scream

acclaim

tale

a story made up in someone's imagination, especially one full of action and adventure

synonym: canard, fiction, fable

Ghosts in folk **tales** are almost always malicious.

proclaim

- to announce or state something publicly and forcefully synonym: announce, declare, trumpet
- (1) **proclaim** victory, (2) **proclaim** law

The leader **proclaimed** a state of emergency in the country.

rack

a framework or support structure used to hold or display objects; a set of interconnected shelves or compartments used for storage; a source of torture, distress, or mental anguish

synonym: shelf, stand, frame

(1) clothing rack, (2) spice rack

I need to buy a new coat **rack** to organize my winter jackets.

halfway

adj. in or at a point midway or an equal distance between two points

synonym: middle, median, center

(1) halfway through my journey, (2) halfway decent job The famous restaurant stands halfway up the hill.

captain

the leader of a group of people, especially who is in charge of a ship or aircraft

synonym: boss, director, leader

(1) the **captain** of an opposing team, (2) **captain** of industry The **captain** ordered the troops to fire.

repay

v. to give back or make restitution for money, debt, or other obligation that is owed; to compensate or reward someone for something done or given

synonym: compensate, refund, reimburse

correspondence

n. the letters, emails, etc., especially official or business ones; the quality or state of being the same in amount, number, status

embargo

 a ban or restriction on trade, commerce, or travel imposed by one country or group of countries against another as a means of political or economic pressure or punishment

synonym: ban, prohibition, restriction

(1) oil **embargo**, (2) economic **embargo**The **embargo** on trade with the neighboring countries severely impacted the local economy.

novel

 an extended fictional work in prose; usually in the form of a story; (adjective) original and of a kind not seen before

synonym: fiction, story, (adjective) innovative

The **novel** has largely gotten positive feedback.

testament

n. a thing that proves the existence or truth of something else

synonym: proof, testimony, testimonial

(1) give properties by **testament**, (2) **testament** to the superior quality

manuscript

the original copy of a book, piece of music, etc. before it is printed

synonym: script

deadline

- n. a date or period by which something must be donesynonym: time limit, period

dishonor

the lack of honor or respect; a feeling of shame or disgrace

synonym: disgrace, shame, dishonorableness

(1) do him a **dishonor**, (2) **dishonor** of my family His actions brought **dishonor** to the family, and he was disowned.

podcast

- a radio program made available in digital format that you can download from the Internet and play on a computer or music player
- (1) football **podcast**, (2) listen to a **podcast**Our **podcast** was the most downloaded in the technology news genre this year.

psychology

- n. the scientific study of mind and behavior
- (1) **psychology** experiment, (2) **psychology** of crowd She had a master's degree in **psychology**.

inviting

sponsor

episode

 a happening or story that is distinctive in a series of related events; an abrupt short period during which someone suffers from the effects of a physical or mental illness

fade

- v. to vanish; to fade away; to lose color; to lose freshness synonym: languish, wither
- (1) **fade** away almost completely, (2) **fade** in importance My memory will **fade**, but my heart will live on.

intentionally

adv. in a planned or intended waysynonym: knowingly, calculatedly, deliberately

(1) she hit him **intentionally**, (2) She **intentionally** spread misleading information.

She would never **intentionally** hurt anyone.

delay

- v. to cause something to happen at a later time than originally intended or expected
- synonym: block, adjourn, detain
- (1) **delay** a flight three hours, (2) **delay** the new project We **delayed** the payment because of an incorrect invoice.

fridge

- n. a piece of electrical equipment in which food can be stored at low temperatures so that it stays freshsynonym: refrigerator

magical

- *adj.* produced by or containing supernatural powers *synonym*: enchanting, occult, supernatural

confirm

- v. to support or establish the truth or certainty of something previously believed or suspected to be the case
- synonym: affirm, verify, assure
- (1) **confirm** the diagnosis, (2) **confirm** a transaction Please write to **confirm** your reservation.

suspicion

the act of doubting something, especially something wrong

synonym: doubt, misgiving, skepticism

(1) suspicion of fraud, (2) cast suspicion

There was an almost certain **suspicion** that the company was involved in illegal activities.

acquaint

v. to cause someone to become aware of or familiar with someone or something

synonym: familiarize, inform, enlighten

(1) **acquaint** himself with a subject, (2) **acquaint** me with business

I recently **acquainted** myself with a new coworker by introducing myself and chatting with her for a few minutes.

chronic

adj. being long-lasting and recurrent or characterized by long suffering; habitual

synonym: established, regular, constant

(1) risk of **chronic** disease, (2) **chronic** alcohol consumption

Chronic hyperglycemia is a trigger for a variety of serious diseases.

disappear

v. to cease to exist or be visible

synonym: fade, evaporate, vanish

(1) **disappear** without a trace, (2) **disappear** after a week They watched the train **disappear** into the distance.

