#### ancient

adj. relating to the long ago, particularly the historical period preceding the fall of the Western Roman Empire; very old

synonym: archaic, age-old, obsolete

## banish

v. to expel or send away from a place or situation, especially permanently

#### wander

vast

## priestess

- a female priest, especially one who is associated with a non-Christian religion or ancient belief system

#### exile

the state of being forced to leave one's country or home,
 typically for political or punitive reasons

## hymn

*n.* a song of praise or worship, especially one in a religious service or ceremony

## epic

a long and eventful or heroic history, story, poem, or film; (adjective) very imposing or impressive

## poem

 a piece of writing that emphasizes the expression of feelings and ideas by paying particular attention to diction (sometimes rhyme), rhythm, and imagery synonym: ballad, lyric, verse

#### bible

 the sacred writings of the Christian religions, consisting of the Old and New Testaments; a book regarded as authoritative in its field

## patriarch

## invade

## frequent

## gap

appoint

 to give someone a job or role, especially as a public official or member of an organization; to arrange or decide on a time or a place

synonym: designate, assign, name

## temple

 a place of worship, especially one that is associated with a particular religion or faith; the flat area on either side of

#### the forehead

## royalty

 revenue derived from the use of a patent, copyright, or other right; the people who are the family of a king and queen

## traditionally

#### mathematics

synonym: arithmetic, calculation, calculus

## competition

## calculation

 the act or process of using numbers to judge an amount of something

#### merchant

a person who buys and sells a large number of goods, especially one who imports and exports goods

synonym: dealer, trader, retailer

## communicate

#### distance

# pictogram

- a graphic symbol that conveys its meaning through its pictorial resemblance to a physical object

## script

## cuneiform

adj. of or relating to a form of writing consisting of pressing a reed stylus into clay to create wedge-shaped marks used in ancient Mesopotamia

synonym: wedge-shaped, triangular, pyramidal

(1) **cuneiform** writing, (2) external **cuneiform** bone The **cuneiform** tablets contain some of the oldest known examples of literature.

## stylus

*n.* a thin, pointed tool used to write, draw, or select items on a touchscreen device

synonym: pen, pointer, cursor

Many artists prefer to use a **stylus** over their fingers when drawing on a digital canvas.

clay

 a natural, earthy material that is made up of very small particles of minerals and can be molded when wet and then fired to produce ceramics

## wedge-shaped

#### transcribe

#### individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self

#### multistoried

adj. having multiple stories or levels, especially about a building or other structure

synonym: multi-level, high-rise, towering

#### brick

 a rectangular block of baked clay used as a building material

synonym: block, tile, paver

## granary

a storehouse or other building where grain is kept; a place where grain is grown

synonym: storage, warehouse, barn

## irrigation

- the agricultural practice of supplying land with water through pipes or channels so that crops grow well

## grain

## storage

#### oversee

v. to watch and direct someone or something to make sure that it is being done correctly

v. to explain or assign the meaning of information, actions, etc.

synonym: decode, decipher, analyze

- adj. connected with religion or religious purposes; worthy of respect or dedication because of a connection with a god

*synonym*: holy, inviolable, hallowed

- to be in charge of or to lead a meeting, ceremony, or organization

*synonym*: chair, lead, control

- a celebration or event, usually marking a particular religious or cultural occasion, often involving processions, music, dancing, and the performance of plays or other artistic works

synonym: fair, holiday, celebration

and night are approximately equal in length.

## accomplish

## combine

# mythology

 a collection of myths (= traditional stories accepted as history) or the study of myths

synonym: folklore, legend, fable

patron

 a person who gives financial or other support to a person, organization, or activity; a loyal or regular customer of a particular shop, restaurant, etc.

synonym: contributor, sponsor, supporter

deity

a divine being or god worshipped and revered by people in a particular religion or culture

synonym: god, goddess, divine being

(1) existence of a **deity**, (2) **deity** of commerce

The ancient Egyptians believed that the sun **deity** Ra was the most powerful god.

