### paleontology

trail

a path or track roughly through a countryside, mountain, or forest area, often made or used for a particular purpose; (verb) to lag or linger behind

synonym: footpath, track, course

clue

 an object, a piece of evidence, or some information that helps someone to find the answer to a problem, question, or mystery

synonym: hint, indication, inkling

dinosaur

 a large extinct reptile, often with an armored back, long neck, tail, and bony plates on the skin synonym: reptile, beast, monster

The discovery of a new **dinosaur** species made headlines in the scientific community.

extinct

adj. no longer in existence

synonym: dead, obsolete, abolished

- (1) **extinct** by human activity, (2) long- **extinct** volcano Many species have become extinct due to habitat destruction and other human activities.
- the top or extreme point of something slender or n. tapering, usually a mountain or hill; a piece of advice about something practical; a small amount of money given for services

synonym: edge, advice, gratuity

- (1) the **tip** of a paintbrush, (2) give the waiter a **tip**. I will introduce some **tips** on learning English in this class.
- any preserved remains, impression, or trace of any once-living thing that has become hard and turned into rock

synonym: relic, remnant, antediluvian

### footprint

- a mark of a foot, shoe, or animal's foot left on a surface *synonym*: footmark, imprint, impression

- to find or discover someone or something that was lost synonym: seek, follow, depict

### journal

a newspaper or magazine specialized in a specific topic or profession

synonym: periodical, diary, bulletin

(1) scientific journal, (2) journal articles

The physician is reading the **journals** related to medicine

### reject

v. to refuse to accept, consider, or use something or someone

synonym: decline, turn down, repudiate

(1) **reject** the proposal, (2) **reject** all imperfect merchandise The company **rejected** the job candidate's application due to a lack of experience.

#### skeleton

 the structure of bones in a human or animal body, or a framework of bones or other material that supports a plant

synonym: bones, frame, structure

(1) the steel **skeleton** of a building, (2) **skeleton** hand Scientists studied the ancient **skeleton** to learn more about the creature's anatomy.

#### detective

 a person whose job it is to find out information about crimes and find out who did them

synonym: gumshoe, investigator, hawkshaw

(1) **detective** work, (2) **detective** movie The **detective** diligently pursued his cases.

#### ultimate

adj. furthest or highest in degree or order synonym: highest, maximum, foremost

(1) the ultimate goal in life, (2) the ultimate luxury

Management must take **ultimate** responsibility for the accident.

#### branch

 a division of a tree or woody shrub that grows out from the trunk or a main stem; a division of some larger or more complex organization

synonym: limb, twig, bough

(1) branch office, (2) a branch pipe

The **branch** of the tree had fallen and blocked the road.

### neglect

v. to not give enough care or attention to something; to leave something undone

synonym: delinquency, carelessness, decay

neglect to call, (2) neglect ethical issues
 He neglected his health to make the project a success.

### footstep

 a step, or the sound generated by a person walking when their foot hits the ground

synonym: footfall, step

(1) **footsteps** in the corridor, (2) approaching **footsteps** The sound of oncoming **footsteps** grew louder, closer.

### importance

- n. the quality of being important and worthy of notesynonym: significance, primacy, matter
- (1) a man of **importance**, (2) high **importance** I stopped by the branch though I have no business of **importance**.

#### reconstruct

v. to build or form something again that has been damaged or destroyed

synonym: rebuild, revamp, reorganize

(1) **reconstruct** an image, (2) **reconstruct** the original text They've decided to **reconstruct** a ruined castle.

### hop

v. to jump lightly and quickly on one foot or both feet; to move rapidly from one place to another; to travel using an aircraft, bus, etc.

synonym: jump, bounce, skip

(1) **hop** on one foot, (2) **hop** from one place to another The rabbit **hopped** over the fence.

skip

v. to move along lightly and quickly, making a step from one foot to the other with a hop or bounce; to intentionally fail to do something which would normally do

*synonym*: bounce, spring, neglect

(1) **skip** across the country, (2) **skip** breakfast We **skipped** the topic because it was too complicated.

burrow

- v. to excavate a hole or make a tunnel in the ground by digging, typically for use as a dwelling of an animal synonym: tunnel, dig, excavate
- (1) **burrow** through the forest, (2) **burrow** into a mystery You can't **burrow** through solid metal.