graduate

 a person who has a first degree from university or college; (verb) to complete the first course of university or college and get a degree

synonym: alumna, alum, grad

graduate degree program, (2) honor graduate
 Many employers hire graduate trainees to train as managers.

opposition

the act of disagreeing or resisting; the state of strong disagreement

synonym: resistance, hostility, antagonism

(1) **opposition** campaign, (2) meet with **opposition** The **opposition** party strongly disagreed with the government's proposed legislation.

precrastinator

- n. (antonym for "procrastinator") a person who tends to complete tasks as soon as possible, often excessively or prematurely; someone who inclines to finish or accomplish tasks far ahead of the deadline or required time

schedule

 a list of planned activities, tasks, or things that must be completed showing when they are intended to happen or be done

colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

collaborate with colleagues,

 decided to seek counseling on the advice of my colleague.

annoying

adj. making someone feel slightly angry

synonym: aggravating, bothersome, irksome

(1) annoying banner ad, (2) annoying habit

The phone call is an **annoying** interruption.

constantly

adv. all the time

synonym: continuously, always, frequently

(1) a **constantly** innovative enterprise, (2) a **constantly** varying mind

The mobile application industry is **constantly** changing.

excuse

 a reason or explanation, either true or invented, given to justify a fault or defend your behavior; (verb) to make someone free from blame or clear from guilt

synonym: apology, justification, reason

(1) excuse for inaction, (2) perfect excuse

He quickly fabricated an **excuse** for not attending the meeting.

fascinate

v. to attract and hold the attention of someone deeply and irresistibly

synonym: captivate, intrigue, mesmerize

(1) fascinate the public, (2) fascinate the young

The magic tricks fascinated the children.

extreme

adj. very great in amount or degree

synonym: farthermost, outermost, fierce

(1) extreme sports, (2) extreme weather events

Solar gravity creates **extreme** pressures and temperatures.

hitchhike

v. to obtain a ride in a passing vehicle by signaling to the driver or waving one's thumb; to travel by getting a free ride in someone else's vehicle

synonym: thumb a ride, bum a ride

(1) **hitchhike** a ride, (2) **hitchhike** across the country She had to **hitchhike** to the nearest gas station when her car broke down.

galaxy

 an independent group of stars, interstellar gas, dark matter, etc., in the universe, bound together by gravity synonym: star cluster, nebula, star system

(1) elliptic galaxy, (2) a galaxy of famous actors

The Milky Way **galaxy** has numerous water-bearing planets.

typical

adj. having the usual characteristics or traits of a specific group of things

synonym: characteristic, usual, distinctive

(1) typical leader, (2) fairly typical symptoms

This artwork is **typical** of her work.

bathtub

 a large container, typically made of porcelain or acrylic, for holding water in which a person can bathe

synonym: tub, bath, basin

(1) bathtub curve, (2) bathtub drain

I filled the **bathtub** with hot water and a bubble bath for a relaxing soak.

edit

v. to prepare written material for publication by correcting, condensing, or otherwise modifying it

synonym: revise, modify, adjust

suite

n. a set of rooms designated for a particular purpose or activity, especially a set of rooms in a hotel or private residence used as a living unit; a musical composition of several movements only loosely connected; the group following and attending to some important person

synonym: set, series, collection

The presidential **suite** is the most luxurious room in the hotel.

presumably

 adv. believed to be true or likely based on the available evidence, or supposed to be the case without definite proof

synonym: likely, seemingly, supposedly

(1) **presumably** accurate, (2) **presumably** refuse the offer

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The witness's testimony was **presumably** based on what he had seen and heard.

writ

- n. a written legal order or commandsynonym: legal document, order, legal process

legendary

adj. famous or well-known, especially through long-standing popular stories or tradition

discipline

 the practice of training people to obey rules or a code of behavior, using and punishments if these are broken; a region of activity, knowledge, or influence

myth

- an ancient story or set of stories accepted as history, especially explaining the worldview of a people
 synonym: fable, legend, lore
- (1) the **myth** of an old religion, (2) perpetuate a **myth** With the financial bubble bursting, the **myth** of economic growth in investment banking collapsed.

sneak

v. to go somewhere, or take someone or something somewhere secretly or stealthily; to steal or do something secretly or stealthily

synonym: creep, tiptoe, smuggle

(1) **sneak** a cigarette, (2) **sneak** out of danger The children tried to **sneak** out and eat the candy.

specifically

adv. only associated with or meant for one thing synonym: especially, particularly, notably

(1) designed **specifically** for men, (2) for **specifically** American customers

This ad campaign is aimed **specifically** at young women.

negative

adj. having the quality of something bad or harmful; expressing refusal

synonym: minus, adverse, pessimistic

(1) have a **negative** effect, (2) a **negative** number The movie has received almost universally **negative** criticism.