dedicate

v. to give all of your energy, time, etc., entirely to a specific person, activity, or cause; to set apart for a particular purpose or use

synonym: consecrate, devote, commit

(1) **dedicate** a few hours, (2) **dedicate** a chapter to the subject

He dedicated his life to helping others.

praise

 an expression that shows approval and admiration of the achievements or characteristics of someone or something

*synonym*: acclaim, honor, commendation

attain critical praise,
 universal praise
 the drama series mainly received praise.

glorify

v. to praise or honor something or someone, often in an exaggerated or overly positive way; to elevate or exalt something or someone to a higher status or position

synonym: exalt, celebrate, honor

(1) glorify god, (2) glorify violence

Religious leaders often **glorify** their messengers to encourage people to follow their teachings.

relation

 the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another *synonym*: association, linkage, connection

(1) **relation** between cause and effect, (2) **relation** of inclusion

The industrial **relations** laws were passed with little to no alteration.

## pantheon

 a temple dedicated to all the gods or goddesses of a particular religion or mythology; a group of something or someone that is remarkably respected, famous, or important

synonym: temple, shrine, sanctuary

(1) pantheon of products, (2) ancient pantheon

The **pantheon** of Greek gods and goddesses is well-known throughout Western culture.

aloof

 adj. emotionally detached or reserved; distant or uninvolved in personal relationships or social interactions; standing apart from others

synonym: distant, detached, standoffish

(1) aloof attitude, (2) keep aloof

The **aloof** cat refused to cuddle with its owner.

suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

(1) suffer a setback, (2) suffer bad grades

The older man **suffers** from arthritis and finds it difficult to move around.

plead

 to make a serious and urgent request or appeal, especially for help or mercy

synonym: beg, implore, supplicate

(1) **plead** for mercy, (2) **plead** a political cause

He **pleaded** with the authorities to release his son, who had been wrongly accused.

#### contribution

n. the act of giving something, especially money, to a particular cause or organization; a voluntary gift as of money or service or ideas made to some worthwhile cause

synonym: donation, gift, offering

(1) make a positive **contribution**, (2) **contribution** to society

His **contribution** to the charity was a generous donation of money.

## poetry

- n. poems in general as a genre of literature
- *synonym*: ode, poesy, verse
- (1) modern poetry, (2) book of poetry

Different cultures have different comfortable word rhythms, so the composition of **poetry** varies greatly.

## goddess

- a female god, especially in ancient mythology; a woman who is worshipped or adored
- synonym: deity, divinity, idol
- (1) a **goddess** of beauty, (2) winged **goddess** of victory The festival was held in honor of the harvest **goddess**.

#### desire

- n. a strong feeling of wanting to have or do somethingsynonym: ambition, appetite, greed
- (1) unsatisfied desire, (2) fleshly desire

Low sexual **desire** typically correlates with low testosterone levels.

#### divine

adj. of, from, or like a god; holy or sacred

synonym: godly, holy, sacred

(1) divine intervention, (2) divine grace

The view from the mountaintop was truly divine.

#### chaotic

- adj. without any order or organization; extremely disorganized, unpredictable, and confusing
- synonym: disorderly, cluttered, topsy-turvy

(1) the **chaotic** economic situation, (2) **chaotic** theory Change is also occurring in Turkey as a result of **chaotic** reform.

## spark

v. to start something or make it grow, especially suddenly; to emit a tiny piece of fire or electricity

synonym: start, inspire, provoke

(1) **spark** his interest, (2) **spark** a chain reaction

The bankruptcy of the giant conglomerate **sparked** turmoil in the stock market.

#### universe

 everything that exists, especially all physical matter, including planets, stars, galaxies, and all other forms of matter and energy

synonym: cosmos, macrocosm

(1) theory of the **universe**, (2) expansion of the **universe**The **universe** is about 13.8 billion years old.

## delight

- n. a feeling of great pleasure or happinesssynonym: pleasure, joy, satisfaction
- (1) a tremor of **delight**, (2) with **delight**The **delight** on the child's faces when they received the toy was priceless.

#### transcend

- v. to rise above or go beyond the limits of something synonym: surpass, exceed, overcome
- (1) **transcend** boundaries, (2) **transcend** limits

  The music **transcended** cultural barriers and reached audiences globally.

