fundamental

flavor

flood

suppose

fundraise

 to collect or solicit funds or donations, typically for a charity, nonprofit organization, or political campaign, often through events, campaigns, or online platforms synonym: appeal, raise, solicit

chapter

 a separate section of a written work usually numbered and titled

stabilize

v. to become or cause to become steady or unlikely to give way

synonym: brace, steady, secure

damage

gut

mention

recurring

equip

 to provide a person or a place with the things that are needed for a particular purpose or activity

synonym: prepare, furnish, provide

temptation