emotion

- n. a strong feeling such as love, anger, etc. deriving from one's situation, mood, or relationships with otherssynonym: feeling, sentiment, passion
- (1) control my **emotion**, (2) afraid to show **emotion**Some **emotions** are common across cultures and backgrounds.

core

- n. the most essential or fundamental part of somethingsynonym: center, basis, heart

mood

 the way you feel at a particular time; an angry or impatient state of mind

synonym: mindset, disposition, temper

regulation

 an official rule made and maintained by a government or some other authority; the act of controlling or directing something according to a rule

synonym: constraint, restriction, rule

The **regulation** approved by Congress was perfunctorily implemented.

elicit

v. to obtain information or a reaction from someone, usually with difficulty

synonym: bring out, obtain, evoke

(1) **elicit** a confession, (2) **elicit** a solution Have you **elicited** a response from them yet?

confidence

- n. the feeling or attitude that one can trust or rely on the abilities or good qualities of someone or somethingsynonym: self-trust, certainty, belief
- (1) **confidence** as a teacher, (2) boost my **confidence** Skill and **confidence** are an unconquered army.

incompetent

adj. lacking the necessary skills, knowledge, or ability to perform a task or job; not legally qualified or authorized to perform a particular task or job

synonym: ineffective, unskilled, inadequate

(1) **incompetent** leadership, (2) **incompetent** employee The **incompetent** doctor misdiagnosed my illness and prescribed the wrong medication.

insecure

adj. not firm or firmly fixed; likely to fail or give way, or not assured of safety

synonym: uncertain, unsure, unconfident

an insecure future, (2) insecure attachment
 Children in an unstructured environment often feel insecure.

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anxiety

 a feeling of worry, nervousness, or unease about something that is happening or might happen in the future

synonym: concern, dread, agita

(1) diagnosis of **anxiety** disorder, (2) **anxiety** for knowledge She waited for her daughter with **anxiety**.

regulate

v. to control something, especially by means of rules or laws

synonym: control, restrain, handle

(1) **regulate** blood sugar levels, (2) **regulate** our conduct We must manage to **regulate** our expenditure.

classic

adj. judged or deserving to be regarded as one of the best or most important of its kind over a period of time; of a well-known type

synonym: definitive, traditional, typical

(1) a **classic** experiment, (2) Chinese **classic** literature He displayed the **classic** symptoms of depression.

picky

adj. overly particular or selective, especially about food or other consumable goods; difficult to please or satisfy because of one's specific tastes or preferences

synonym: fussy, choosy, particular

(1) picky personality, (2) picky about detailsMy picky eater only likes to eat certain types of vegetables.

hypothesis

 a proposed idea or explanation that is based on a few known facts but has not yet been proven to be true or accurate

synonym: assumption, conjecture, theory

(1) test my **hypothesis**, (2) a bold **hypothesis**. This evidence supports the big-bang **hypothesis**.

proof

 a fact or piece of information that shows something is true or exists

synonym: testimony, evidence, assurance

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(1) documentary **proof**, (2) a geometric **proof Proof** is better than argument.

neat

adj. clean or tidy, with everything in its place synonym: tidy, uncluttered, refined

(1) a **neat** piece of work, (2) **neat** idea She has **neat** habits.

loom

 to appear or take shape as a large, especially in a frightening way

synonym: appear, come on, overshadow

(1) **loom** over the global economy, (2) **loom** on the horizon The issue of divorce **loomed** large in his mind.

suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume
- (1) **suppose** you're right, (2) **suppose** beforehand What do you **suppose** the culprit's motive was?

stir

v. to mix a liquid or substance by using a spoon or something similar; to cause to be agitated, excited, or roused

synonym: mix, swirl, provoke

(1) stir a sauce, (2) stir up controversy

Topics related to that war may stir up a political hornets' nest.

consequence

n. the outcome of a particular action or event, especially relative to an individual

synonym: result, impact, outcome

(1) unintended **consequences**, (2) the **consequence** of an argument

These economic activities had disastrous environmental **consequences**.

peer

n. a person who has the same age, status, or abilitysynonym: fellow, associate, counterpart

(1) **peer** group, (2) **peer** review

Among young people, **peer** pressure can be pretty influential.

suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

(1) suffer a setback, (2) suffer bad grades

The older man **suffers** from arthritis and finds it difficult to move around.

junk

n. discarded or unused material or objects, often considered worthless or of little value; also used to describe cheap or poorly made items or food that is high in calories but lacking in nutrition

synonym: trash, debris, waste

(1) **junk** mail, (2) hunk of **junk**

I need to clear out some of the junk in my garage.

difficulty

- n. a condition or state that causes problemssynonym: hardship, complication, problem
- (1) the degree of **difficulty**, (2) **difficulty** in breathing He has **difficulty** exercising because of a back injury sustained in an accident.

