate** the advancement, (2) **frustrate** other team members

The coach explained a strategy to **frustrate** the opponent's schemes to the players.

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) nation-state, (2) a seafaring nation

The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

### unacceptably

*adv.* in a way that is not acceptable or satisfactory *synonym*: improperly, unsatisfactorily, inadequately

(1) **unacceptably** high prices, (2) **unacceptably** poor The restaurant's service was **unacceptably** slow.

### ignore

- v. to intentionally not listen or pay attention to synonym: neglect, disregard, shun
- (1) **ignore** her advice, (2) **ignore** a ban Since independence, the area has been completely **ignored**.

#### interfere

v. to get involved in and prevent a process or activity from continuing

*synonym*: interpose, interrupt, hamper

(1) **interfere** in another country's affairs, (2) **interfere** with DNA synthesis

Your talking **interferes** with my work.

### absolutely

adv. without restriction or limitation; completely or utterly synonym: completely, utterly, definitely

(1) **absolutely** against, (2) **absolutely** obsessed with the girl

I am **absolutely** opposed to his idea because of morality.

#### strategy

 a detailed plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall goal.

synonym: approach, procedure, scenario

(1) military **strategy**, (2) develop a **strategy** 

Our plan includes a comprehensive marketing **strategy**.

#### vice

wrongdoing or wicked behavior; (in the form of vice versa) with the order reversed; (as a prefix) someone with a job immediately below a particular person

synonym: corruption, depravity, evil

virtue and vice,
 vice-chair of the committee
 Cats hate dogs and vice versa.

### complain

v. to say dissatisfaction or annoyance about something or somebody

synonym: gripe, claim, denounce

(1) **complain** about a job, (2) call and **complain** frequently Our users are often **complaining** about the slow application.

#### decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options
   synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

#### foster

 to promoto growth; to take care of another person's child, usually for a limited time, without becoming their legal parents

synonym: nurture, nourish, cultivate

(1) **foster** a better relationship, (2) **foster** two kids The pastor contributed to **fostering** the sense of a community embracing all classes.

#### promote

 to encourage or persuade people to like, buy, use, do, or support something; to raise someone to a higher position or rank synonym: boost, raise, advertise

(1) **promote** a better relationship, (2) **promote** bad behavior The government should do more to **promote** sustainable agribusiness.

#### individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self
- (1) a private **individual**, (2) **individual** freedom
  As an **individual**, he had the right to make his own decisions and live his life as he saw fit.

### progression

 the act or process of changing to the next stage or phase or moving forward

synonym: advancement, development, evolution

- (1) **progression** of civilization, (2) **progression** of disease The company has made great strides in its **progression** toward sustainability.
- v. to remove or pull out by the roots, especially a plant or tree; to displace or remove someone or something from a particular place or position

synonym: remove, eradicate

(1) uproot the tree, (2) uproot tradition

We decided to **uproot** our lives and move to a new city.

#### intervene

uproot

v. to intentionally get involved in a situation to improve it or prevent it from getting worse

synonym: interfere, mediate, intercede

(1) **intervene** in a dispute, (2) **intervene** between quarreling parties

Following international law, our country does not **intervene** in the internal affairs of our neighbors.

### conflicting

adj. incompatible or inconsistent with something else; in disagreement

*synonym*: incompatible, inconsistent, contradictory

(1) a lot of **conflicting** information, (2) make **conflicting** allegations

The witness's testimony was **conflicting** with the evidence found at the scene.

#### addition

 the act or process of adding something to something else; the process of adding numbers

synonym: accumulation, expansion, addendum

(1) chemical **addition**, (2) **addition** of vectors

In **addition**, private corporations provide healthcare services.

### legitimate

adj. accordant with or allowed by law; lawful synonym: lawful, honest, fair

(1) a **legitimate** child, (2) **legitimate** question

Public political demonstrations are considered **legitimate** rights for citizens.

#### retribution

 punishment inflicted on someone as vengeance for a wrong or criminal act; just dessert or compensation for wrongdoing

synonym: punishment, revenge, recompense

(1) divine **retribution**, (2) seek **retribution** 

He faced **retribution** for his crimes and was sentenced to many years.

### concept

- n. an idea or principle associated with something abstractsynonym: idea, notion, vision
- (1) learn new concepts, (2) concept car

One such rapidly growing **concept** is quantum cryptography.

### profoundly

adv. to a great or complete degree; deeply synonym: deeply, greatly, completely

(1) profoundly insightful, (2) sleep profoundly

The novel affected her **profoundly**, causing her to question her beliefs and values.

### shifting

adj. constantly changing or moving synonym: unfirm, shifty, fluctuating

(1) **shifting** balance, (2) continuously **shifting** landscape Trends in the fashion industry are so **shifting** that it is challenging to keep up with them.