excavate

- v. to dig or remove earth, rocks, or other materials from the ground or a site, often to uncover or discover something synonym: dig, unearth, extract
- (1) **excavate** a deep hole, (2) **excavate** soil

  The archaeologists **excavated** the ruins of an ancient city buried under the desert sands.

nest

 a structure in which animals lay their eggs or give birth to their young

*synonym*: roost, perch, burrow

(1) bird's **nest**, (2) a **nest** of thieves

The female birds build a **nest** and lay their eggs in May.

juvenile

adj. relating to or characteristic of youth or young people; immature

*synonym*: youthful, boyish, childlike

(1) exhibit **juvenile** behavior, (2) **juvenile** justice

The detective suspected that the vandalism was the work of **juvenile** delinquents.

### moving

adj. causing strong emotions or feelings, especially sadness or sympathy

synonym: emotional, poignant, touching

brought tears to the audience's eyes.

### sprint

bolt

v. to run at full speed over a short distance or period of time

synonym: dash, bolt, race

- (1) **sprint** for a bus, (2) **sprint** towards the finish line Top athletes can **sprint** 100 meters in less than 10 seconds.
- a metal bar that slides across to lock a door or window closed; a discharge of lightning accompanied by thunder; (verb) to move or jump suddenly

The lightning **bolt** twigged in several directions.

### limp

- adj. having no strength or energy; walking with difficulty because of pain, injury, or disability in one's leg or foot synonym: unsteady, weak, faltering

injury

 harm done to a person's or an animal's body caused by an accident or an attack

synonym: wound, damage, hurt

My accidental **injury** got better right away.

### pivotal

 adj. relating to or acting as a pivot or central point; crucial or essential to the success or outcome of something

synonym: crucial, essential, important

(1) pivotal moment, (2) pivotal role

#### Renaissance

*n.* a new growth in activity or enthusiasm in anything, particularly art, literature, or music

synonym: rebirth, golden age

### sophisticated

adj. having a great deal of worldly experience and knowledge of people's behavior, culture, and fashionsynonym: refined, cultured, worldly

#### makeover

 the process or act of a complete transformation, especially relevant to the appearance of someone or something

### regard

v. to think about or consider somebody or something in a specified way

synonym: consider, see, reckon

#### defunct

adj. no longer existing, operational, or functioning; extinct or dead; obsolete or out of use

synonym: inactive, non-functioning, extinct

#### transform

v. to change in outward structure or looks;

synonym: alter, convert, change

### dynamic

adj. having a lot of energy, ideas, and enthusiasm, and a strong personality; of or relating to dynamics (= the branch of physics and engineering concerned with the forces that cause motions of bodies)

synonym: energetic, active, vital

(1) a **dynamic** market, (2) **dynamic** person The sprinter has a **dynamic** way of running.

#### athlete

 a person who competes in one or more sports that involve physical strength, speed, or endurance

synonym: player, contestant, jock

(1) become a professional **athlete**, (2) high school **athletes** His dream is to become an Olympic **athlete**.

### intelligent

adj. having the capacity for thought and reason, especially to a high degree

synonym: brilliant, clever, competent

(1) an **intelligent** person, (2) **intelligent** assisting system **Intelligent** robots that can cooperate with humans have limited motor output for safety.

#### locate

v. to specify or determine the exact position of someone or something

synonym: discover, find, place

(1) locate a missing pet, (2) locate a tumor

The robot can accurately **locate** construction material.

#### shore

n. the land along the edge of a sea, lake, broad river, or other large body of water; (verb) to support by placing against something solid or rigid

synonym: coast, seaside, beach

(1) a sandy **shore**, (2) **shore** up demand The waves are beating against the **shore**.

### rocky

adj. full of or abounding in rocks; of, relating to, or made of rock

synonym: stony, boulder-strewn, rough

(1) rocky terrain, (2) rocky relationship

The **rocky** road made it difficult to drive on.

### represent

 $\nu$ . to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

synonym: depict, express, describe

(1) **represent** by a diagram, (2) the characters that **represent** numbers

We elected him to **represent** us at the international conference.

### landscape

an expanse of scenery that can be seen in a single view;
 a large area of land, especially in the country and relating to its appearance

synonym: geography, terrain, topography

a peaceful landscape,
 landscape painting
 Recent electoral shocks have shaken the political landscape in Europe.