## gender

n. the range of characteristics of femininity and masculinity and differentiating between them, especially when considering social and cultural differences rather than differences in biology

synonym: sexuality

(1) **gender-blind** policies, (2) dual **gender** 

Cultural norms strongly influence **gender** expectations.

## boundary

- n. a real or imaginary line that marks the limit or extent of something and separates it from other things or placessynonym: border, frontier, limitation
- (1) geographical **boundary**, (2) the **boundary** between reality and fantasy

He wandered the **boundary** between life and death by gunfire.

## attendant

- a person who is employed to provide a service or perform tasks, often in a public place, such as a flight attendant, parking attendant, or hospital attendant
- synonym: assistant, aide, guide
- (1) flight **attendant**, (2) personal **attendant**The **attendant** at the parking lot directed me to an available parking spot

## prostitute

- a person, typically a woman, who engages in sexual activity in exchange for payment
- synonym: hooker, harlot, whore
- (1) **prostitute** street, (2) a male **prostitute**She turned to **prostitute** to make ends meet.

#### eunuch

n. a male who has been castrated, often to serve a particular role assigned by society; a man who has had his testicles removed, often historically to serve as a royal attendant, scholar, or religious figure

synonym: castrate, gelding, emasculated male

(1) **eunuch** palace, (2) serve as the **eunuch** guardian
The **eunuch's** castration was viewed as a sacrifice that he
made for the emperor's service and was considered an honor
in some cultures

## ode

 a lyrical poem that expresses feelings or praise for a person, place, or thing; a poem that is marked by a prominent theme or tone synonym: poem, song, verse

(1) nature **ode**, (2) an **ode** to love

The poet composed a beautiful **ode** to nature and its wonders.

## pronoun

- n. a word that takes the place of a noun in a sentence,such as "he," "she," "they," or "it"
- (1) **pronoun** usage, (2) possessive **pronoun** In English, personal **pronouns** such as "he," "she," and "they" can replace a person's name to avoid repetition.

## explore

v. to travel to or penetrate an area or a country to learn about it; to thoroughly examine a subject or a possibility to learn more about it

synonym: analyze, delve into, examine

explore the world, (2) explore our options
 The management must explore strategies to increase office security.

#### emotion

- a strong feeling such as love, anger, etc. deriving from one's situation, mood, or relationships with others
   synonym: feeling, sentiment, passion
- (1) control my **emotion**, (2) afraid to show **emotion**Some **emotions** are common across cultures and backgrounds.

## advantage

 a condition or circumstance that puts one in a favorable or superior position; a beneficial feature or asset that someone or something has

synonym: benefit, edge, asset

(1) score an **advantage**, (2) take **advantage** of his weak points

One of the main **advantages** of the new product is its increased efficiency.

#### vacuum

 a space empty of matter; a device or tool used for cleaning or removing debris by creating suction synonym: void, emptiness, gap

(1) vacuum cleaner, (2) vacuum packing

Please use the **vacuum** to clean up the mess on the floor.

coup

 a sudden, violent, and illegal seizure of power from a government; an impressive or successful action or achievement

synonym: revolution, overthrow, takeover

(1) **coup** plotters, (2) military **coup** 

The prime minister was arrested and charged with treason after he was found to be involved in the **coup**.

nephew

- *n*. a son of your brother or sister
- three-year-old nephew,
   nieces and nephews
   method nephews

legendary

adj. famous or well-known, especially through long-standing popular stories or tradition

synonym: mythical, fabled, storied

(1) **legendary** actor, (2) achieve a **legendary** status

ultimate

- adj. furthest or highest in degree or order synonym: highest, maximum, foremost

crush

v. to press it firmly, usually with your hands or a tool, so that it becomes flat or smaller

synonym: destroy, demolish, pulverize

## uprising

 a public rebellion, especially against an established government or authority

*synonym*: revolt, rebellion, insurgency

## influence

n. the ability to affect someone's or something's character, growth, or behavior, or the effect itself

## **Christ**

 the man that Christians believe is the prophet and the son of God, and whose life and sermons form the basis for Christianity