### patience

n. the ability to remain calm and composed in the face of adversity, delay, or frustration; the capacity to tolerate or endure difficult or unpleasant situations without becoming upset or angry

synonym: forbearance, endurance, tolerance

(1) test my patience, (2) show patience

Healing a broken heart requires **patience**, as it takes time to heal.

### persistent

 adj. continuing firmly or obstinately in the course of action despite difficulty or opposition; lasting or enduring without fading or being lost over time

synonym: tenacious, steadfast, unrelenting

(1) persistent cough, (2) persistent data

Despite the setbacks, he remained **persistent** in his pursuit of his dreams.

#### commitment

 a promise or firm decision to do something or to behave in a certain way

synonym: burden, obligation, promise

(1) a **commitment** to an alliance, (2) meet his **commitments** 

His business **commitments** took him to the United States.

#### shift

- n. a slight transition in position, direction, or trendsynonym: transition, change, modification
- (1) Doppler **shift**, (2) major paradigm **shift** Could you help me **shift** some furniture?

### inspire

 to make somebody fill with the desire, confidence, or enthusiasm, especially to do something creative synonym: boost, encourage, enlighten

(1) **inspire** a feeling of curiosity, (2) **inspire** him to write a novel

The unique style of this martial arts **inspired** many action film producers.

### integrity

 the quality of being honest and having strong moral principles; the state of being whole and undivided

*synonym*: honesty, honor, morality

(1) a person of **integrity**, (2) **integrity** of data The company's reputation for honesty and **integrity** is highly valued among its customers.

### employ

v. to give somebody a job and pay them for it; to make use of

synonym: hire, engage, use

(1) **employ** job seekers, (2) **employ** a new method When making arrests, police officers frequently **employ** excessive force.

gloss

n. a smooth and shiny surface on a material, often achieved through the application of a coating or finish; a brief or superficial explanation or description, often used to make something seem better or more attractive than it actually is; (verb) to make something appear better or more positive than it really is, often by using vague or misleading language

synonym: shine, gleam, luster

(1) **gloss** over my mistake, (2) **gloss** of politeness The shiny **gloss** on the new car made it look even more impressive.

#### dilemma

 a situation in which a difficult choice has to be made between two or more options, especially that are equally unfavorable ones

synonym: difficulty, plight, predicament

(1) chicken-and-egg dilemma, (2) be in a dilemma

The choice between bureaucracy and adhocracy represents a common **dilemma**.

#### explicit

adj. stated clearly and in detail, leaving no room for confusion or doubt

synonym: clear, unambiguous, unequivocal

(1) explicit content, (2) explicit instructions

The movie had an **explicit** sex scene that some viewers might find offensive.

#### obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understand synonym: apparent, conspicuous, evident

(1) **obvious** reasons, (2) his conclusion was **obvious** There are **obvious** differences between the two wine-producing regions.

#### exhibit

 to show something in public for people to enjoy or to provide them with information

synonym: display, expose, show

(1) **exhibit** a bad attitude, (2) **exhibit** a great talent Other technology industries **exhibit** similarly explosive growth.

#### mindset

 the established set of attitudes or fixed ideas held by someone

synonym: attitude, ethos, mentality

(1) flexible **mindset**, (2) the **mindset** in an education system

Countries whose goal is economic development often focus on fostering an entrepreneurial **mindset** in each individual.

#### confident

adj. feeling sure about your abilities or qualities or having trust in people, plans, or the future

synonym: certain, sure, convinced

(1) feel confident,(2) a confident remarkI'm not confident in our victory.

### opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

*synonym*: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

#### suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

(1) suffer a setback, (2) suffer bad grades

The older man **suffers** from arthritis and finds it difficult to move around.

#### climate

n. the weather in a particular location averaged over some long period

synonym: atmosphere, weather, environment

(1) a cold **climate**, (2) effects of **climate** change **Climate** and weather have an impact on every part of our lifestyles.

#### ecosystem

- n. all the plants and living creatures in an area and the way they affect each other and the environment
- (1) marine **ecosystem**, (2) change the **ecosystem**Human conservation efforts often fail unexpectedly because they disturb the balance of the **ecosystem**.

### collapse

v. to fall down or give way suddenly, often after breaking apart

synonym: tumble, spill, bankruptcy

### biodiversity

- the number and variety of plants and animals that exist in a particular area or the world and make a balanced environment

#### analyze

v. to think about in-depth and evaluate to discover essential features or meaning

synonym: explore, examine, investigate

#### conserve

v. to protect something, especially the natural environment or culture, from change, damage, or destruction

synonym: preserve, save, maintain