### theropod

 a type of carnivorous dinosaur that existed during the Mesozoic Era and is characterized by having three-toed limbs, a stiff tail, and sharp teeth, such as the Tyrannosaurus and Velociraptor

synonym: dinosaur, predator, carnivore

(1) theropod fossils, (2) theropod teeth

The **theropod** dinosaur was one of the fiercest predators of the prehistoric era.

### parallel

 adj. being everywhere equidistant and not intersecting; of or relating to the simultaneous performance of multiple operations synonym: aligned, side-by-side, similar

(1) a **parallel** case, (2) **parallel** processing He walked a road **parallel** to the railroad.

### trackway

- n. a pathway or trail made by the footprints or tracks of animals, typically found in mud, sand, or snowsynonym: trail, path, route
- (1) dinosaur **trackway**, (2) animal **trackway**The ancient **trackway** provided evidence of prehistoric animal migration patterns.

#### subadult

adj. referring to an animal or person that is not fully mature or developed but has not yet reached adulthood, typically used to describe a stage of development between juvenile and adult

synonym: adolescent, juvenile, immature

(1) **subadult** male, (2) **subadult** behavior

The **subadult** elephant was still too young to mate and reproduce.

#### indistinct

adj. not clear or easily seen, heard, or understood synonym: faint, blurred, hazy

(1) **indistinct** memory, (2) **indistinct** pronunciation

The **indistinct** shape in the fog made it difficult to determine what it was.

#### modern

*adj.* of or belonging to the present time or recent times *synonym*: contemporary, stylish, current

(1) **modern** poetry, (2) pre- **modern** agricultural society Their headquarters are in a **modern** skyscraper.

### sandpiper

- a small to medium-sized wading bird commonly found near water, characterized by its long beak and slender body
- sandpiper habitat, (2) migrating sandpiper
   The ecology class studied the sandpiper's behavior as part

of their animal adaptation to environments coursework.

### giant

adj. enormous; much bigger or more important than similar items usually are

synonym: big, gigantic, huge

(1) giant trees, (2) giant tech company

The **giant** jets gradually dominate the world's airlines.

#### diameter

- n. the length of a straight line passing through the center of a circle and connecting two points on the circumference synonym: diam, width
- (1) **diameter** of an oval, (2) a particle **diameter** Draw a circle five centimeters in **diameter**.

### weigh

v. to have a particular weight; to carefully evaluate things before making a conclusion

synonym: consider, cogitate, count

(1) **weigh** heavily on stock prices, (2) **weigh** a cargo The baby **weighs** 1 pound 3 oz.

### extraordinary

adj. exceptional, unexpected, very unusual; surpassing the ordinary or usual

synonym: exceptional, noteworthy, astonishing

(1) **extraordinary** ability, (2) **extraordinary** weather He narrated the **extraordinary** story of his adventure.

### biped

n. an animal with two feet

*synonym*: hominoid

(1) biped robot, (2) a featherless biped

**Biped** walking encouraged the further evolution of humankind.

#### crocodile

 a large, carnivorous reptile with powerful jaws and a long, scaly body; native to tropical regions and often found in rivers and freshwater habitats

synonym: alligator, gator, croc

(1) crocodile hide, (2) saltwater crocodile

The **crocodile** attack left the villagers in a state of shock and fear

#### carnivorous

adj. feeding on the flesh of other animalssynonym: meat-eating, predatory, flesh-eating

(1) **carnivorous** cell, (2) aquatic **carnivorous** mammal The **carnivorous** dinosaur preyed on other animals.

#### ferocious

adj. very fierce, savage, or cruelsynonym: savage, fierce, brutal

(1) ferocious beast, (2) ferocious predator

The lion's **ferocious** roar could be heard from miles away.

#### lizard

- a reptile that has a relatively long body, two pairs of legs, and a tapering tail
- (1) giant lizard, (2) lizard leather

The lizard's tail regenerates if severed.

#### heron

 a long-legged wading bird with a long, slender neck and bill, typically found near water and known for its ability to stand motionless for long periods while waiting to catch prey

synonym: egret, crane

(1) **heron** migration, (2) great blue **heron** 

I love watching the graceful movements of **herons** as they hunt for fish.

#### shoreline

- n. a line that separates land and sea
- (1) **shoreline** erosion, (2) coral-reef **shoreline**

Flooding occurs along the city's **shoreline** due to the storm surge.