depression

 a mental condition in which a person feels very unhappy and without hope for the future; a severe recession in an economy or market

synonym: recession, slump, despair

(1) the Great **Depression**, (2) the root problem of her **depression**

Depression symptoms might include a decrease in appetite and weight loss.

meta

adj. pertaining to or involving a higher or more abstract level of analysis, interpretation, or self-reference, often used to describe aspects of gaming, social media, or other online communities that involve self-conscious or

self-referential elements

synonym: self-referential, introspective, recursive

(1) meta-analysis, (2) meta-language

The **meta** description of a website is an important element for search engine optimization.

definitely

adv. without any question and beyond doubt; clearly synonym: absolutely, certainly, indeed

(1) **definitely** become a problem, (2) say **definitely** The paper is **definitely** worth reading thoroughly.

guilty

adj. feeling responsible for or having done something wrong or criminal

synonym: culpable, blameworthy, at fault

(1) feel a bit **guilty**, (2) **guilty** verdict

After much contemplation, the suspect decided to plead **guilty** to the theft charge.

guilt

 the fact of having committed something illegal; the negative feelings caused by believing or knowing that you have done something wrong

synonym: regret, remorse, blame

(1) criminal **guilt**, (2) feeling of **guilt**Shame and **guilt** have significant social influences.

motivate

- v. to make someone want to do something, especially something that requires tremendous work and effort synonym: boost, encourage, inspire
- (1) **motivate** the students, (2) all ability to **motivate** The ability to **motivate** people is a priceless asset.

unfair

- adj. not giving equal treatment or opportunities to people involved; marked by injustice, partiality, or deceptionsynonym: wrongful, biased, dishonest

In a democracy, it is necessary to monitor the judiciary to see if it is making **unfair** decisions.

postpone

environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

phrase

a group of words that mean something specific when used together

synonym: expression, idiom, term

ready-made phrases, (2) noun phrase
 We bought a Spanish phrase book.

evoke

 to bring or recall a feeling, memory, or image into your mind

synonym: arouse, raise, inspire

evoke a sense of awe, (2) evoke sympathy
 This movie is likely to evoke strong emotions in the viewer.

absolutely

adv. without restriction or limitation; completely or utterlysynonym: completely, utterly, definitely

(1) **absolutely** against, (2) **absolutely** obsessed with the girl

I am **absolutely** opposed to his idea because of morality.

willpower

n. the control exerted to do something or restrain impulses synonym: determination, resolve, self-discipline (1) demonstrate **willpower**, (2) lack of **willpower** With strong **willpower** and determination, he could quit smoking for good.

autonomy

 the right of an organization, country, or region to govern itself independently

synonym: independence, sovereignty, self-sufficiency

(1) regional **autonomy**, (2) establish **autonomy**Demonstrators strongly demanded immediate **autonomy** for their country.

structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

ambiguous

adj. open to more than one interpretation; not clear or decided

synonym: unclear, uncertain, equivocal

The instructions provided were **ambiguous** and confused the team.

struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the iob

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

uncertain

adj. not being sure of something; not being able to choose synonym: doubtful, skeptical, pending

(1) numerous **uncertain** factors, (2) take an **uncertain** attitude

She was **uncertain** about her friend's intentions.

doubt

 a feeling of being uncertain about something, especially about how good or accurate it is

synonym: distrust, suspect, mistrust

(1) dispel **doubts**, (2) no **doubt** about the news

Doubt is the start, not the end, of intelligence.

confusion

 the state of being mixed up or unclear, or the state of disorder or uncertainty

synonym: disorder, disarray, chaos

(1) administrative **confusion**, (2) in great **confusion**The sudden policy change has caused **confusion** among employees.

boredom

 a state of weariness, restlessness, or impatience that arises from not being interested or engaged in an activity, task, or situation

synonym: ennui, tedium, monotony

(1) **boredom** relief, (2) chronic **boredom**

The long lecture on a topic I already knew left me struggling to fight off **boredom**.

flavor

the taste sensation produced by a substance in the mouth

synonym: taste, savor, essence

(1) a delicate flavor, (2) flavor enhancer

The **flavor** of the coffee was rich and full-bodied.

curb

to restrain, limit, or control something; to reduce or put a stop to something undesirable; (noun) the raised edge or barrier along the edge of a street, road, or sidewalk

synonym: restrain, limit, control

(1) **curb** appetite, (2) **curb** anxiety

He tried to **curb** his anger during the argument with his friend.

compassion

 a strong feeling of sympathy and sadness for another's suffering or bad luck

synonym: pity, empathy, understanding

(1) feel **compassion** for the poor, (2) have **compassion** toward the accident

His infinite love and **compassion** for everyone never weary.

relieve

v. to make something burdensome, unpleasant, or painful less severe

synonym: alleviate, ease, assuage