#### stratum

 a layer or level of something, usually referring to a layer of rock or soil in the Earth's crust

synonym: layer, level, tier

(1) social stratum, (2) stratum corneum

The geologist identified a new **stratum** of rock through his research.

#### lapse

n. a temporary or brief failure in judgment, action, or behavior; a gradual or slow decline, often referring to a loss of performance, quality, or attention; a period of time that has passed; (verb) to fall or slip into a particular state, often one that is undesirable or unintended

synonym: break, failure, blunder

(1) **lapse** back into recession, (2) **lapse** in payment I missed the deadline due to a **lapse** in my memory.

frame

- n. a strong border or structure of the wood, metal, etc. that surrounds something such as a picture, door, or window
- synonym: body, skeleton, scaffolding
- (1) a picture **frame**, (2) the **frame** of the policy

  The detective looked for fingerprints on the window **frame**.

### documentary

 a film or a radio or television program that gives facts and information about a subject; of or derived from official documents

synonym: film, broadcast, doco

(1) a **documentary** film, (2) **documentary** proof He won an award for that short **documentary**.

lakeside

n. (also "lakeshore" or "lakefront") the edge or shore of a lake; an area adjacent to a lake

synonym: shoreline, lakeshore, waterfront

(1) lakeside view, (2) lakeside cabin

The **lakeside** resort was a perfect destination for a romantic getaway.

#### headland

 a narrow piece of land that projects out into a body of water, typically with steep cliffs on three sides

synonym: promontory, cape, point

(1) headland erosion, (2) rocky headland

The lighthouse on the **headland** provided safety for ships in the stormy sea.

### clipboard

 a flat, rigid board with a clip at the top used to hold papers, documents, or forms in place

synonym: notepad, writing board, memo pad

(1) **clipboard** with a pen, (2) write on a **clipboard**The nurse carried a **clipboard** with the patient's medical information.

tap

to hit someone or something quickly, gently, and often repeatedly; to use existing resources, such as energy, knowledge, etc.

synonym: knock, exploit, use

- (1) **tap** a new market, (2) **tap** keyboard with an index finger To expand the company, we must **tap** new human resources.
- v. to guess or calculate the cost, size, value, etc. of something

synonym: calculate, gauge, evaluate

(1) **estimate** a fair value, (2) **estimate** this chicken to weigh three pounds

We **estimated** the season's total trade deficit at \$50 billion.

degree

estimate

 a unit of measurement for angles, temperature, or level of proficiency or achievement; a rank or level of academic or professional attainment

synonym: level, qualification, diploma

bachelor's degree, (2) degree centigrade
 she received her degree in psychology from the university.

graduated

adj. having received a degree from a school, college, or university; marked with or divided into levels or degrees

*synonym*: completed, finished, earned

(1) **graduated** taxation, (2) **graduated** flask

She was a **graduated** student of a prestigious university.

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) nation-state, (2) a seafaring nation

The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

#### monument

 a statue, building, or other structure erected to commemorate a person or event

synonym: memorial, marker, statue

(1) humanity's **monument**, (2) **monument** honoring The stone **monument** was built to commemorate the war heroes.

#### arch

 a curved structure with two supports that holds the weight of something above it, such as a bridge or the upper part of a building

synonym: turn, bow, arc

(1) the **arch** of a person's foot, (2) an **arch-shaped** stone structure

The **arch** bears the weight of the overhead bridge.

#### stainless

 adj. resistant to staining or discoloration; not affected or damaged by contact with dirt, water, or other substances; clean and hygienic

synonym: unblemished, immaculate, spotless

(1) stainless hardware, (2) stainless sink

The kitchen appliances were all **stainless** steel, making the space modern and sleek.

#### steel

 a strong metal alloy made up of iron with typically a few tenths of a percent of carbon used for making things that need a strong structure

*synonym*: iron

(1) magnetic steel, (2) steel beam

This bridge is the third largest **steel** bridge in the world.

#### sauropod

 a large, long-necked dinosaur that was dominant during the Jurassic and Cretaceous periods, characterized by its massive sizes and quadrupedal stances, such as Brachiosaurus, Apatosaurus, and Diplodocus

synonym: dinosaur, Brachiosaurus, Diplodocus

(1) herbivorous **sauropod**, (2) **sauropod** fossils

The long necks of **sauropods** allowed them to reach high vegetation.

loom

v. to appear or take shape as a large, especially in a frightening way

synonym: appear, come on, overshadow

(1) **loom** over the global economy, (2) **loom** on the horizon The issue of divorce **loomed** large in his mind.

courtyard

 an open space surrounded by buildings or walls, often in the center of a building or group of buildings

synonym: patio, garden, atrium

(1) quiet **courtyard**, (2) spacious **courtyard**The hotel's beautiful **courtyard** was the perfect spot for a wedding reception.

stud

n. a small object with a head on one end and a sharp point on the other, used for fastening clothing, leather, or other materials; an animal used for breeding, typically a male horse or bull that is of superior breeding stock; (verb) to decorate or adorn with studs; to provide with studs for support

synonym: beam, scantling, framing

(1) horse stud, (2) wall stud

He bought a new **stud** to attach the strap to his watch.

ken

n. knowledge, perception, understanding, or range of sight;(verb) to be aware of or know

synonym: knowledge, understanding, familiarity

(1) within my **ken**, (2) **ken** of the person

He had a good **ken** of the city and could easily find his way

#### around.

#### **bobcat**

 a small wild cat native to North America, known for its distinctive tufted ears

synonym: lynx, wildcat, mountain cat

(1) **bobcat** population, (2) **bobcat's** agility

We spotted a **bobcat** lounging on a rock outcropping during our hike.

lad

 a young boy or man, often used in an informal or affectionate way

synonym: boy, youth, youngster

(1) working-class lad, (2) local lad

The older man gave the young lad some helpful life advice.

#### observe

v. to watch or notice something carefully, often to gather information or insights; to take note of something or someone; to celebrate or commemorate a special event or occasion

synonym: watch, monitor, scrutinize

(1) **observe** a tradition, (2) **observe** wildlife

It is important to **observe** safety procedures in the workplace to prevent accidents.

### puzzling

*adj.* confusing or difficult to understand; mysterious *synonym*: baffling, confusing, enigmatic

(1) **puzzling** behavior, (2) **puzzling** questions

The detective found the clues **puzzling** and couldn't solve the case immediately.

#### pseudo

adj. (meaning "false" or "not genuine") indicating something that is similar to or resembling something else but is not that thing

synonym: quasi, false, fake

(1) **pseudo** code, (2) **pseudo** name

#### ancestor

- n. a person from whom one is descended; a forefathersynonym: forebear, forefather, progenitor

#### prowess

#### breed

v. to keep animals for producing offspring in a regulated manner

### discovery

 the act or process of finding information, a place, or an object, or learning about something that was previously not known

synonym: finding, uncovering, detection

(1) a scientific **discovery**, (2) the great **discovery** of the century

Her research team made an important discovery.

### practically

adv. almost or nearly

synonym: almost, nearly, virtually

(1) **practically** constant, (2) **practically** impossible to find a parking spot

The store is **practically** empty.

#### lane

 a narrow road in the countryside; a well-defined track or path for someone such as a swimmer or driver

*synonym*: roadway, street, artery

(1) lane change, (2) first lane

We walked along a muddy **lane** to reach the farm.

#### rendezvous

 a meeting or appointment that has been arranged beforehand; a gathering of people in a pre-arranged location

*synonym*: meeting, appointment, encounter

(1) romantic **rendezvous**, (2) business **rendezvous**Our **rendezvous** point was the coffee shop on the corner.

#### tryst

a planned meeting between two people, especially lovers, typically in a private and secluded setting

synonym: rendezvous, meeting, appointment

(1) midnight **tryst**, (2) romantic **tryst** 

The couple planned a secret **tryst** at the beach after dark.

#### lovebird

- a type of small parrot, typically characterized by their brightly colored feathers and affectionate behavior towards their mates
- (1) **lovebird** breeding, (2) **lovebird** nesting

  The **lovebird's** colorful plumage and playful personality make it a popular pet.

### specification

 a detailed description of the characteristics, features, or requirements of something, typically a product or system; a written statement that outlines the standards, procedures, or requirements for a project or job

synonym: description, requirement, guideline

crest

a peak or ridge, especially on a mountain or wave; a decorative tuft or topknot

synonym: summit, peak, pinnacle

### ornithologist

- n. a person who studies, observes or is an expert in the scientific field of ornithology, which is the study of birdssynonym: birdwatcher, avian expert

  The documentary featured interviews with several renowned **ornithologists** discussing the bird population decline.

#### frenzied
